The Committee particularly desire to draw the attention of the Public to the following points:---

THAT the Hospital is open to Members of the Contributory Association for both In-patient as well as Out-Patient treatment without charge—provided they are in benefit.

> Non-Members of the Contributory Association are required to pay for such treatment.

> Patients have "free choice" of a Doctor on the General Staff of the Hospital.

> The Medical Superintendent will see responsible friends of Patients at any hour when professional information is desired, or when anxiety or uncertainty needs to be relieved.

> All Medical urgencies, all obscurities and uncertainties and all patients needing observation will be placed under the care and name of Dr. G. F. Walker.

> Maternity Patients are admitted to Thorpe Hall Annexe, where they will be under the care of their own Medical Practitioner, but it is necessary for them to apply to be interviewed on a Friday or Saturday afternoon at Midland Road by the Medical Superintendent, well in advance of the required date, and when accepted by him, then to apply to the House Governor and Secretary for confirmation of the booking which is only given upon the payment to him of the booking fee of £8 8s. 0d. (£6 5s. 0d. if applicant is entitled to a Contributory Scheme Voucher).

THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-EIGHTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of the GOVERNORS

of the Peterborough and District Memorial Hospital Held on 26th February, 1944

Present:-The President, Sir P. Malcolm Stewart, Bart., in the Chair, and some 120 Governors.

The House Governor and Secretary read the Minutes of the last Annual Meeting, and they were duly confirmed and signed by the President.

Sir Malcolm Stewart then addressed the Meeting and in referring to the continued progress of the work of the Hospital, spoke of the passing of the old order of Honorary Service to the new order of paid full-time Service of the medical personnel.

He was of the opinion that the citizens of Peterborough could look with satisfaction on the good progress made and they could steadily start to work for those needed extensions to the Hospital which it is hoped to build when victory brings in its train, Peace.

Mr. Joseph Stephenson, Chairman of the Management Committee, then presented his Report.

Mr. H. le P. Grimwade, the Treasurer, reported upon the Balance Sheet and presented the Accounts for the year.

Dr. G. F. Walker read the Medical Officer's Report.

Mr. W. T. Freestone, as Chairman of the Hospital Contributory Association, reported upon the Association's work for the past year.

All of the Reports were duly adopted.

The following Resolution was unanimously passed,

"That the thanks of the Meeting be given to the Medical and Surgical Staff of the Institution for their services during the past year and that in accordance with Law 68 which directs that 'The interest accruing from the Medical Officers' Fund, shall from time to time be disposed of by vote at a Meeting of the Governors in presents to the Honorary Acting Staff of the Charity'—the interest for the year 1943, amounting to £50 9s. 0d., be presented to the Treasurer of the Medical Board, to be disposed of as the Board thinks proper."

The Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to Sir P. Malcolm Stewart for presiding and to Dr. McLaine for his address.

Report of the Management Committee.

Mr. President. My Lords, Ladies and Gentlemen,

On behalf of the Management Committee of the Hospital, I have pleasure in submitting the Annual Report for the year 1943, and in addition I shall refer to activities which have taken place this year so far.

The past year has been one of great activity and we venture to think that much progress has been made despite the war.

The accommodation in the X-ray Department has been extended at a cost of £1,165, and the increased facilities thereby afforded have proved of great benefit both to the Hospital patients and the Medical Staff. The extension was made possible by the untiring efforts of Mr. H. Neaverson, who organised a Fund to defray the cost. The Fund was named "The A. C. Taylor Memorial Fund," and was in memory of the late Mr. Taylor's great work for the advancement of X-ray practice. A total of £1,311 ls. 11d. was raised. In this Department, Dr. A. H. Brockbank was appointed Radiologist in May last. His qualifications are L.R.C.P.(London), M.R.C.S.(England), D.M.R.E. Additional radiographic staff has also been engaged. The work has increased to an astonishing extent.

Another important addition is the Rehabilitation Department at Thorpe Hall. This question of rehabilitation has the strong backing of the Ministry of Health. The alteration of the premises for this purpose is now complete and immediately all the necessary equipment has been obtained, the Department, which will be in the charge of Mr. Noel Smith, the Orthopaedic Surgeon, will be put into operation.

It will be remembered that the Report on the 1942 Accounts mentioned there was to be a Maternity Ward at the Thorpe Hall Annexe with twenty-five beds. By instructions from the Ministry of Health we have had to cut this down to twelve beds with two Labour Wards and Nursery, etc., and until war emergencies are out of the way the Ministry of Health will not agree to any more space being taken for Maternity purposes. The South Ward Ladies' Sewing Party presented a cheque value £444 13s. 5d. for the purpose of equipping the Maternity Ward and it can be said that the undertaking is a great success and the Committee are only sorry that the exigencies of war prevent many more Maternity beds being installed.

