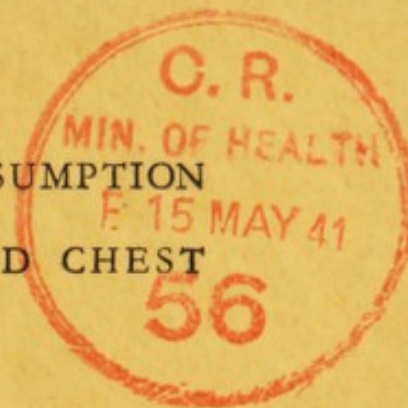



**REPORT OF
THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT**

for the year ended December 31st, 1940

THE Board have pleasure in submitting the Report and Financial Statement for the year ended December 31st, 1940.

The work of the Resident Medical Staff and the Honorary Medical Staff is again much appreciated and thanks are also tendered to the respective Matrons and the Nursing Staff for valuable work carried out so willingly under trying circumstances.

The hospital has suffered a big loss during the year through the death of Mr. H. E. Gaddum. He was an active member of the Board since 1898 and his kindness and ever happy disposition is sadly missed by all. We have also with regret to record the death of Alderman R. S. Harper who represented the Manchester Corporation Public Health Committee on the Board for many years. Miss Ecroyd, Manchester and Salford Hospital Saturday Fund representative, resigned and her attendance at meetings and her experienced advice are much missed.

The work at the various departments has been carried on as usual in spite of the difficult times, but the shortage of Nursing and domestic staff at the Crossley Sanatorium has caused the board considerable anxiety and unless things improve a number of beds might reluctantly have to be closed.

At the St. Anne's Home some necessary improvements were carried out. These include the installation of a modern economical kitchen range and improvements to the staff bathrooms including a new bathroom, etc., for the night staff,

At the Crossley Sanatorium some desirable additions had to be postponed, but necessary repairs in keeping the Sanatorium efficient have been put into work. After the tragic event at Barrowmore Tuberculosis Colony, accommodation for some of the patients was readily afforded until other arrangements for their treatment was forthcoming. The Rev. Otway Mayne has continued his chaplaincy and the weekly

services taken in the Chapel at the Sanatorium have been much appreciated. The Library has continued to be a source of great pleasure to the patients. Gifts of more modern books would be much appreciated.

The Hospital Saturday Fund has again given increased support for which we are very grateful. Thanks are also given to the Medical Charities Fund, The Oldham Ladies' Committee, the Manchester Corporation and various Hospital Funds and Charities for their much appreciated and valuable assistance.

Gifts of fruit and vegetables have been very welcome but there is an urgent need for children's books and playthings of all sorts at the St. Anne's Home.

The board are again very grateful to Messrs. Litton, Pownall, Blakey and Higson for their valuable services as Honorary Auditors.

MEDICAL REPORT.

The Medical Board have pleasure in reporting a satisfactory year's work in spite of difficulties due to the war.

The Out-patient attendances in Manchester show a big decline probably due to patients being evacuated from the district, but the Out-patient attendances at Bowdon show a small increase. The number of operations performed at Bowdon is smaller due partly to the depleted Medical Staff and to a number of beds being kept empty in the early part of the year under the Emergency Hospital Scheme.

DELAMERE

The number of beds in use at the Sanatorium during 1940 was subject to fluctuation both at the beginning of the year and at the end. In the former case a number of beds were kept empty on instructions of the Ministry of Health, while at the end of November a number of cases were admitted from a sanatorium wrecked by enemy action, and accommodated in the beds set up as part of the Emergency Hospital Scheme. The total admissions were 173 divided as follows:—

During the year 1368 X-Rays were taken.

The operative work of the Sanatorium was continued on the same lines as in previous years. Much assistance in the work of the Sanatorium has been rendered by the members of the honorary consulting staff whose monthly visits are of considerable value, while Mr. Graham Bryce has operated here on numerous occasions. The difficulties in obtaining domestic staff have been a great source of anxiety during the year and unless an unexpected improvement occurs a number of beds may have to be shut.
