ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 1947.

The Board of Management has pleasure in presenting to the Governors its Annual Report and Financial Statement for the year 1947. This is the concluding Annual Report before transfer of the Hospital to the State in July, 1948.

The Year's Work.

The volume of work for both In-Patients and Out-Patients has continued to increase.

The number of In-Patients admitted was 7,507, the highest number in the history of the Hospital. 780 were admitted to the Private Wards for paying patients.

A considerable increase in the number of new Out-Patients is recorded, 40,984, an increase of 3,216. Attendances registered were 198,293 as compared with 181,520 in 1946.

The Out-Patients' Department, although a large building, is sometimes taxed to capacity. Larger numbers of patients are attending the clinics of the Specialists. It is hoped by a re-arrangement of some of the Departments more accommodation will be made available for examination of patients attending for Consultation and Specialist attention.

It is regretted there is a constant list of patients awaiting admission—an average for the year of over 600—but all urgent cases are admitted without delay. The average number of patients awaiting admission to the Private Wards for paying patients was 42, showing a need for the continuance of these special services.

The shortage of bed accommodation for patients in the town is much regretted. Efforts have been made during the year to obtain more beds but without success.

The New Ward is nearing completion, and 32 beds will be added to our number at the Hospital within the next few months, making the total at the two Hospitals 406.

The system of rehabilitation of patients by Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and other methods has made much progress since the War, and two well-equipped buildings will shortly be completed, with fully qualified whole-time staffs. Further extensions of this Department are awaiting official licences.

Formal notice has been received from the Ministry of Health that the Hospital will be taken over on the Appointed Day, July 5th, 1948.

The Board of Management is anxious to hand over the Hospital in the highest state of efficiency possible, and during the past year has authorised the purchase of much medical, surgical and specialist equipment; the redecoration, externally and internally, of both Hospitals (deferred during the past eight years). Also, additional appointments, honorary and salaried, have been made to the medical, surgical and specialist staff, enabling the hospital to retain its place as a major Hospital, to fit into the plan to serve the Bournemouth and Christchurch area under the National Health Service.

The Board has supported proposals for improvement in the services where these could be given effectively—cases in point are improvements and increased staff in the Laboratories, following the engagement of a full time Pathologist to administer the section set apart for Histo-Pathology and Morbid Anatomy investigations.

Additional accommodation was urgently needed for the Preliminary Training School for Student Nurses, and during the year suitable premises with furniture and effects were purchased in Boscombe Cliff Road; this accommodates 40 Student Nurses with two certificated Sister Tutors.

Plans have been approved for the erection of a building in the Hospital grounds for the accommodation of female domestic staff; and one for an additional and much improved class room for the Nurses' Lectures, and Practical Demonstration Classes. It is hoped they will all be occupied by June, 1948.

Finance.

The total income received amounted to approximately £187,000, and the total expenditure was in the neighbourhood of £204,000 showing a deficiency on the year's working requiring Treasury assistance. Consequently all the free investments held by the Hospital have been realised to meet the needs of day to day running costs.

In addition to the purchases already mentioned, the salaries and wages of many grades of the technical and non-technical staffs have been increased following negotiations by the various National Boards and Councils, comprised of employers and employees under the aegis of the Government. This is reflected in the average cost per In-Patient which has risen from 19/2.55d. to 22/7.94d., and the average cost per Out-Patient attendance from 2/6 to 3/-.

As to the future, the public will still be able to give support to the Hospital work in many ways; during 1947 one particularly welcome gift of £2,000 was received from the Boscombe Carnival (Chairman, Alderman A. H. Little), which was made for the exclusive purpose of providing extra comforts and amenities for the patients; a portion of this gift was devoted to special diets and extras for the patients and staff at Christmas. It is hoped all friends will make large or small gifts for this worthy purpose.

It may be that our Hospital Contributory Scheme will cease to function on the Appointed Day, 5th July, when National Insurance and National Health Contributions commence, but this fact should not deter voluntary effort in aid of the Fund for comforts for patients which a National Plan does not provide.

Honorary Staff.

It was with regret the resignation was received from Mr. E. C. Bowden, Senior Honorary Surgeon, who was elected to the staff in 1923, also Mr. A. R. N. Macgillcuddy, Honorary Surgeon to the Nose, Throat and Ear Department since 1922, and Dr. J. W. Redgate, Honorary Anaesthetist from 1938, who has left the town. The two former members have been elected to the Honorary Consultant Staff.

