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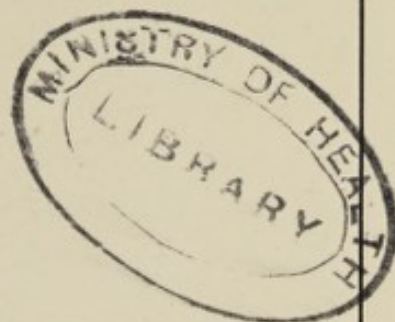
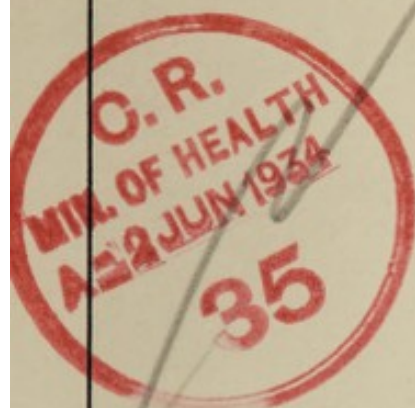

REPORT for 1933.

In presenting their Fourteenth Annual Report the Committee regret that the Balance Sheet shows a loss of £196 16s. 3d., mainly due to the cost of repairs and renewals, part of which expenditure was of an exceptional character and not likely to recur for many years.

The number of Out-Patients was 422 involving 1,934 dressings.

The number of Card Contributors admitted was 24. Trade Contributors 4, 1d. in the £ scheme 11.

The total number of operations was 100. Of these 16 were done by visiting specialists, 71 by Dr. Selby, 12 by Dr. Turner and 1 by Dr. Carlisle. Dr. Gunn gave the anaesthetic in all cases.

Of the 190 Patients 160 were cured, 23 relieved and 7 died.

The Committee again tender their sincere thanks to the surgeons, physicians, medical staff, the Matron and her staff for their services so willingly given during the year. They also acknowledge the splendid efforts of the collectors and particularly those of Mrs.

Bulley for her supervision of their work which resulted in an increase of £95 15s. 6d. being collected under the Card Scheme.

The Committee particularly wish to thank and congratulate Mrs. Kirby and her helpers on raising the splendid amount of £100 from the "Bring and Buy Sale" organised by her.

Their thanks are also due to the Right Hon. the Viscount Leverhulme and Mr. A. G. Grenfell for their donations which are very much appreciated. The firework display favoured by a fine dark night, attracted a very large number of spectators at Parkgate, with corresponding benefit to the Hospital. Owing to the good offices of Mr. Park N. Stone, a legacy of £500 free of duty was left to the Hospital by the late Mr. Andrew Gibson of Woodside, Carlisle, this being supplemented by Mr. Stone giving another £500, making £1,000 in all, on condition that the £1,000 was invested in the names of the Trustees of the Hospital and the interest only used as part of the income of the Hospital.

The special thanks of the Committee are also due to all those who contributed throughout the year, particularly on Pound Day and Christmas time in the form of fruit, flowers, etc.

We are grateful to the various places of worship who made special collections on behalf of the Hospital.

More funds are still needed and the Committee appeal for new subscribers to enable them to carry on the work which is undoubtedly of great benefit to the district it serves. It would be of assistance if the existence of the Hospital and its needs could be brought to the attention of newcomers to the area, by those who already subscribe.

CARD SUBSCRIPTION SCHEME.

RULES.

Who May Join.

1.—Any person approved by the Committee whose income is not greater than the income of a person who must be compulsorily insured under the National Health Insurance Acts and any dependent of such person. The subscriber's name must be shown on the cover of the Subscription Book.

Subscriptions.

2.—Subscriptions payable in advance are as follows :—3d. per week, 1s. 1d. per month, 3s. 3d. per quarter or 13s. a year, whether the subscriber is in or out of the Hospital. Married couples can be subscribers at a combined rate of 5d. weekly, 1s. 10d. per month, 5s. 5d. per quarter, 10s. 10d. half yearly, or 21s. 8d. a year, and are entitled to the benefit of Hospital treatment for themselves and their children up to 16 years of age if such children are not employed.

The family of a widow subscriber is entitled to the same benefits as the above.

Payments to be entered in Book.

3.—Each payment made must be entered and signed for in the subscriber's book by a duly authorised Collector for the Hospital.

