ANNUAL REPORT

The Committee of Management present their Report for the year 1945 ; it is still in a somewhat abridged form, but the lists of Annual Subscriptions and Donations has been published again. It is hoped that next year's Report will include statistics relating to the work of the Hospital which have had to be omitted in recent years.

PRESIDENT.

It is with deep regret that the death is recorded of the late Earl of Onslow, P.C., G.B.E., President of the Hospital since 1924. The Court of Governors will be asked to confirm the appointment of the present Earl of Onslow, who, by accepting the Presidency in succession to his father, maintains the valued association of his family with the Hospital.

COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT.

There were few changes in the Committee : the Chairman, Mr. P. Peebles ; Vice-Chairman, Mr. J. Dixon ; Hon. Treasurer, Major H. F. Browell, and other officers were re-elected, and the Committee were glad to have Major-General G. H. Addison with them again. Mr. Honnywill's resignation was received with regret ; his interest in Hospital activities in Godalming will be especially missed. Mr. J. Parkin and Mrs. C. D. Harvey resigned : the vacancies have been filled by Mr. W. Fish, Mrs. J. W. Dixon and Mr. H. H. Norris.

MEDICAL STAFF.

The Committee were glad to welcome back from active service Dr. G. Bamber (Dermatologist), Mr. H. G. N. Cooper (Surgeon) and Dr. P. Wesson (Physio-therapist). It was regretted that Mr. St. J. D. Buxton and Mr. P. Wiles were unable to continue their work in the Orthopædic Department when the war ended and their resignation was accepted, as was that of Dr. A. E. Campbell, and this opportunity is taken of placing on record the thanks and appreciation of the Committee for their valuable work for the Hospital for so many years.

Mr. J. Jackson Richmond, F.R.C.S., D.M.R., was appointed as Hon. Consultant in Radiotherapy. Mr. Richmond is also in charge of the Emergency Medical Service Radiotherapy Centre at St. Luke's Hospital and his services are proving of great assistance to our Medical Staff in connection with the implementation of the Cancer Act.

Dr. S. Keys was obliged to resign his appointment as Assistant Pathologist through illness and it is sincerely hoped that his health will be restored.

WAR SERVICE.

The Committee feel that it would be appropriate to record an account of some of the work of the Hospital intimately connected with the war, which for reasons of national security they have been unable to publish in previous Reports.

By overcrowding the wards and by the addition of Merrow Grange as an Auxiliary Hospital, the number of beds available for emergency was more than double the pre-war accommodation, and, as the following figures will show, in addition to the treatment of an increased number of ordinary civilian cases, a very large volume of work was undertaken throughout the war on behalf of the Ministry of Health :—

About 180 wounded men were brought to the Hospital from Dunkirk in June, 1940 ; many of these were cases of severe burns and their treatment was remarkably successful. For some weeks before the invasion of the Continent in 1944, practically all the patients had been evacuated to their homes or to hospitals in the North of England in preparation for "D" day, when the Hospital became a Transit Hospital, the first casualties coming direct from the Normandy beaches. Immediately on arrival, the men were examined, emergency treatment was given, and as soon as they were fit to be moved, in most cases within 24 hours, they were transferred to other hospitals inland, so that the beds were quickly available for the reception of further casualties. Over 800 wounded were admitted during the early days of the invasion, the total number of which fortunately proved to be considerably less than was anticipated.

A few weeks later, the V-bomb attack on the London area developed and at a few hours' notice the Hospital ceased to be a Transit Hospital and was receiving instead convoys of air raid victims from London. Admissions as the result of local air raids were comparatively few and the Hospital itself suffered no structural damage.

THE YEAR'S WORK.

IN-PATIENTS.