In order to meet the difficulties occasioned by the shortage of Nurses, it was decided to open a preliminary Training School for girls who wished to enter the Nursing Profession. West End House, Thorpe Road, was rented for the purpose and furnished, and the scheme has proved to be a success.

The present Operating Theatre being inadequate to meet the needs of the Hospital, it was decided to erect a second Theatre. After some months of preparation and negotiation the necessary permission has been obtained from the Authorities and the work has recently been put in hand. The cost will be approximately £4,000.

The Waiting List has caused, and is still causing, the Committee much concern, but at last there seems some prospect of it being reduced. The balconies on the ground floor and upper floor of the Medical and Surgical Wards are to be enclosed, provided with heating and lighting, and these alterations will give us another sixteen beds.

After careful consideration and investigation, the Management Committee has decided to appoint, if possible, the following Consultant-Specialists, who will attend from time to time when occasion demands. They will be paid a retaining fee and an agreed fee for each visit. Registered Hospital patients will receive priority, but subject to that, private patients in the City and District served by the Hospital will be able, through their own Doctors, to consult the Specialists:--

- 1. Gynaecologist
- 2. Obstetrician
- 3. Genito-Urinary Surgeon
- 4. General Surgeon
- 5. General Physician.

In addition, it has been decided to appoint a Dermatologist, who will hold Clinics at the Hospital twice weekly.

Mr. Monkhouse, the Ear, Nose and Throat Specialist, has a long waiting list and therefore it has been decided to appoint an additional Ear, Nose and Throat Surgeon.

Within the last few days the Ministry of Health has requested us to send some of the patients on our waiting list to the Emergency Medical Services Hospital at Doddington. The Medical Superintendent has inspected the Hospital and has expressed himself satisfied with its appointments and facilities, and consequently it is hoped that this privilege will, to some extent, help to decrease the waiting list.

THE HOSPITAL CONTRIBUTORY ASSOCIATION.

We are indebted to the Association for a continued increase in its contributions. For the calendar year 1942 the amount was $\pounds 17,950$, for 1943 $\pounds 24,500$. Beyond expressing our grateful thanks for this wonderful financial assistance, I do not propose to trespass on the Report which the Chairman of the Association, Mr. Freestone, will be making.

The Management Committee has been able to make the following satisfactory arrangements, namely-

1. Parents of children who are members of the Contributory Association and whose children are sent by the Medical Officer of the Education Authority to the Ear, Nose and Throat Department of the Hospital will not now be asked to make any contribution with regard to this service, and this applies to the Soke as well as the City.

2. An agreement has been reached with the Huntingdon Hospital Authorities on the question of the boundaries of the respective Hospitals, this matter having arisen in consequence of the Huntingdon Hospital adopting a Contributory Scheme.

The Management Committee have thought it necessary to issue a ruling that people who are not members of the Contributory Association attending the Out-Patients Department for treatment and consultation shall be charged at the following rates, namely,—

5/- per attendance, except in the X-ray Department, where the normal charge will be 7/6, and for Chest cases 15/- to 30/according to the number of films used, all these charges to be subject to the Almoner's usual investigations.

It would be almost impossible for me to thank all donors, but I would refer to the following, as they indicate very useful additions to the Hospital's equipment, namely, through the good offices of Major J. Baker, a member of the Management Committee, a system of increased ventilation by extractor fans has been instituted in each of the Wards with the result that air conditions have been very much improved. Another item on the engineering side has been the re-positioning of the Operating Theatre sterilizing outfit, together with a system of canopies with an extractor fan for the clearance of the steam in the Sterilization Department. The cost of the ventilating canopies, etc., referred to has been covered by funds inaugurated in memory of the late Mr. Alan Baker and the late Mr. J. Booth. "Auntie Rhona" and "The Peterborough Standard" Chums have

"Auntie Rhona" and "The Peterborough Standard" Chums have again been to the fore during the year. A gift of thirty Lockers costing £340 was received for the Children's Ward, also thirty Cot Tables costing £172 10s. 0d.

Reference has already been made to the gift by Mr. Herbert Neaverson and his friends of the X-ray extension.

The City Air Raid Precautions Wardens and Fire Guards provided forty-two bedside screens at a cost of £250. These, and all other gifts have been very gratefully received by the Management Committee.

We have experienced during the year great difficulty in obtaining adequate Nursing and Domestic Staff. It is regretted that it has not been possible to put into operation the shorter hours for Nurses as recommended by the Rushcliffe Report, but the Committee are not unmindful and intend to reorganise working hours as soon as circumstances permit.

