



REPORT

COMMITTEE.

The Committee has to report with deep regret the death of Colonel the Hon. Arthur Brodrick on September 18th, 1934. For 25 years he served on the Committee, and for 14 years he was one of the Trustees of the Hospital.

Mr. H. A. Powell and Mr. C. J. Barlow were re-elected Chairman and Vice-Chairman, and Major H. F. Browell was appointed Hon. Treasurer; the Committee reappointed Mr. Riddell to assist the Hon. Treasurer.

The Committee are glad to report that Mr. W. T. Patrick has agreed to serve on the Committee and thereby continue his long association with the Hospital. Mr. H. B. Anderson, of Chinthurst Hill, Wonersh; Major P. C. Fletcher, of Charterhouse, Godalming; and Mr. Frank Hazell, of Ewhurst, who, until recently, was Secretary of the Manchester Royal Infirmary, have also agreed to serve, and these appointments will be brought before the Court of Governors for confirmation in due course.

The long list of patients awaiting admission has caused grave anxiety to the Committee, as they were unable, for financial reasons, to improve the position. Letters were published in the Press to this effect, and the Committee received from a very kind friend of the Hospital the offer of £10,000 towards the cost of building a new ward. The Committee most gratefully accepted this generous offer, and plans for the new extension have been passed.

The consequent additional annual expenditure has been estimated at £4,000 to £5,000; in order to meet this it has been decided to launch a special appeal to all residents of the County of Surrey. For this purpose the services of Mr. F. W. Allwright have been engaged, and a Special Appeal Sub-Committee has been formed. It is hoped to increase our subscriptions by at least £7,000 a year to meet the increased annual expenditure and at the same time raise a substantial capital sum to meet the cost of the extensions over and above the gift of £10,000.

The Committee take this opportunity of thanking Mr. Napper for the valuable work he did during his five years of office.

HON. MEDICAL STAFF.

The Committee have to report with regret the death of Dr. J. P. A. Gabb, who was a member of the Hon. Medical Staff from 1884 until 1906 and Hon. Consulting Medical Officer from 1906 until 1934.

Dr. Godfrey Bamber has been appointed Hon. Dermatologist in charge of the new Dermatological Clinic.

Dr. Ralli Creet has been appointed Hon. Ophthalmic Clinical Assistant to Dr. Lang in the Ophthalmic Department.

Dr. Barbara Whitaker's name has been added to the list of Hon. Assistant Anæsthetists.

The Committee take this opportunity of thanking all members of the Hon. Staff for their whole-hearted co-operation and service.

STAFF.

The Matron and the Nursing Staff have shown untiring energy and loyalty in the performance of their duties and in their efforts to make the burdens of the patients as light as possible. Many letters of appreciation have been received from patients.

ADMINISTRATION.

The new Registrar's Department referred to in the last Annual Report has proved of great benefit. The Report of this department will be found on page

The length of time patients have to wait in the Out-Patient Department has been reduced by making appointments. This system is being extended, and it is hoped that advantage will be taken of it by patients coming to the Out-Patient Department. The Report on the Almoner's Department will be found on page

The work in this department has been growing steadily, and in July the Committee appointed Miss K. Wyldbore-Smith Assistant Almoner.

The Committee wish to thank the Administrative Staff for the valuable work they are doing.

CHAPLAIN.

The Rev. C. E. C. Lefroy, the Chaplain, has been assisted by Miss Vaughan and Deaconess Ford. Miss Wallace has provided the music at the Sunday services. The Committee express their thanks for the good work that has been done.

SHEPHERD CONVALESCENT HOME, WORTHING.

The Committee have to report with regret the death of Dr. A. E. Rouse, who has acted as Medical Officer to the Home since it was opened in 1909. Dr. J. E. C. Rouse has

been appointed Medical Officer to the Home in succession to his father.

During the year 168 patients were sent to the Home, thereby releasing beds in the Hospital for more urgent cases.

The thanks of the Committee are due to Miss Flack and her staff for their loyal co-operation, and to Mr. Morris Butler, Hon. Architect, for his help.

SAMARITAN FUND.

The report of this fund for the year will be found on page 68. After providing for the needs of patients, £365 was handed over to the Convalescent Home at Worthing, an increase of £10 over last year.

The Committee express their gratitude to Miss E. Lancaster (President) and Mr. H. R. Le Cocq (Hon. Secretary) for all their work.

WEST SURREY AND ALDERSHOT HOSPITAL LEAGUE.

The valuable work done by the League has not diminished. From its members, 2,844 received in-patient treatment and 6,163 received out-patient treatment in its affiliated hospitals; of these, 1,652 in-patients and 4,354 out-patients were treated in this Hospital.

BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE.

The Committee offer their sincere thanks to Eng.-Rear-Admiral Berry and the Archbishop Abbot Conclave of Crusaders for the work that has been done in connection with this service and to all those who have come forward and given their blood for patients.

The Committee wish to draw attention to the immense value of this service and to say how grateful they will be to any person willing to give his services in this direction. Names of prospective blood donors should be sent to Eng.-Rear-Admiral Berry, Merrowdowns, One Tree Corner, Guildford.

The Income and Expenditure Account shows an adverse balance of £2,475 5s. 4d., which compares very closely with the result of the previous year, both income and expenditure for the year showing an increase of some £600. The increase in expenditure is mainly due to the extra staff required in the Registrar's and Out-Patients' Departments. Apart from this item there is little variation in the expenditure.

Constant care is taken to ensure economical administration and expenditure is closely scrutinised. When the Committee have assured themselves that increased expenditure is essential for the benefit and well-being of the patients then it does not hesitate to add to its already heavy expenditure.







WE are very pleased to be able to again present a most satisfactory Report.

The total amount received was £479 7s. 2d., an increase of £21 1s. 1d., as compared with last year.

Grants were made to patients of £64 14s. 8d.

A sum of £365, or £10 more than in 1933, was paid over towards the upkeep of the Shepherd Convalescent Home, Worthing, making a total of over £5,400 sent to the Home during the last 14 years.

We had 72 collectors (an increase of five), and 62 towns and villages were represented.

The number of patients admitted to the Home was 168, an increase of 14; and the average number of days spent there was 18.

We again thank our collectors for their untiring energy and interest, and sincerely hope that further efforts will be made, for the reason that when more beds are shortly added to the Hospital, more funds will be urgently required.

THE Committee have pleasure in submitting the 29th Annual Report of the work of the League.

The membership is now 980; the number of articles made 1,461, and the Subscriptions amount to £384 2s.3d. All these figures showing a slight increase over last year.

The League has supplied all the Linen required for the Hospital and Worthing Home, and has given many other things for the use and comfort of patients as will be seen in the Balance Sheet.

The Committee much regret the resignation of Mrs. Rupert Anderson, who served on the Committee and as Collecting Member for Farnham and District for the last 11 years. During this time she collected over £1,200 for the League. The Hon. Mrs. Needham has undertaken the work in that district.

The resignation of Mrs. Neil Gossage, who has collected for Shamley Green since 1919, is much regretted. Mrs. Nesbitt has agreed to fill her place. It is hoped to start a branch in Horsley next year under Mrs. Briggs.

The High Sheriff of Surrey, Sir John Jarvis, accompanied by Lady Jarvis, attended the General Meeting and Exhibition of Work in May, and spoke of the important work of the League, which was much appreciated. After tea, Members had the opportunity of going round the Hospital with the Matron.

The Committee would like to thank all those who have so generously helped in the work, and hope they will continue to show their interest and also endeavour to make the object of the League more widely known.