Statistics on pages 29 will show that there have been fewer admissions to the general wards, which is partly due to the fact that, since the end of the war, there has been a gradual reduction in the number of beds required by the Ministry of Health under the Emergency Medical Service. Merrow Grange Auxiliary Hospital was closed on 1st September, 1945, and by the end of the year, the total number of beds in the hospital had dropped to 243 (including 19 for private patients), compared with 428 in 1944 and 216 in 1938 (including 22 private beds). Although the number of cases for which the Ministry of Health accepted financial responsibility steadily diminished, the volume of work for the civilian population continued to increase to an extent which presented the Committee with an exceedingly difficult problem. There are nearly 600 patients awaiting admission (including 170 cases for tonsillectomy) irrespective of emergency cases; the Hospital is working to its utmost capacity in spite of acute shortage of domestic staff—during one period of a few weeks, a ward of 20 beds had to be closed on that account. The adoption of the recommendations of the Rushcliffe Committee, which entailed a considerable increase of the Nursing Staff, has created great housing difficulties; the night nurses continue to be housed at Sunnysdown, on the Hog's Back, which, as a temporary measure, is expensive and not altogether satisfactory. Detail schemes of extension have been planned for the wards and for the nurses' homes, but it is unlikely that building of this nature will be possible for some time to come.

OUT-PATIENTS.

The return of the evacuees to London at the end of the war resulted in some reduction in the number of out-patients; the number of the Ministry of Health patients also decreased, but this was, to some extent, offset by the increasing number of patients referred by the Ministry of Pensions.

MINISTRY OF PENSIONS CASES.

An agreement was reached by the British Hospitals Association with the Ministry of Pensions, under which, as from 1st April, 1945, payment will be made by the Ministry of Pensions for hospital treatment of their patients on the basis of maintenance costs as shown in the Annual Report for the previous year, less such items as have been charged to the Ministry of Health.

REHABILITATION DEPARTMENT.

The Rehabilitation Department, which was started at the request of the Ministry of Health during the war, has become well established and is proving of great benefit to all classes of patients ; the out-patient attendance at the Occupational and Physio-therapy clinics during the past year amounted to almost half the total out-patient attendances.

EDUCATION ACT, 1944.

As from 1st April, 1945, the local County Education Authority becomes statutorily responsible for the cost of hospital treatment of children attending their schools. The Act came into force before any agreement could be made between hospitals and the local authorities as to the scale of charges and until negotiations can be concluded on a national basis, the Surrey Voluntary Hospitals and the Surrey County Council have agreed to an interim payment of 10s. per day for in-patients and 2s. per out-patient attendance towards maintenance costs of patients under the Act, excluding those admitted for tonsillectomy, for whom the original agreement remains in force.

CONVALESCENT HOMES.

The Convalescent Home at Bramley was closed on 31st October, 1945, and the Committee wish to record their appreciation of the kindness of Mrs. Gossage and the late Mr. Gossage in giving them the use throughout the war of the Manor House, with its pleasant garden, for convalescent patients ; upwards of 200 patients a year, including some from St. Thomas's Hospital at Hydestile, spent an average of a fortnight's convalescence at Bramley Manor, the successful results achieved being in great measure due to the valuable work of the Matron, Miss Cuming, and her staff.

The Shepherd Convalescent Home at Worthing was closed in 1939. Last year it was decided that, in view of the transport difficulties and the impossibility of obtaining domestic staff, steps should be taken to obtain permission from the Charity Commissioners for the premises to be sold. It was hoped, eventually, to use the proceeds for the purpose of establishing a more accessible convalescent home.

CATERING.

For some years the Committee have been anxious to bring the Catering Department into conformity with recognised modern hospital standards. A woman Catering Officer has been appointed and the department reorganised, but the shortage of kitchen and domestic staff, the continued rationing restrictions on food, and the

inadequate accommodation for serving meals and washing up, have somewhat hindered the development of schemes which the Catering Sub-Committee have had under consideration for further improvements.

DINING ROOM EXTENSIONS.

Plans prepared for the Committee by the well-known hospital architect, Mr. L. Pearson, for extensions to the staff dining room and the pantries, were deferred by the Ministry of Health, but a modified scheme has since been sanctioned for improvements to the pantries only, which will enable a dish-washing machine and other equipment to be installed and will greatly facilitate the serving of meals.

NURSES' CHAPEL.

A prefabricated type of building has been completed at a cost of £525, the whole of which, together with the cost of some of the furnishing, has been raised by the efforts of the Nursing Staff. Gifts of furniture have been received from many friends and it is hoped that services will be held in the Chapel in the near future.

FINANCE.

