



## The 68th Annual Report for the year 1941.

THE COMMITTEE have pleasure in submitting their 68th Annual Report and Statement of Accounts being that for the year ended 31st December, 1941, and on account of the importance of saving paper, the report has again been considerably reduced.

They desire to express their thanks to the Subscribers and friends of the Hospital without whose help and support the benefits of the Hospital would be curtailed.

The number of patients treated during the year was 384 and they were in for a total of 6040 days, giving an average period for each patient of rather under 16 days.

The average cost per patient per week was £3 18s. as against £4 0s. 4d. in 1940. Of the 384 patients treated, 141 were admitted with Hospital and Convalescent Fund Recommends; 41 "Service" patients, and 43 were Private patients. There were 206 operations.

In the X-Ray Department 435 patients have been treated and of this number 228 received free recommends from the Hospital and Convalescent Fund.

The ordinary income for the year, inclusive of special receipts, was £4423 1s. 8d. and a further sum of £337 was received from the Ministry of Health for treatment of men serving in the Forces, Evacuees, etc. The Expenditure was £3368 13s. 2d.

The Committee much regret to record the death of Mr. Mitchell Smith who for many years gave his services as Honorary Orthopædic Surgeon to this Hospital. Mr. D. Wainwright has kindly consented

to take his place on the Honorary Staff.

The Committee desire to place on record their appreciation of the services rendered during the year by Mr. Eric Young and all members of the Honorary Consulting Staff. To Dr. Bellamy, the Hon. Radiologist; Mr. H. J. Arundel, the Hon. Solicitor; and to the Hon. Auditors, Mr. G. Clay and Mr. H. H. Goodwin. Also to the members of the Ladies' Linen Guild, and to express their thanks and appreciation to all donors of gifts in kind and to all those who assisted in any way to make the Christmas festivities enjoyable and to Sister Casey and to the Staff for the excellent work done during the year.