During the year, Dr. Joe Walker, Honorary Physician since 1921, having reached the age of retirement under the Laws of the Hospital, the Management Committee invited him to continue in that office and were pleased to have his consent. His services in these troublesome times are much appreciated.

Future extensions are continually before the Committee, but at present we can only visualise what in our opinion must be done in the future as soon as the war is over and the materials become available. Then important financial considerations will be involved and if we are to continue to effect wholesale improvements for the sick and suffering the Government will undoubtedly have to afford some financial assistance. It is to be hoped, however, that the voluntary principle will still be maintained. In the meantime, we shall continue to serve to the best of our ability.

We wish to express our grateful thanks to all donors of money and gifts in kind, to Collectors in the Wards and in the Villages, the Hospital Contributory Association and all the Works Collection Committees, the Clergy and Ministers who have arranged collections from their congregations and visited the sick in the Hospital, the donors of gifts and valuable equipment, voluntary stretcher bearers, blood donors, decontamination squad members, voluntary clerks, Women's Voluntary Service, members of Toc H and of St. John Ambulance Brigade, as well as the Nursing members of that Brigade, and last, but not least the members of the Hospital Ladies' Linen Association.

Finally, our thanks are once again due to Messrs. Swallow, Crick & Co. for acting as honorary Auditors of the Hospital accounts, now no small affair, to the Hospital Acting Staff, the Medical Superintendent and resident Medical Staff, Acting Matron, Sisters and other members of the Nursing Staff, Radiologist, Pathologist, Dispensary and Massage Staff.

To Mr. F. A. C. Taylor, House Governor and Secretary, and his Staff, whose hours have invariably been long throughout the year, the Committee sincerely say, "Thank you."

Treasurer's Report for the Year Ending 31st December, 1943.

Mr. President, my Lords, Ladies and Gentlemen,

As the printed accounts have been in your hands for some days and have received wide publicity in the Press where they have been fully dissected, I assume that you will wish to take them as having been read, and that I should only refer to the main points of interest, and endeavour to provide an answer to any question you may wish to ask.

You will see that our total income for the 12 months was $\pounds 54,006$, being an increase of some $\pounds 17,079$ on the previous year's figures. The principal increases were $\pounds 6,550$ from the Contributory Association and $\pounds 7,577$ from the Ministry of Health on account of E.M.S.

Against this increase of $\pounds 17,079$ in Income, we have an increase of $\pounds 14,391$ in our expenditure, so that as against a deficiency of $\pounds 2,387$ in 1942, I am in the extraordinary and happy position for a Hospital Treasurer of being able to report a balance in hand of $\pounds 301$ on the year's working.

One must, however, bear in mind that the amount received from the Ministry of Health may prove to be an exceptionally large item and that our expenditure will continue to increase as the services of the Hospital are extended, and conditions for our Staff and patients improved, and I would remind you that our Income and Expenditure Account in the Balance Sheet is still £2,907 overdrawn.

Salaries, Wages and Insurance alone showed an increase of £7,275 on the twelve months; these and our all round running expenses will continue on the up grade.

It would not be well for me as your Treasurer to strike too optimistic a note and I must impress upon you and upon our colleagues of the Contributory Association the need to keep your efforts unrelaxed.

The more money we can get, the better service can we give.

I must congratulate you all and the Contributory Association on the results for 1943.

The above figures represent an increase in the work of the Hospital of one-third, as compared with 1942. This increase has been achieved by co-ordination between the whole of the medical, nursing, lay and domestic staffs. The increasing volume of work mentioned has not been achieved without overcrowding in the wards, sometimes reaching almost unmanageable proportions.

During the past year the Management Committee have purchased substantial quantities of new medical and surgical equipment.

The waiting list remains at the figure of 500, but it tends to fall since the high level of 538 in July 1943. Nearly the whole of these 500 patients waiting will need operation.

The size of the waiting list reflects the fact that, on careful estimates of the population we serve, the Hospital is just one-third the size it ought to be.

The extensions to the X-ray Department, which the Chairman has mentioned, have been greatly appreciated, but a high pressure on this Department continues.

We renew the invitation to all other doctors in the district served by the Hospital, to enter the Hospital freely and to join us in the promotion, development and expansion of our services.

There is a high level of fraternal team work among the doctors within the Hospital, and the more we see of our colleagues in general practice the better.

We desire to return thanks to the Matron and her nursing and domestic staffs and for her personal unfailing courtesy; also we desire to renew the expressions of unswerving confidence which the medical staff feel in the Management Committee and our deep gratitude to the Chairman for his tireless zeal and energy.