During the past year, the average cost per patient per week has risen to £5. 5s. 2d., compared with £3. 1s. 9d. in 1938. Receipts from voluntary sources showed an appreciable increase but were quite insufficient to balance the heavy increase in expenditure, most of which, though approved by, was completely outside the Committee's control. To maintain the Hospital services at full efficiency, all available securities amounting to £14,300 had to be sold, and there still remains, as the accounts show, a deficit of £15,043.

The Committee are most grateful to Messrs. Lloyds Bank for their generous help in enabling them to tide over the most serious financial crisis the Hospital has ever had to face.

APPEAL.

Towards the end of the year, an appeal for funds was launched which brought in £180 in annual subscriptions and £1,319 in donations. The uncertainty of the future of Voluntary Hospitals caused by the many uncontradicted Press reports of the Government's intention to take them over compulsorily was the undoubted cause of the poor response, many potential subscribers withholding their support until the position was clarified.

NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE.

At the time of issuing this Report, the Government Bill for the National Health Service had just been published, but beyond realising that it must mean confiscation of hospital property and endowments and a revolutionary change in administration, there has not been enough information to study its effect in detail. The Committee are, however, fully prepared to co-operate in any scheme which will result in the improved welfare of the patients; the experience of 80 years of such work in this Hospital confirms their belief that the Voluntary Hospital spirit is one of the essential provisions of a successful Health Service.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS.

It is impossible to mention individually all the kind friends of the Hospital whose voluntary services and gifts in kind have been so welcome, but the Committee are most grateful to them all, and also to the local Press for its consistent support.

The Committee also desires to thank the whole Staff—Medical, Nursing, Domestic and Administrative—for their valuable service and loyal co-operation throughout a year of many difficulties.

ALMONER'S DEPARTMENT

The Almoner's Department at the Royal Surrey County Hospital has two functions: social work, including advice and help for all patients who are in any difficulty or who are prescribed any appliance or special treatment which they would not otherwise be able to obtain, and the assessment and collection of patients' payments. It is difficult to compile statistics that give a true measure of the activities of a Social Service Department, but the figures below attempt to give a brief summary of both sides of the almoner's work.

The Committee would like to record their debt to all Voluntary agencies and statutory authorities who have co-operated most generously with the Almoner in assisting hospital patients throughout the year. They would particularly like to express appreciation of the Volunteer Car Pool, and its successor the Hospital Car Service, whose volunteer drivers have provided an unflinching Transport Service for patients too ill to travel in public conveyances.

The average length of stay of each patient was 9.78 days.

For Bramley, £123 7s.1d. was received in payment for maintenance from patients and their Approved Societies, and 6 patients were paid for by the Ministry of Health, through the Emergency Medical Service.

Bramley Manor was closed in October, 1945, and has been much missed. Since that time, however, all patients in need of convalescence have been successfully placed in other homes.

REPORT

OF THE

Committee of the Ladies' Linen League

OF THE

Royal Surrey County Hospital

FOR THE YEAR 1945

The Committee present the 38th Annual Report. Subscriptions amount to £233 19s.8d., slightly less than last year; interest on the P.O. Savings Bank was £12 15s.4d., and the amount now invested shows a total of £657 14s.7d.

The League has suffered a severe loss in the death of Mrs. Ricardo, President since 1924 and one of the Founders of the League in 1905. She always took a keen interest in the work and will be much missed by all on the Committee.

All Collecting Members and two Members from each district were invited to a Meeting in August at the Hospital. After the Meeting, Matrol provided tea and those who wished were shown round the Hospital and the new Rehabilitation Centre which has been started recently. Mrs. Eustace was elected President and various changes were noted among Collectors.

The death of Mrs. Venables, Collector for Blackheath and Chilworth, was recorded with regret: it was hoped Mrs. Steward would take up this district again.

It was with much regret the Meeting received the resignation of Miss Marshall, who, with members of her family, had collected in Godalming since 1905. It was hoped someone would be found to carry on the work.

It was agreed to spend £100 on Linen, etc., bought in from Merrow Grange Auxiliary Hospital, now closed, and to spend £74 7s.6d. on material.

A small Committee was appointed consisting of the President, Mrs. Odling Smee, Matron and Secretary to decide what Linen should be bought from the War Disposal Board when the surplus stores are released. Some of the funds in the P.O. Savings Bank will be used for this purpose.
