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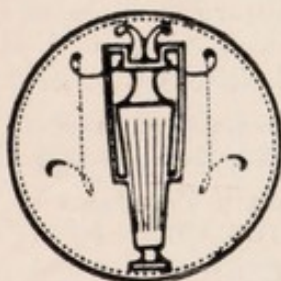

The 69th Annual Report for the year 1942.

THE Committee have pleasure in submitting their 69th Annual Report and Statement of Accounts, being that for the year ended December 31st, 1942, and, on account of the importance of saving paper, this Report has once again been considerably curtailed.

They desire to express their thanks to the subscribers and friends of the Hospital, without whose help and support the benefits of the Hospital would be reduced.

The number of patients treated during the year was 366 and they were in for a total of 5,395 days, giving an average period for each patient of rather under 15 days.

The average cost per patient, per week, was £4 5 4.

Of the 366 patients treated, 157 were admitted with Hospital and Convalescent Recommends ; 17 were "Service" or Evacuee Cases and 47 were private patients.

Operations numbered 272—a considerable increase on previous years. In the X-Ray Department, 557 patients have been treated as against 435 in 1941.

The ordinary income for the year, inclusive of special receipts, was £4,705 19 10, and the expenditure £3,290 1 5.