The following appointments have been made in accordance with the rules :—

Dr. T. K. Owen, M.Sc., M.B., Ch.B., L.R.C.P.(Lond.), has been appointed to the salaried position of Director of the Department of Histo-Pathology and Morbid Anatomy.

A new Department has been established for Thoracic Surgery; Mr. N. F. Adeney, F.R.C.S., has been appointed Surgeon in charge.

Appointments continue to be made in conjunction with the Oxford University Post Graduate Centre for the temporary employment of demobilised medical officers under the Government Scheme, and appointments have been made of Physicians, Surgeons, Pathologists and Anaesthetists.

The Rev. E. R. Weeks, Free Church Chaplain at the Hospital, Poole Road, resigned on leaving the town, and our thanks are due to him for over 17 years' ardent service to the patients, who appreciated his help. The Rev. H. Knowles, M.A., has been appointed to that vacancy.

Life Governors and Beds Named.

Mr. S. D. Hiscock of Ringwood, elected Honorary Life Governor in recognition of the support given by the patrons of the Star Inn, Ringwood, over the past years.

As a result of a further donation, making the total £512 1s. 9d., the 7th (Boscombe) Battalion Home Guard Bed, 1941, has been named in perpetuity.

A bed has been named the Craigie Ross Bed, 1947, a donation of £200 having been subscribed by friends of the late Miss Craigie Ross.

The Cyril Marsden Laws Cot, 1948, has been named by the receipt of a legacy of £500.

Nursing.

During the year 62 candidates entered the Preliminary Training School, of whom 59 were successful in their Entrance Examination, and have entered the Hospital to commence training. Miss Payne, Sister Tutor of the Preliminary Training School, returned to us in January, 1947, after a year's leave of absence in order to study for her Sister Tutor's Diploma which she was successful in obtaining. In December, 1947, the Preliminary Training School moved out of the Hospital to Seacliffe Court, which is to be our new Preliminary Training School.

During 1947 the average number on the Nursing Staff has totalled 220 as compared with 214 of last year. The staff has been increased to provide for the new extensions, now nearing completion.

The results of both Hospital and State Examinations have been entirely satisfactory. During the year 35 Nurses sat for the Final State Examination, 34 candidates were successful; one candidate, having failed in one subject, has since been successful. Fifty-two Nurses entered for the Preliminary State Examination, 46 were successful, 6 having failed in either Part I or Part II.

In September, 1947, Miss Cordery, Assistant Matron, took up her appointment as Matron of the General Hospital, Hereford. Miss Taylor, Second Assistant Matron, was promoted to the post of First Assistant, and Miss Kershaw, Night Superintendent, to the post of Second Assistant Matron. These changes have fulfilled expectations.

The Nurses' Benevolent Fund has made contributions to various charities during the year amounting to £50.

The Annual Prizegiving was held in December. Miss Angela Gaywood, S.R.N., Assistant Secretary of the Student Nurses' Association, presented the awards. In her stimulating talk to the Nurses she reminded them that 1948 was to go down as a very important year in the history of nursing, and stressed that on all committees relating to Nurses and Nursing matters, Nurses must be represented by Nurses.

The Heygate Vernon Gold Medal for the best nurse in her final year was awarded to Staff Nurse Isabel Marian Hills.

The Cecil Heygate Vernon Prize for obtaining the second highest marks was awarded to Staff Nurse Kathleen Mary Best.

The Earl of Malmesbury Prize was awarded to Nurse D. H. Cobbett.

The Sir Arthur Watson Prize to Nurse M. D. Johnston.

The Norman Brown Prizes to Staff Nurse J. M. E. Pennell, Nurse P. L. Stroud.

The Prizes for First Year Practical Nursing to Nurse U. M. Bunce, Nurse R. G. Grundy and Male Nurse S. J. W. Barrow.

The Matron's Prize was awarded to Nurse N. Goff.

REPORT FOR 1947

The President, the Countess of Malmesbury, and the Committee have pleasure in presenting their Report for the year just ended. They wish, first, to thank the Vice-Presidents who have raised £718 19s. 5d. and collected 1,022 articles, whose value is assessed at £204 15s. 9d. Secondly, they wish to thank all associates and friends who have contributed to this total. Such a collection to-day represents real hard work, with personal visits to collect subscriptions carried out under the most severe wintry conditions. Furthermore, coming events have undoubtedly cast their shadows before them, calling for persuasive arguments in favour of the hospital's ever-present needs, and at the same time bringing a further reduction of 191 in the number of our associates, and a reduction of £132 15s. 8d. in the Vice-President's collections. The total loss in the year's income is £198 10s. 8d.

