

THE Annual Report of the Rutland Memorial Cottage Hospital is issued for the third time since the opening of the new building in February, 1925. During the year the number of patients has increased to 177 as against 153 in 1926. There have been 77 major operations, 45 minor and 36 medical cases.

A most successful Bazaar was held on 23rd and 24th of February last to raise money to pay off the remaining debt on the Building of the Hospital amounting to £500. The large sum of £701 was raised by this means, the surplus being paid in to the current account of the Hospital. The Committee are most grateful to all who so kindly helped to make the Bazaar such a wonderful success, and they also wish to thank all those who so kindly patronised it.

A most successful egg week was held in May, which produced over 3,000 eggs, a slight increase on last year. The Annual Pound Day was held on November 2nd, and constituted quite a record, over £,70 being contributed in cash, 1700 lbs. in weight, besides apples and potatoes. The Committee desire to thank all those who did such splendid work in collecting and conveying the goods both on Pound Day, and during Egg Week and also those who so liberally contributed in money, goods and eggs.

The Hospital has again been most generously helped by proceeds from Church collections, Entertainments, Gifts from Harvest Festivals and gifts in kind, and the Committee tender their most hearty thanks to all who have supported them in these various ways, and also to those who have so diligently collected week by week for the Penny League.

The thanks of the Committee and patients are once more due to Sister Thompson for her unremitting care, and to the Staff who so loyally support her.

The Committee feel assured that they will receive during 1928 the same hearty support and help from the many kind friends of the Hospital that they have received in the past, and confidently count on the generosity which has been such a tremendous source of encouragement to them hitherto.
