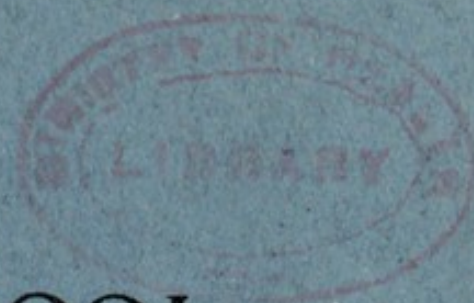

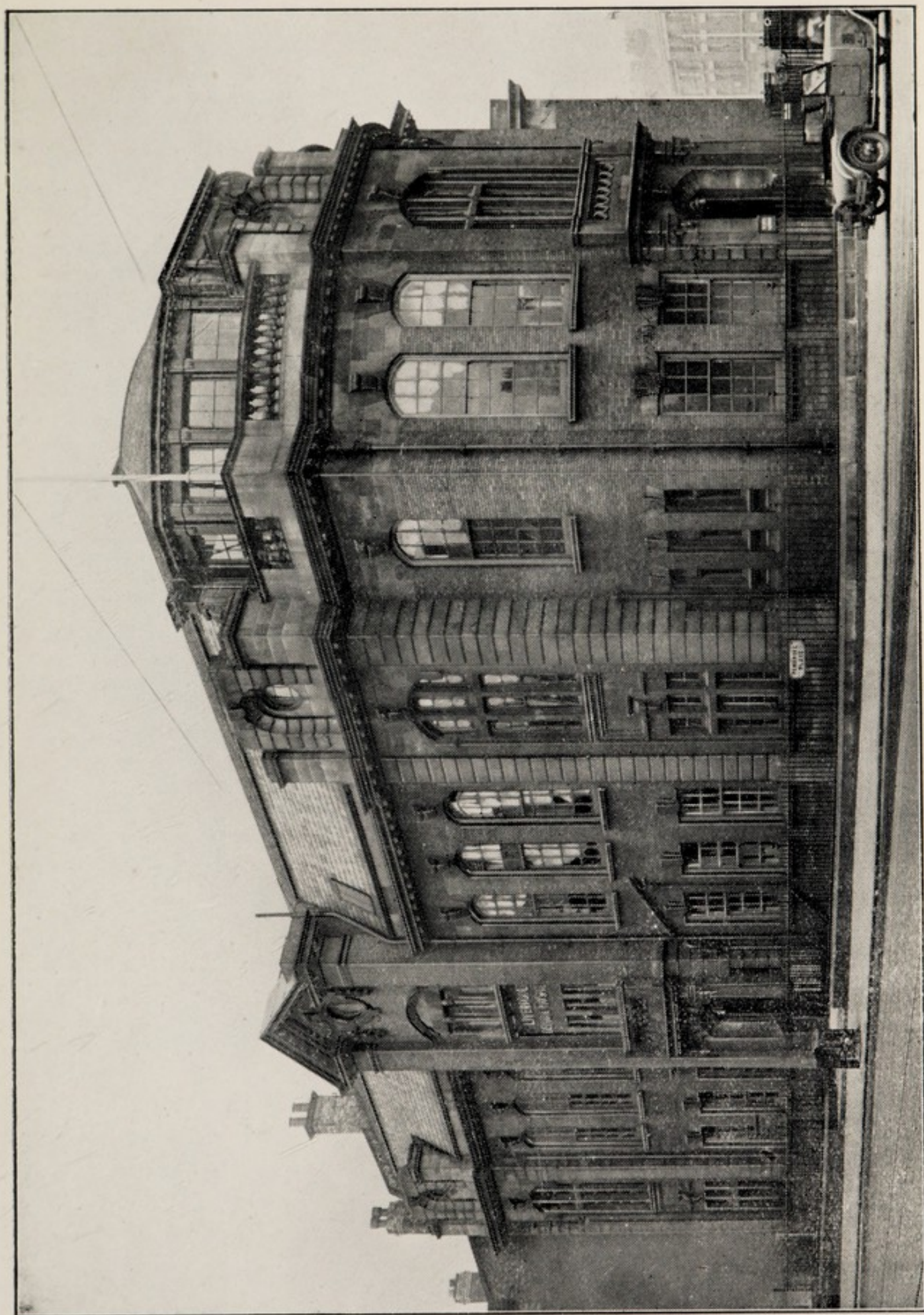

The Eighty-fifth Annual Meeting of the Members, Patrons, Subscribers and Friends of the Liverpool Dental Hospital (being the thirty-fourth since incorporation), held on Friday, March 29th, 1946, at the Town Hall, Liverpool.

