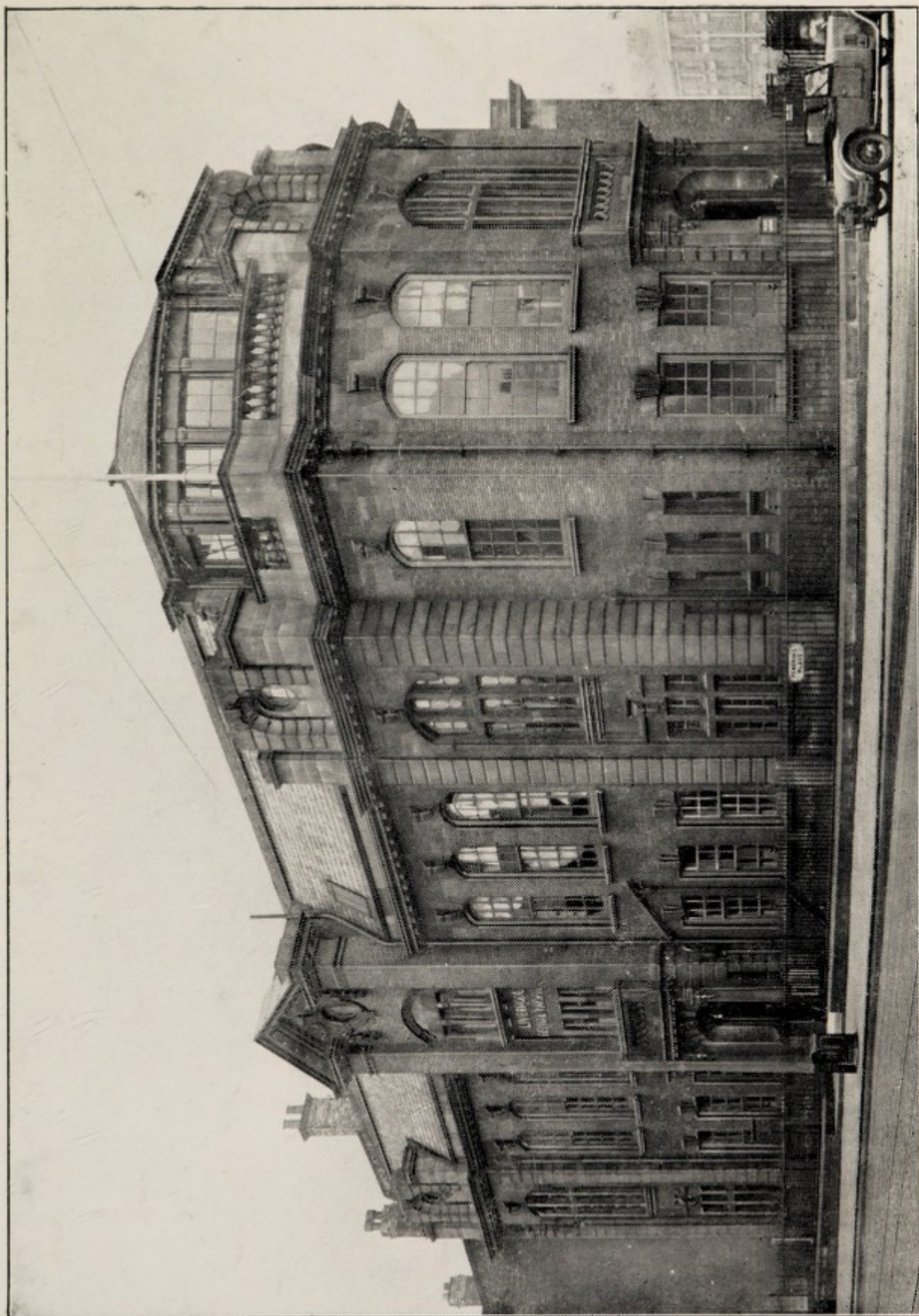

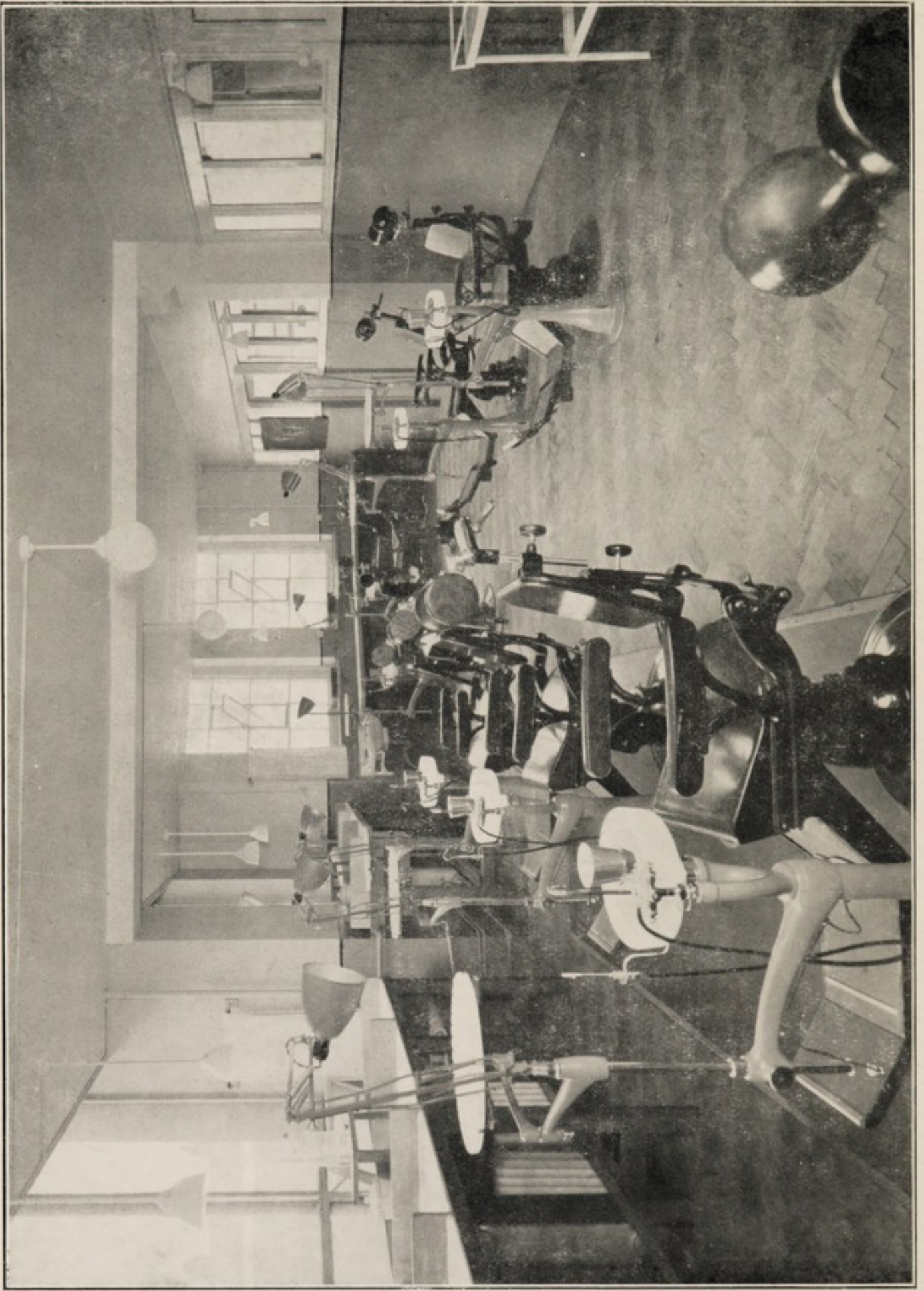

The Eighty-Fourth Annual Meeting of the Members, Patrons, Subscribers and Friends of the LIVERPOOL DENTAL HOSPITAL (being the thirty-third since incorporation), held on Friday, April 6th, 1945, at the Town Hall, Liverpool.

The Annual Report was read by Mr. C. W. HESKETH (Hon. Secretary), and the Balance Sheet and Accounts to December 31st, 1944, by Mr. J. FORSTER BRAKELL (Hon. Treasurer).

## EIGHTY-FOURTH ANNUAL REPORT

*(Being the Thirty-third since the Incorporation of the Hospital).*

---

The Chairman and Committee have pleasure in presenting their Eighty-fourth Annual Report and Statement of Accounts for the year ended December 31st, 1944.

During the past year the total number of attendances was **44,251**, including **18,331** new patients, a decrease of **4,650** on 1943. The number of operations performed was **39,262** (including **4,532** anaesthetic cases and **4,875** for the preservation of teeth), as compared with the 1943 figure of **42,481**.

These lower figures are mainly due to our present difficulties in maintaining an adequate staff to cope with the demand for treatment, and to the smaller number of students in the Hospital. During the latter part of the year, however, it was possible to obtain suitable staff for the Orthodontic Department, with the result that the attendances and treatments in this specialist department increased by **2,932**.

