



### Extract from Rules.

Every Annual Subscriber of one pound  $(\pounds_I)$  shall be entitled to recommend one patient yearly and have one vote at the Annual Meeting and be entitled to recommend one patient for every pound  $(\pounds_I)$  subscribed and shall have one vote for every ten pounds  $(\pounds_I)$  in addition to the first  $(\pounds_I)$ .

A Donor of twenty-five pounds  $(\pounds_{25})$  to be called a "Life Donor" shall be entitled to recommend one patient annually and shall have one vote for life and so on in like proportion.

In order to obtain admission a patient must first obtain a recommendation from a Life Donor, Subscriber or Donor.

The charge for each male patient shall be twenty-one shillings (21/-) per week and for each female patient seventeen shillings and six-pence (17 6) per week for board and lodging, payable in advance, which shall cover all expenses except washing and medical requisites.

All applications must be accompanied by a letter from a Justice of the Peace, Clergyman, Minister or other responsible person, to whom the applicant is well-known, stating his or her inability to pay more than the Hospital iee of 21/- for males and 17/6 for females per week, also by a Medical Certificate or Statement as to the complaint from which the applicant is suffering.