The Lord Mayor (Ald. Luke Hogan, M.B.E., J.P.) in the Chair.

The Annual Report was read by Mr. C. W. Hesketh (Hon. Secretary), and the Balance Sheet and Accounts to December 31st, 1945, by Mr. J. Forster Brakell (Hon. Treasurer).

Moved by the Lord Mayor and seconded by Professor H. H. Stones :

"That the Report and Statement of Accounts now presented be adopted."

Moved by Mr. A. Drake and seconded by Mr. J. H. Coney :

"That the thanks of the Meeting be given to the President, Chairman, Committee, Honorary Auditor, Honorary Treasurer and Honorary Secretary, and to the Consulting Physician, Consulting Surgeon, and the Dental Staff for their valuable services during the past year, and that the President, Officers, Committee and Hospital Staff for the year 1946 consist of the following gentlemen (*see list*), and that Mr. A. H. Walker be re-elected Honorary Auditor."

Moved by Mr. Alfred S. Cross (Chairman of the Hospital) :

"That the best thanks of this Meeting be accorded to the Lord Mayor for his kindness in presiding on this occasion."

EIGHTY-FIFTH ANNUAL REPORT.

(Being the Thirty-fourth since the Incorporation of the Hospital).

The Chairman and Committee have pleasure in presenting their Eighty-fifth Annual Report and Statement of Accounts for the year ended December 31st, 1945.

During the past year the total number of attendances was **49,194**, including **19,779** new patients, an increase of **4,934** on 1944. The number of operations performed was **42,772** (including **4,608** anaesthetic cases and **6,041** for the preservation of teeth), as compared with the 1944 figure of **39,262**. It is gratifying to report that, for the first time since 1938, there has been an increase in patients and operations. This increase has been maintained in all departments, except in the Oral Surgery, where there was a small decrease.

The number of full-time appointments, in conjunction with the School of Dental Surgery, has been increased, this having been made possible through a grant of £1,000 from the Merseyside Hospitals Council, and thanks are extended to the Council for this very welcome financial assistance.

The Hospital Dental Aid Fund has enabled many deserving patients to obtain dentures, and the Committee's thanks are due to the Executive of the J. R. Hobhouse Dental Aid Fund for a further grant of £450.

The Dental Hospital has continued to co-operate with the School of Dental Surgery in the investigation into the cause of Dental Decay and its prevention, thanks to the generosity of Mr. J. P. Bibby and Messrs. J. Bibby & Sons, Ltd. This research work is being carried out at the National Children's Home, Frodsham.

The Committee has purchased the property, 65a-71a Pembroke Place, as the present building has not sufficient space to allow for development of the services and amenities the Hospital wishes to give to the patients.

The adaption of these premises to present needs would be a temporary measure, as it has been realised for some years that an entirely new building is essential. Following the Report of the Inter-Departmental Committee on Dentistry, it can be said that Dental Hospitals will, in future, have two primary functions : firstly, to provide facilities and patients for clinical training of Dental Students, as it is clear that there must be a considerable increase in the number of practising Dental Surgeons and these will have to be trained in the Dental Schools of the Universities and in the Associated Dental Hospitals ; secondly, the unique facilities of the Dental Hospitals must continue to be available to patients.

Thanks are also extended to the members of the Staff and Students for their work in the Hospital during the year, and to those who have assisted the Entertainments Committee.

