Social Club and all other donors for amounts received. Also for many gifts received.

The Committee desire to express their thanks to the Honorary Medical Practitioners for their generous services, to the Matron, Home Sister, Sisters and Nurses for the constant care and attention bestowed by them upon the patients. To other Staff who loyally fulfil their duties.
