



Royal East Sussex Hospital Annual Report 1934

The Committee have great pleasure in placing before the Governors their Ninety-fifth Annual Report.

The year 1934 has been a very notable year, because, at long last, the difficult question of providing a Home for the Nurses was solved in a most satisfactory manner, and the status of the Hospital as a training school was more fully than ever assured.

The opening of the Home by the Countess of Willingdon, C.I., D.B.E., the Vicereine of India, was the great event of the year. The ceremony took place in the grounds of the Home, Lady Willingdon being accompanied by the Countess Brassey, the Mayor and Mayoress of Hastings (Councillor H. Burden and Miss Phyllis Burden), the Medical Staff and the Hospital Committee. The Home consists of 80 bedrooms fitted with hot and cold water, and fixed furniture, several sitting rooms, a lecture hall and cooking demon-Your Committee acknowledge the valuable assisstration room. tance of the Matron, Miss Martindale, who was responsible for the tasteful scheme of furnishing of the rooms. During the spring, while the work of construction was in progress, H.R.H. the Princess Alice, Countess of Athlone and the Earl of Athlone, honoured the Hospital by visiting the Home. It will be remembered that Princess Alice unveiled the Commemoration Stone and received Purses for the Home in 1933. At a later date the Home was dedicated by the Bishop of Lewes, the Rev. E. G. Reid, Honorary Chaplain to the Hospital, acting as the Bishop's Chaplain for the Ceremony.

Your Committee were fortunate in receiving an anonymous gift of £200 for equipment of the Lecture Room with the latest medical models necessary for the training of the probationers. This gift enabled the Committee to meet a long-felt need created by the comprehensive nature of the studies of the Nurses. Your Committee feel fully justified in the opinion that the Home is one of the best equipped in the nursing world, an opinion endorsed by people who can speak authoritatively on the subject.

Another mark in the Hospital's history was the presentation of Radium by the British Empire Cancer Campaign Committee for the use of Hospital patients. The presentation was made on behalf of the Cancer Campaign Committee, by the Lord Lieutenant of Sussex, Lord Leconfield, and the Mayors of Hastings and Eastbourne accepted the Radium on behalf of their respective Boroughs. This ceremony took place in the Lecture Hall of the Nurses' Home, which was used for the first time for a public ceremony. The Bishop of Lewes (The Rt. Rev. H. M. Hordern), The Countess Brassey, the Mayor and Mayoress of Hastings (Councillor H. Burden and Miss Phyllis Burden) and the Mayor of Eastbourne (Alderman G. L. Thornton), the Deputy Mayor of Bexhill (Mrs. Meads), Mr. Ernest Stanford and Dr. G. Morgan, of the British Empire Cancer Campaign Committee, and representatives of the Hospitals were amongst those present upon this important occasion.

There are special reasons for the fall in the total of inpatients, including the reflooring of Ward 2 and the restriction on admissions on medical grounds during various periods of the year.

The more detailed figures reveal a remarkable development in the work of the specialised departments—massage, orthopædic, X-ray and Sun-ray. The policy of the Committee has been to maintain these important services at the highest point of efficiency for the benefit of those to whom the expensive treatments would otherwise be prohibitive.

The same comment applies to the pathological laboratory where again the returns show an increase of work, the benefits of which are shared by all classes of the community. So greatly has the work grown that better accommodation for the Honorary Pathologist and his staff is a vital necessity.

The Committee are very grateful for the gift of £500 from an anonymous friend of the Hospital, to be devoted to the provision and equipment of a department for X-ray treatment.

Towards the end of the year the Committee gave instructions for steps to be taken to provide private wards, for which frequent demands have been made and the plans are at the moment of writing on the way to completion, together with proposals for new quarters for the laboratory and improvements to the theatre block.

The financial position continues to receive our most careful attention. The debt on the old Building Fund has been paid off and we are using all available money in reducing the debt on the new Buildings and Equipment Fund.

The total cost of the Nurses' Home, the building and furnishing was £28,472, and the debt on that account stands at £13,572.

There is such a constant need for expenditure on the improved methods of treatment of patients and for renewals and repairs to the fabric that the Maintenance Fund calls for unremitting attention.

On the Maintenance Fund Account the ordinary income for the year was $\pounds 22,487$ 18s. 0d., and the ordinary expenditure $\pounds 23,729$ 7s. 8d.

During the year 69 victims of road traffic accidents were treated at a cost of $\pounds 686$ 0s. 9d. The amount received from insurance companies and other sources in respect of cases was $\pounds 451$ 7s. 10d.

Special thanks are due to the Committee of the Hospitals Carnival Association from whom the splendid sum of £2,406 5s. 0d., was received as the Hospital's share of the profits of the first Carnival. It is appreciated that the organization of this event meant a very strenuous time for many workers over a long period of the year, and to every one concerned the Committee offer sincere thanks.

The Committee confidently hope that the 1935 Carnival will be successful, and they cordially invite all interested in the Hospital to support the Carnival Committee in every way. Whilst that Committee is functioning, it is not the intention of the Hospital Committee to organise any Bazaars or Garden F tes for the Funds on the former large scale.

A cheque for £400, the balance of £1,000 raised by the Hastings and St. Leonards Lodges of the Ancient Order of Druids, was handed to the Hon. Treasurer of the Hospital (Mr. W. H. Cremer) by Mr. F. G. King, the Lodge Secretary. The Druids very kindly started the raising of £1,000 by means of a collection of tinfoil and other means for the endowment of a bed, in 1926, and now that their object has been achieved the Committee take this opportunity of expressing their sincere appreciation and thanks. They commend so fine an effort to the consideration of other organisations as worthy of emulation and as a practical interpretation of the principles of their Orders.

Among the improvements which became urgent during the year was the reflooring of the Men's Medical Ward, towards the cost of which £50 was given by a generous friend, to whom the Committee have often been indebted.

Grateful thanks are due to the Committee and workers of the League of the Golden Penny whose efforts have secured a larger return than that under the old form of collecting boxes; also to the Hospitals Benevolent Fund, whose payments form one of the largest items in the income; and to all who organise and carry out the flag days and other collections in which the Hospital shares.

It is with great regret that the Committee record the death, after a long illness, of Mr. C. W. Crocker, a member of the Committee for several years. Mr. Crocker is also remembered as the Hon. Secretary of the Hospital Saturday and Sunday Fund for Hastings, where he performed a fine service for the Hospitals.

The Committee once more gladly place on record sincere thanks to the members of the Honorary Medical and Dental Staff for their unselfish services to the patients; and they also acknowledge the loyalty and ready co-operation of all the members of the Nursing and Administrative and Domestic Staffs.

In gratefully acknowledging the continued support of all the Subscribers the Committee invite the help of new friends. Good health is the basis of happiness and success and is a blessing to which all are entitled. All that medical service can offer to those who fall victims to sickness or accident must be placed at the disposal of even the very poorest and the Committee trust that their policy, with this end in view, will be even more generally supported than in the past.

Forms of Bequest

BEQUEST OF LEGACY.

(3) I give to the Trustees of my Will all my property, known as in order that the same may be sold within one year from my death and the proceeds thereof paid over to the Treasurer for the time being of the Royal East Sussex Hospital to be used for the general purposes of the Hospital in accordance with the rules of the Hospital for the time being in operation and I direct that his receipt alone shall be a sufficient discharge to my Trustees for the same.
