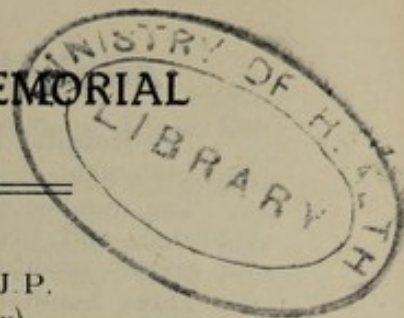

## ANNUAL REPORT OF HOSPITAL BOARD

The Hospital Board have pleasure in presenting the 12th Annual Report and Statement of Accounts, for the year ending December 31st, 1933.

The number of patients admitted during the year was the highest yet recorded, and the extra accommodation provided by the Extension, with the greater facilities for treatment of cases, has been of considerable value.

Three hundred and thirteen In-Patients have been admitted, and 130 Out-Patients were treated; X-Ray cases, including Barium Meal examinations, numbered 128; there were 56 casualties, 10 of these being road accidents. Of the cases treated, 171 operations were performed, 100 of which were by the visiting Honorary Surgeons. The Medical cases treated numbered 57. There were 5 deaths.

One hundred and thirty-four children were admitted to the Children's Ward, and 119 women and 60 men to the other wards. The private patients numbered 5.

The total stay of patients in Hospital has been 3,952 days, being 1,561 days in excess of any previous year, the average stay of each patient being 12.62 days. The average weekly cost of each patient was £2 15s. 5d.

By a reference to the list of cases treated, it will be observed that a considerable number of serious cases have received treatment with satisfactory results.

The increased demands made on the services of the visiting Surgeons have been considerable, and the Board once more desire to record their appreciation and thanks to the Hon. Consulting Surgeons and the Medical Staff for their whole-hearted services to the Hospital.

The care and devotion of the Nursing Staff to their duties has been much appreciated, and the Board desire to thank the Matron and her Staff for the services so ably rendered in all departments. The serious nature of many cases, together with the large increase of patients, has called for much self-sacrifice by the Staff in carrying out their arduous duties. The assistance rendered by members of the 16th Essex V.A.D. throughout the year has been most valuable, and those concerned are warmly thanked for their services, as are also the members of the 7th Essex (Men's Detachment).

The collectors and supervisors of the weekly contributions continue to do admirable work, and their onerous task is greatly appreciated. Sincere thanks are extended to those whose names appear under the various lists of subscriptions, donations, etc., in this report.

The Board desire to express their warmest thanks for the generous support received from the various bodies who have organised events for the funds of the Hospital, special mention being made of the following: The Bakers' and Sweeps' Charity Match, Waltham Abbey Chamber of Commerce, Waltham and Cheshunt Hospital Carnival Committee, Waltham Hospital Football Cup Committee, Toc H Concert Committee, Junior Imperial League, Garden Fete per Mrs. Brenton, Children's Cot Fund, and Lecture by Miss Warburton.

Grants have been received from the Alexandra Rose Day Fund, League of Mercy, Stock Exchange Dramatic and Operatic Society, and the British Charities' Association, to all of whom thanks are accorded.

The Annual Flag Day collection organised by Mrs. Smith showed a small increase over last year, and the Board tender their thanks to all concerned for their efforts.

The Alexandra Rose Day collection was again well supported, and the Board express their gratitude to all those who kindly assisted.

The annual Pound Day continues to be a valuable help to the Hospital. Gifts in kind amounting to about 700 lbs. were received, with the addition of £9 15s. 8d. in money. Sincere thanks are expressed to all who helped to achieve this splendid result, and particularly to the staffs and scholars of the local schools, whose efforts are deserving of much praise.

The Linen Guild, organised by Miss Lee, has again rendered great service during the year. In addition to the sum of £2 13s., which was collected and spent on replacing worn-out stock, the following articles



were sent to the Hospital by Miss Lee: 14 Towels, 6 Teacloths, 8 Pillow Cases, 14 Dusters, 6 Handkerchiefs, 1 Traycloth, 2 Packets of Paper Serviettes, and 2 Counterpanes.

The Board are most grateful to the many friends who have manifested their interest in the work of the Hospital by sending gifts, including the Harvest Festival produce from the various religious denominations. These gifts have, by the kindness of the local Press, been acknowledged from time to time during the year.

The continued kindness of Mr. H. O. Larsen is much appreciated, as also the help given by Mr. Bolton, Mr. Digby, and many others who have assisted in divers ways.

A very successful Garden Fete was held in the grounds of Joyce House, through the kindness of Mr. and Mrs. G. Gray, to whom most hearty thanks are expressed. The fete was opened by Mrs. W. E. Tanner, who was supported by Mr. W. E. Tanner and Mr. W. Ibbotson, members of the Medical Staff, Hospital Board, and others. It is desired to record appreciation and thanks to all those who assisted by their united efforts to make the event such a splendid success, and particularly the Honorary Organising Secretaries, Mrs. Bond and Mrs. Walsham, and Mrs. Courtney, the Chairman of the Organising Committee. The sum realised was £150 15s. 3d., which amount was allocated to the Extension Fund.

Visits made to the Hospital by the clergy and ministers of the various denominations have been much appreciated by the patients.

The resignation of Mr. A. H. Bavister as Hon. Treasurer, owing to his leaving the district, was accepted with regret, and Mr. Bavister is thanked for his services in the past. Mr. H. W. Ellwood has kindly undertaken to fill the vacancy.

Mr. Larsen was unanimously appointed as Chairman of the Board, in the place of Sir T. F. Buxton, Bt., who tendered his resignation last year. The following members of the Board retire by rotation, and are eligible for re-election: Miss M. B. Lee, Mrs. E. Smith, Mr. W. Sherman, and Mr. H. O. Larsen.