To offset these reductions, 127 more articles were given this year, and it is encouraging to note that some Vice-Presidents have actually gained new associates, namely, Mrs. John Beale (15), Mrs. Rees (12), Mrs. Dick (10), and Mrs. Stride (8); while others have gained at least one or two.

Buying the linen has been no easy matter. There has been a further sharp rise in prices and we are told that 75 per cent. of the manufacturer's output is now going abroad. In spite of these and other unprecedented difficulties in the history of the cotton trade, the Matron's requests for the past year have been fully met.

To meet the requirements of the coming months £700 has been invested in the Trustee Savings Bank until such time as the linen now on order shall arrive.

The following special donations are gratefully acknowledged: £2 from the Boscombe Congregational Church Social Circle; 15/- from the St. John's (Boscombe) Women's Fellowship; two guineas from the Catholic Women's League (Boscombe Branch); £1 10s. 0d. from Cambridge House Hostel; one guinea in memory of Miss A. S. Livermore from Miss Ten Bruggenkate; £1 from the Ringwood Parish Church Infants' Sunday School; £5 from St. Christopher's School, two guineas from Wentworth School, and £2 anonymously given for care and attention while in hospital; £6 14s. 6d. and £1 2s. 0d., the proceeds of Whist Drives arranged by Miss Gates in Ringwood and by Mrs. Morris at the Marlborough Hotel; £3 6s. 7d. from Mrs. Adeney's Ward boxes, and £1 11s. 3d. from her box at Langton Hall Hotel. Foreign and colonial stamps realised £1.

The President and Committee wish to pay tribute to the work in Christchurch of Mrs. Popham who has recently died.

There are eight resignations to report: Miss Browne, Mrs. Hooper, Mrs. Mooring Aldridge, Mrs. Harlow, Mrs. Paton, Miss Daniell, Mrs. Heilpern and Mrs. Bowden. Four of these Vice-Presidents have been succeeded by Mrs. Angus, Mrs. Warcus, Mrs. Ayres and Miss Farquhar, and the work of others is being kindly undertaken by Mrs. Roberts Thomson, Mrs. McNeil and Mrs. H. E. Beale.

Mrs. Dancy was elected a Vice-President for a short time, but owing to an unexpected move was obliged to resign.

Mrs. John Beale has very successfully undertaken the widespread work of the late Mrs. King by whose death the Linen Association has lost another good friend.

Coupon-free materials have again been sold to associates and 709 specially required articles made from this source. The Hangersley W.I. has lived up to its reputation for a high standard of work and has sent in 152 articles. The women of Hurn Village have made 19, the Winton Christadelphian Dorcas Class 41, and 12 girls at Queensmount School have made 13. We look forward in the coming year to help in this way from the members of the Holy Trinity Fellowship and the Bournemouth East Townswomen's Guild.

We have now come to rely on the girls in the Council schools for making the babies' gowns. Not only have they made 119 but they have also knitted 54 babies' jackets and vests. Moordown C. of E. School and Charminster School have each sent a special donation of 10/-, making the total subscription from the schools £1 12s. 6d.

The wartime nature of our work still necessitates many calls on the time of the administrative staff, especially Miss Cordery's, who was responsible for the care of linen to the time of her departure from the Hospital staff. Her help and co-operation are always at our disposal.

Publicity given to an appeal in the local Press and Parish Magazines aroused more response than in past years. On the other hand we are led to believe that some considerable support so generously given during the past 48 years may soon be discontinued. Whatever the future may hold for the Hospital Linen Association it may well be proud of its long record of keeping this hospital not only well supplied, but one of the best supplied in the country; and proud too of its many workers and associates whose service to the community has been so freely given.

THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT given in details at the end of this Report shows an income of £752 16s. 10d. from subscriptions and donations and the sale of coupon-free materials, and £820 from the Trustee Savings Bank, together with a balance of £130 16s. 6d. brought forward from last year, making a total of £1,703 13s. 4d.; and an expenditure of £1,563 18s. 1d., which includes the transfer of £700 to the Trustee Savings Bank, leaving a balance of £139 15s. 3d. to be carried to the next year's account.
