**ANNUAL REPORT.**

The Board of the Leeds Public Dispensary and Hospital has pleasure in submitting the Report for the year ended 31st December, 1943, and desires to express to the many friends of the Hospital its warm appreciation of the support received during a year of many difficulties.

As in previous war years the Report has been curtailed for the purposes of economy, but no essential facts or figures are omitted.

Many members of the Honorary Medical Staff are still on Military Service, which has hampered the work in the special departments. The large increase in the number of patients, however, shows that the service rendered to the civilian sick and injured has been greater than ever.

It was found possible to re-open the Children's Ward on the 1st September, and the Ward is now working to its full capacity. It is hoped to re-open the other wards in the near future.

**PATIENTS.**

The following table gives an analysis of patients treated during the year under review, with the figures of the two previous years for the purpose of comparison :—

**CASUALTIES.**

The resources of this department have never been more sorely taxed and the following statistics show the increase in the number treated :—

99 Cases were treated as a result of accidents due to Motor Traffic ; a decrease of 23 on the previous year. 3,805 Operations were performed, and 5,630 Radiological examinations were made, an increase of 1,105. Attendances in the Ear, Nose and Throat department numbered 7,456 ; Rheumatoid Arthritis Clinic, 5,298 ; Massage department, 13,101 ; Ultra-Violet Ray department, 469. Dressing cases totalled 70,698, and 142 Visits were made by the Medical Staff to patients in their own homes.

5,251 patients passed through the Almoner's department, of which 40 were referred for convalescence ; 99 were assisted to obtain surgical appliances, and 111 were helped financially from the Samaritan funds.

## FINANCE.

The total Ordinary Expenditure for the year was £16,773, an increase of £2,193 on the previous year. Towards this, a total Ordinary Income of £14,854 was received, an increase of £131. After bringing in the £2,000 grant from the Leeds Corporation for use of part of the Hospital as a First Aid Post there is thus a surplus of £36 11s. 10d. for the year ended 31st December, 1943.

The amount received from Annual Subscriptions was £1,161 2s. 8d., Dividends and Interest £2,619 10s. 0d., Donations £618 14s. 0d., Donations by patients £323 17s. 4d., Receipts on account of services £286 17s. 1d., Donation Boxes £277 13s. 7d.

The Board gratefully records its appreciation of the splendid help given by the Leeds and District Workpeople's Hospital Fund by its grant of £8,200, and for the special grant of £200 towards the increasing cost of the Massage department. £1,000 has been earmarked for the reduction of the deficit on the Income Account which is now £2,448. The Board also expresses its grateful thanks to the Leeds Voluntary Hospitals Fund for its splendid help and congratulates the Committee on the excellent progress made by the Fund. £2,085 2s. 1d. was received from this source during the year, an increase of £337 16s. 9d. on the previous year.

Tribute was paid to the unabated interest and warm-hearted efforts of the contributors, to both these funds, and to the co-operation and help rendered by the employers of labour.

## BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT.

Except for urgent repairs, little has been done under this heading. The Children's Ward was repainted, prior to being re-opened. The Matron's private rooms were re-decorated.

Connection was made between the kitchen and the main boiler, to ensure an adequate supply of hot water for domestic purposes.

## TRAINING IN PHARMACY.

The facilities afforded for many years for training in dispensing, (forming part of the course conducted jointly with the College of Technology for the Assistants' Examination of the Society of Apothecaries) continues to be appreciated and valued, the number of students undergoing training being 12.

### **BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE.**

The Board and Medical Staff again acknowledges with grateful thanks the invaluable assistance received from the Leeds Blood Transfusion Service and from the blood donors attached to the service.

### **FIRST AID POST.**

The Hospital though carrying out its normal duties to the civilian sick and injured, is fully equipped as the Central First Aid Post in the City to deal with any exigency which may arise from enemy action. The Board is grateful to the Medical Officers, the voluntary workers, both auxiliary and from the permanent staff, whose enthusiasm has been so well maintained.

### **THANKS.**

The Board again desires to record with a deep sense of gratitude its indebtedness to the Honorary Medical Staff, and to express appreciation of their excellent service during the year. Thanks are also accorded to the donors of gifts in kind, the Press, the District Nurses, the City Police, and to many others by whose help better work has been made possible.

### **CONCLUSION.**

The Board finds it difficult to express its gratitude adequately to the friends and supporters for their devotion to the interests of the Hospital, as without their help its essential service to the community could not be maintained. The increased cost of all essential commodities has placed a very heavy burden on the finances, and the continued maintenance and development of the work is only made possible by that public spirit of kindness and generosity which founded the Institution and brought it to its present position of importance. The Board therefore, appeals to all classes of the community to take a share, however small, in maintaining the efficiency of the Institution.