It is recorded that Mr. L. S. Cohen, Mr. J. V. Murphy and Dr. A. Bateman (Hon. Anaesthetist) are still serving with H.M. Forces, and that Dr. E. L. Rubin (Hon. Radiologist) and Mr. A. F. Drake (Asst. Hon. Dental Surgeon) have now recommenced their duties after service in H.M. Forces.

During the year Dr. G. F. Rawdon Smith and Miss M. Tinkler retired from the staff of Hon. Anaesthetists. The Committee acknowledges the excellent service rendered by them, and particularly that of Dr. Rawdon Smith, who had served the Hospital continuously for 32 years.

The Committee record with regret the decease of Mr. H. H. Tomlinson, who, for many years, was an Hon. Anaesthetist to the Hospital. From his student days at the Hospital he had rendered excellent and loyal service and had the affectionate regard of the Committee and of his colleagues.

In conclusion, the Committee wish to commend to the people of Merseyside the valuable services available at the Hospital, and ask for greater financial support of their efforts to provide this service, which is so essential to the health of the community.

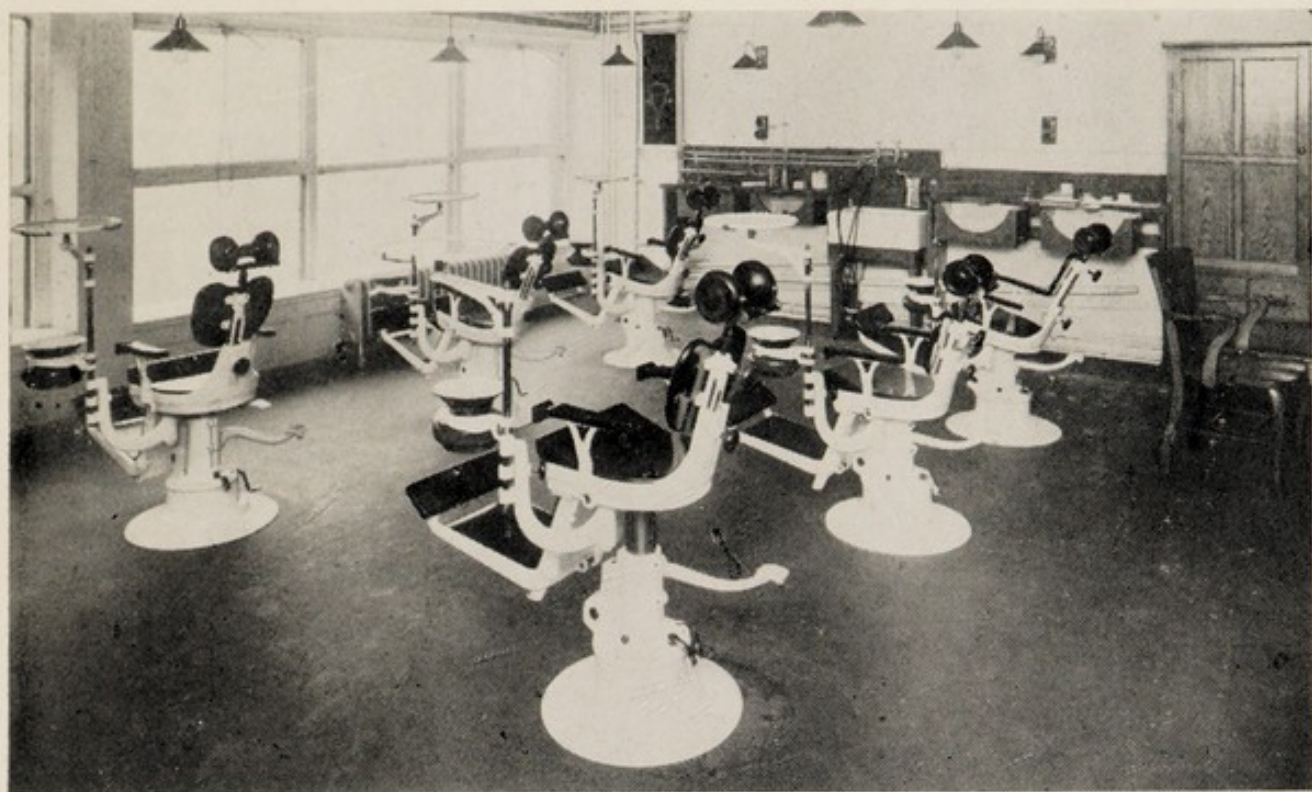

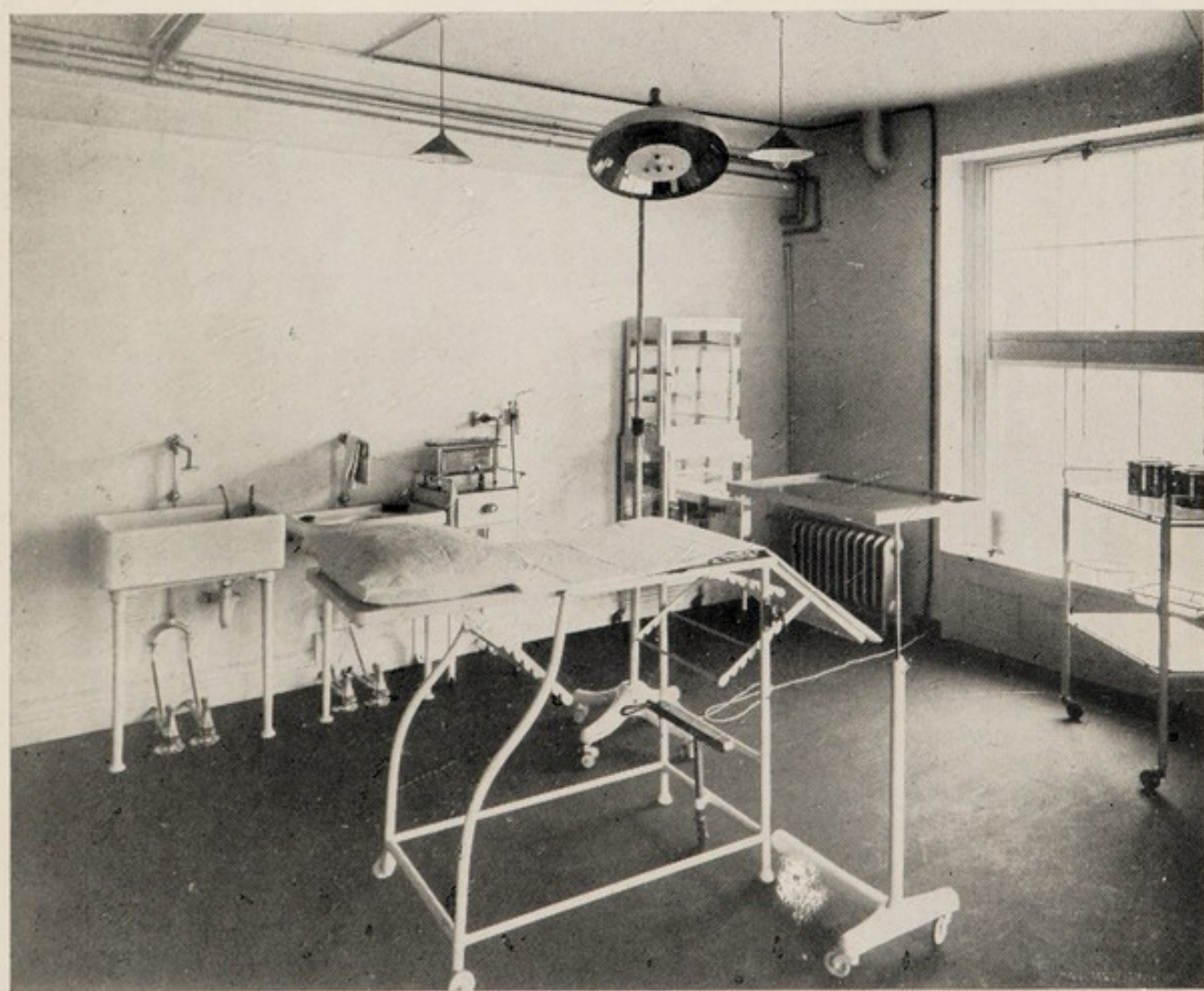

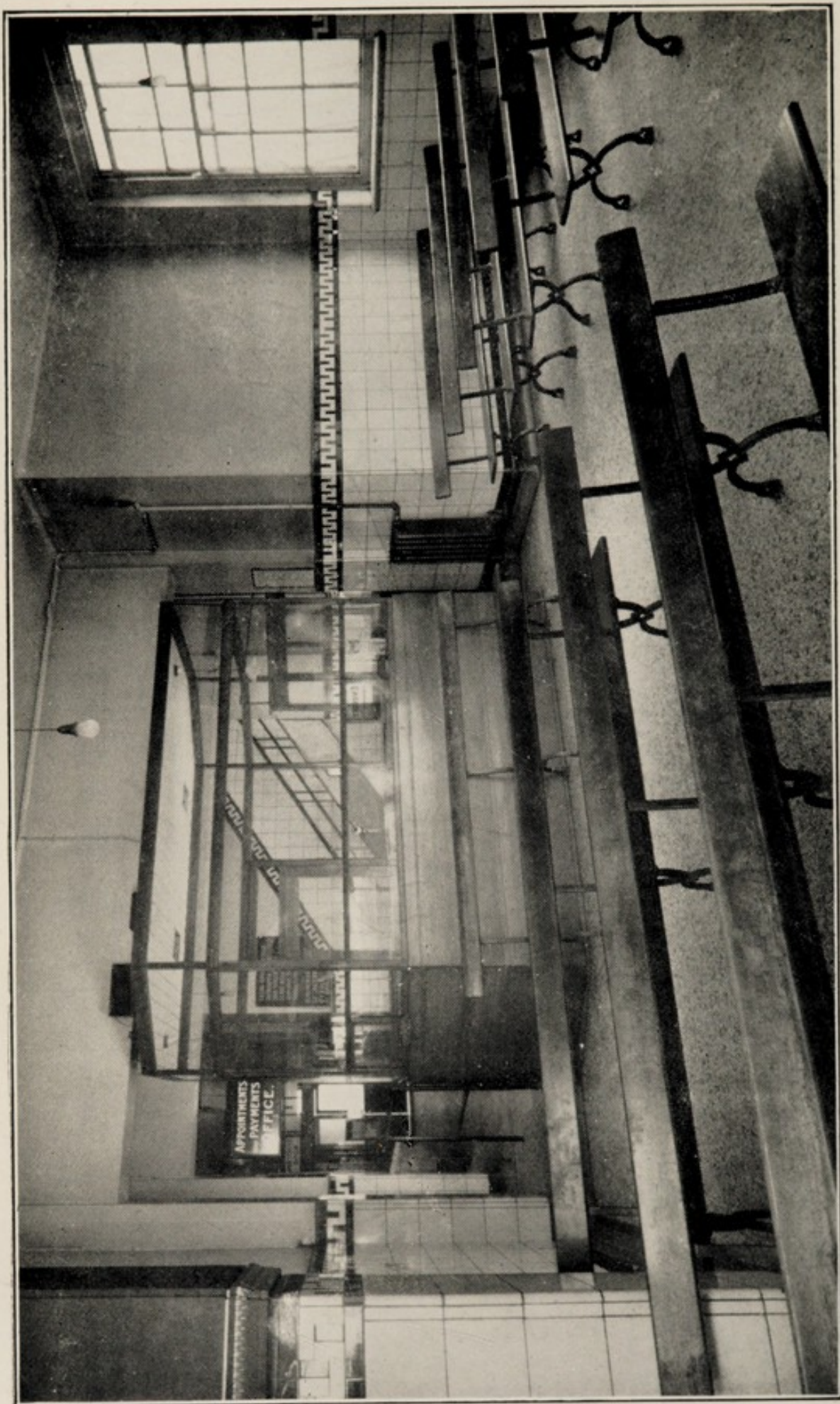