Subscriber in Benefit after Four Weeks' Payments.

4.—Subscribers are in benefit when 4 weeks' subscriptions have been paid. Arrears must be paid up in the quarter in which they occur.

Benefits Under the Scheme.

5.—The Hospital does not admit Maternity, Mental, Infectious, long standing, or incurable cases, nor any case which the Medical Officer, for any reason, considers unsuitable. Subject to the above exceptions subscribers are entitled to :—

- (a) Free treatment at the Out-patient Department of the Hospital throughout the year.
- (b) Free admission to the Hospital as often in the year as necessary (but only so far as the accommodation available permits) without charge for nursing, board or care.
- (c) If a case (though otherwise suitable for the Hospital) can, in the opinion of the Hospital's Medical Advisers, be more advantageously treated at a City Hospital, then the sum of 40s. will be allowed towards the expenses incurred in connection with treatment at such City Hospital, payable in such manner as the Committee shall decide. No subscriber will be allowed more than one such payment in any year.

No Benefits if Subscriber Occupies Private Ward.

6.—Subscribers who wish to occupy Private Wards at the Hospital will be liable not only for the Hospital's charge for such Ward but also for Medical fees, including those of Specialists.

HOSPITAL REGULATIONS.

1.—The Matron, under the supervision of the Committee, shall have the entire responsibility for the management and good order of the Hospital, and for the observance of the Regulations relating to the management thereof.

2.—No patient shall be admitted suffering from any illness which is a notifiable illness, from mental affection or maternity.

3.—Except in cases of emergency no patient under 12 years of age shall be admitted without the special sanction of the Committee, unless the parents are card-subscribers.

4.—Except in cases of emergency only persons residing in the Parishes of Puddington, Burton, Ness, Neston, Parkgate, Gayton, Brimstage, Thornton Hough, Raby, and Willaston, shall be eligible for admission.

5.—Except in cases of emergency, application for admission must be made to the Matron, on the forms supplied for that purpose, and patients will be admitted as and when directed by the Matron.

6.—Unless otherwise directed by the Committee the minimum charge for a patient shall be 15s. a week. The charge covers nursing, board and care. Payments shall be arranged for in advance, except in cases of emergency, when such arrangements shall be made as soon as possible after admission of the patient. **Note.—This regulation does not apply to Card Subscribers.**

7.—Each patient shall provide for his or her use such clothing as the Matron may consider necessary.

8.—Patients must strictly conform in all respects to the directions of the Matron.

9.—Friends of patients not exceeding two at a time for each patient may visit them on Wednesdays and Sundays between the hours of 3 and 4-30 p.m. At other times only by permission of the Matron.

10.—Any gifts brought by friends for patients must be given into the hands of the Matron.

11.—A patient shall be entitled to be attended in the Hospital by his own Medical Attendant, whether he is or not one of the Medical Officers of the Hospital, subject to such rules and regulations as may be from time to time made by the Committee.

12.—Unless otherwise directed by the Committee, the Medical Attendant in attendance on any particular case, whether he is or is not one of the Medical Officers of the Hospital, shall not be entitled to make a charge on the patient for his professional services in the public wards.

13.—A patient shall leave the Hospital upon being instructed so to do by the Matron.

CHARGE TO PATIENTS OCCUPYING PRIVATE WARDS.

The charge to a Patient occupying a Private Ward (of which there are two) is £7 7s. 0d. weekly.

The charge to a Patient occupying a semi-private ward (two beds) is £3 3s. 0d. weekly.

A Patient occupying a private ward or a semi-private ward pays, in addition, medical fees, including those of Specialists. A charge of £1 1s. 0d. is also made for the use of the Operating Room, when required.

THE CHARGES FOR ACCIDENT CASES ARE AS FOLLOWS :—

FOR RESIDENTS in the district covered by the Hospital except Panel patients, contributors to Workmen's Collections and Card Subscribers :—

7s. for one day.

5s. a day for two or more days.

2s. for first aid, if not remaining in the Hospital.

FOR NON-RESIDENTS :

10s. for one day.

7s. a day for two or more days.

5s. for first aid, if not remaining in the Hospital.

The Doctors to have the right to charge a fee in all non-resident cases.

FORM OF BEQUEST.