The Merseyside Hospitals Council during the year made a grant of £1,000 and thanks are extended to them for this very welcome financial assistance, which has enabled the Committee to make additional appointments, not only to the Orthodontic Department, but also, more recently, to the Parodontal and Anaesthetic Departments.

The Hospital Dental Aid Fund has enabled 121 patients to obtain dentures, and the Committee thank the J. R. Hobhouse Dental Aid Fund for a further grant of £550.

The Ministry of Health have appointed an Inter-Departmental Committee to consider how dental treatment can best be included in a comprehensive health service. The Liverpool Dental Hospital will probably have two primary functions: Firstly, to provide facilities and patients for the clinical training of Dental Students, for it should be realised that, as stated by the Inter-Departmental Committee, the country is short of Dental

Students, and considerably more will be required in the future. These must all be trained in the Dental Schools of Universities and in Dental Hospitals attached thereto, which have the specialised staff for this purpose. Secondly, the unique facilities of the Dental Hospitals must still continue to be available to patients. In such a comprehensive dental service, however, the Hospital would lose the contributions from patients and this would be extremely serious unless financial assistance is obtained from the appropriate authority.

In the meantime the Hospital requires all possible financial assistance and appeals for greater support of their efforts to maintain the excellent dental service it offers in this region.

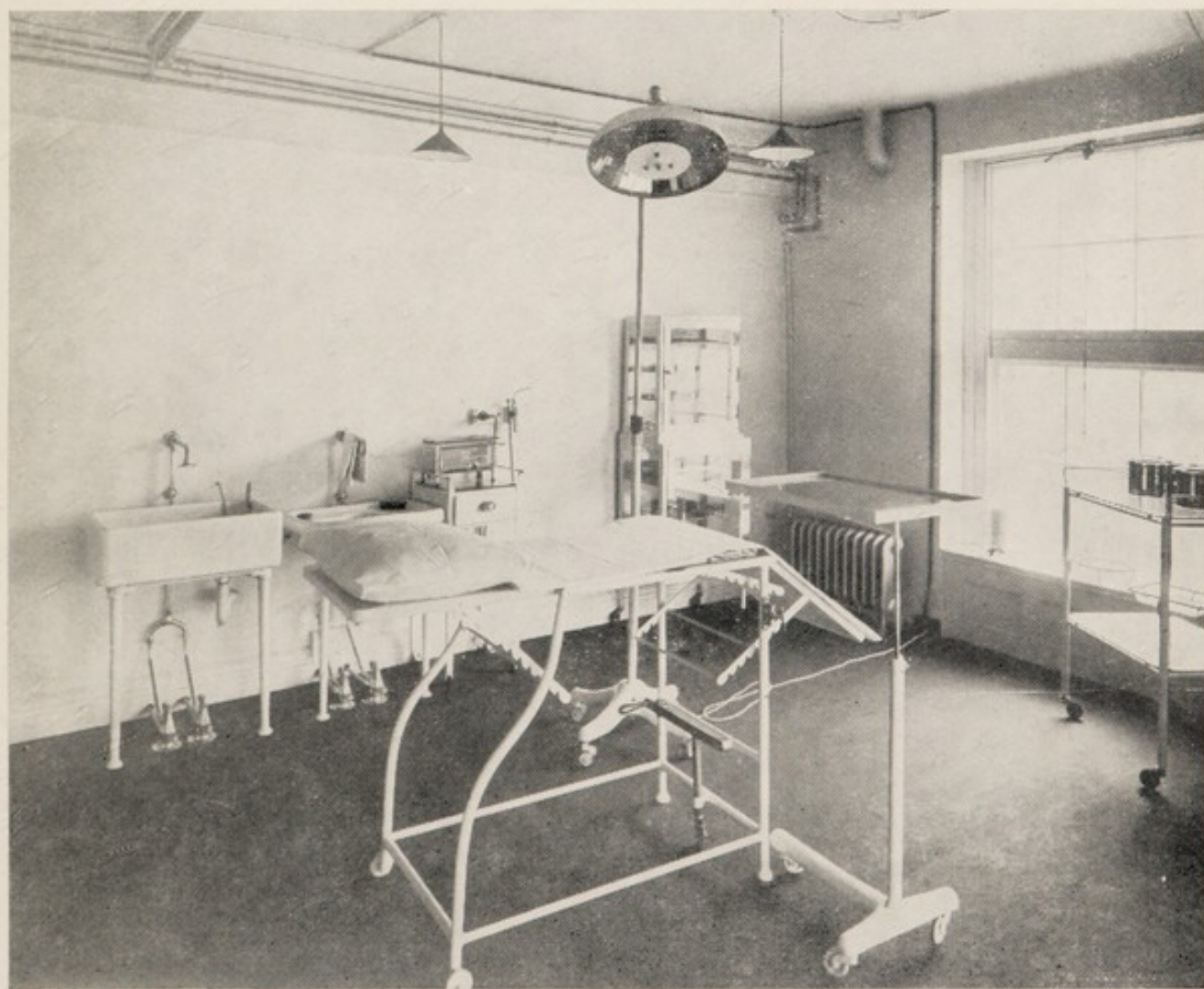

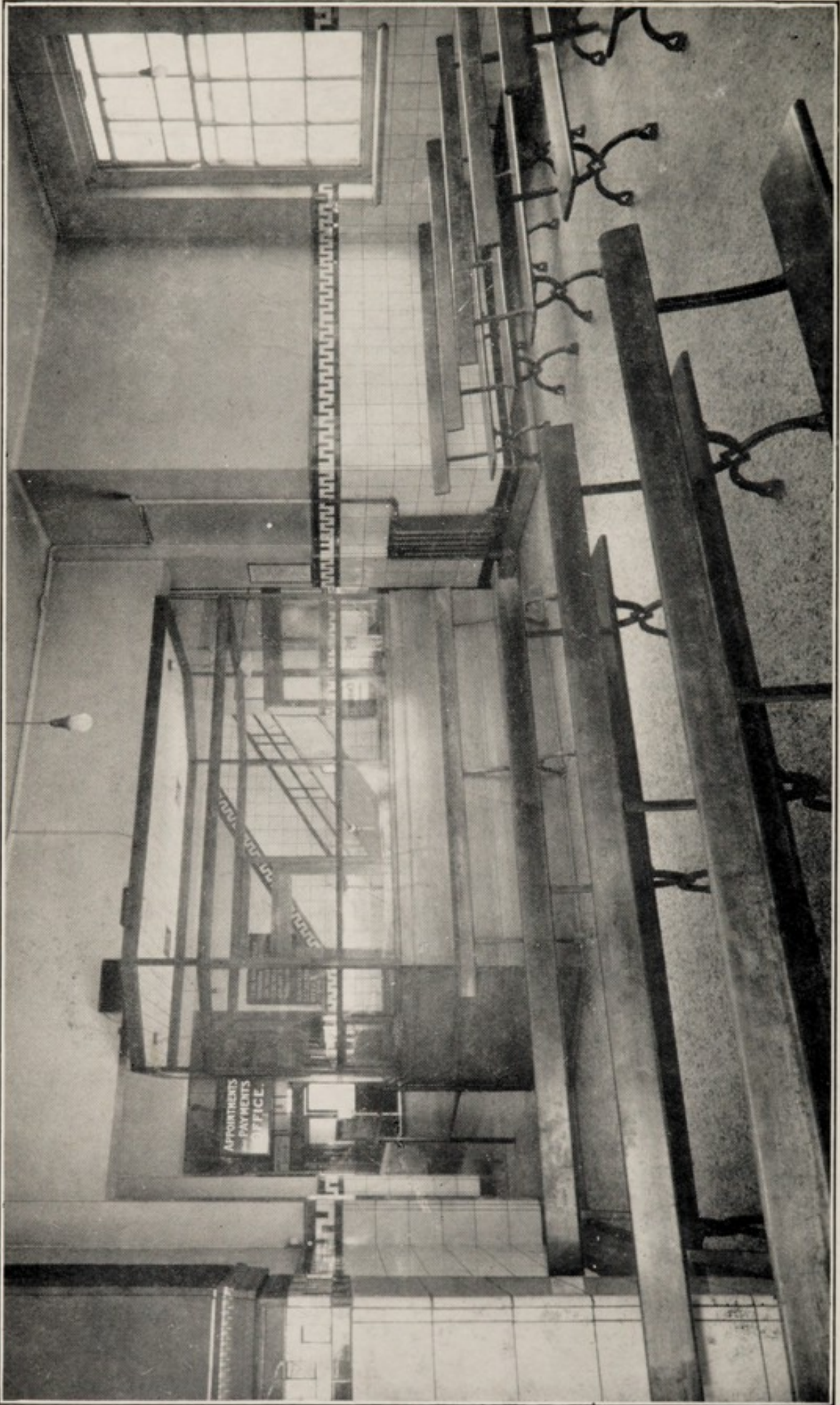