Once more we are indebted to Mr. J. Eve and Mr. J. W. Wigney for their valuable services in auditing the accounts.

As will be observed from the Statement of Accounts, the Hospital has derived substantial benefits from the Hospital Saving Association, and Hospital Saturday Fund, for services rendered to their members.

The attention of members of contributing societies, and others, is particularly drawn to the cost of medical services which the Hospital is called upon to meet in respect of expenses incurred by visits of the Hon. Consulting Surgeons and medical staff for operations.

The benefits obtained by the patients in having the valuable assistance and skill of the Surgeons in their own local Hospital when they undergo treatment cannot be under-estimated, and is much to be appreciated. The Hospital Board are most grateful to those who have shown their appreciation by making donations to the Hospital Funds.

The Board have, during the past year, been compelled to arrange for an overdraft at the bank, as sufficient funds were not available to meet the final payments for the extension. The Board are especially anxious that this overdraft may be cleared as soon as possible, and therefore appeal to all who have the welfare of the Hospital at heart, particularly those who have not yet subscribed, to assist in relieving the Hospital of this financial burden. The Board have every confidence that when this overdraft is extinguished the ordinary income will balance expenditure.

A list of donations to the Extension Fund is included in this report under the various headings of the collectors, etc., and the Board are most grateful to those who have contributed to the fund in any way, and also to those who undertook the collection of subscriptions in the various districts.

The total cost of the Extension was £2,671 12s. 6d., and towards this amount £2,058 10s. 5d. has been received, leaving a balance of £613 2s. 1d. to be raised to clear the debt. In addition, the interest on the overdraft to date amounts to £15 7s. 1d.\* The cost of furnishing the new part of the



Hospital is not included in the above amount. This work was undertaken by the lady members of the Board, and about £150 was required for the purpose, this expense being met from the Suspense Account. A list of those who have helped with gifts of money or kind are included elsewhere in this report, and are warmly thanked.

A review of the Income and Expenditure for the Maintenance of the Hospital during the past year shows that the increase of expenditure over the previous year amounts to £236 18s. 4d., whilst the Income is increased by £127 10s. 5d., leaving a deficit for the year of £151 6s. 2d.

In conclusion, it is realised that the enlarged Hospital must necessarily mean increased cost for maintenance, but the Board feel confident that the additions made cannot fail to assist the work at the Hospital and provide greater facilities for those requiring treatment, and that the necessary increased support will be forthcoming to enable the work to be carried on with efficiency.

## RULES.

### MANAGEMENT.

The Waltham Abbey War Memorial Cottage Hospital shall be managed and controlled by a Hospital Board of 12 persons (6 men and 6 women), in addition to the President, Medical Officers, Hon. Treasurer, and Hon. Secretary. A Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall be appointed.

(2) The Hospital Board (5 of which shall form a quorum) shall appoint all Committees, including a House Committee and a Finance Committee (3 to form a quorum). The President, Chairman, and Vice-Chairman, Hon. Treasurer, and Hon. Secretary, shall be ex-officio members of all Committees.

(3) The Hospital Board shall meet every month to receive reports from the House and Finance Committees.

(4) There shall be an Annual Meeting of Subscribers in February, when the audited accounts of the Hospital shall be submitted. All officers and 4 members of the Board (2 men and 2 women) to retire annually, but shall be eligible for re-election. The new officers and new members of the Board to be elected at the Annual Meeting of subscribers, but vacancies which occur during the year to be filled up by the Hospital Board.

(5) Annual subscriptions to become due on the 1st January in each year.

(6) Persons afflicted with Alcoholism, Mania, Epilepsy, Infectious, Contagious, Tuberculous, or Incurable Disease, shall not be admitted, nor any woman in an advanced state of pregnancy.

(7) New rules or alterations to existing rules or nominations can be proposed at the Annual Meeting by giving written notice to the Hon. Secretary at least 14 days before the day of meeting.

### PATIENTS' FEES.

Subscribers to pay a minimum fee of 1s. 6d. per day.

Non-Subscribers to pay a minimum fee of 4s. per day.

Children under 14 years of age pay half the above fees.

The X-ray fee to be at least 10s. 6d. Subscribers 5s. 6d.

Ex-service men will receive special consideration.

Patients in the Private Ward to pay a minimum fee of

£4 4s. per week for Subscribers; £5 5s. Non-Subscribers.

Out-Patients' fee for Subscribers, 6d. each dressing;

Non-Subscribers, 1s.

The House Committee shall have power to consider fees for necessitous cases.

### HOUSE COMMITTEE.

(1) The House Committee shall consist of 6 members elected from the Hospital Board (3 of which shall form a quorum) with the Medical Officer in charge for the month.

(2) The House Committee shall be responsible under the Hospital Board for the management of the Hospital, and shall perform such duties as the Hospital Board shall from time to time prescribe, and shall report all proceedings to the Board.

(3) The House Committee shall not incur any expenditure without the special authority of the Hospital Board, unless in case of emergency, when a sum not exceeding £5 may be spent.

(4) A case book shall be kept by the Matron, containing the name, age, occupation, nature of complaint, medical attendant, date of admission and discharge of patient.

(5) No food shall be introduced into the Hospital by visitors without the consent of the Matron or Sister in charge.

(6) Relatives and friends may visit children, and patients on the danger list, at the discretion of the Matron. Visiting days to be Wednesdays, 2 p.m. to 3.45 p.m., and Sundays, 2 p.m. to 3.45 p.m.

(7) Alterations may be made from time to time to these Rules by order of the Hospital Board.
