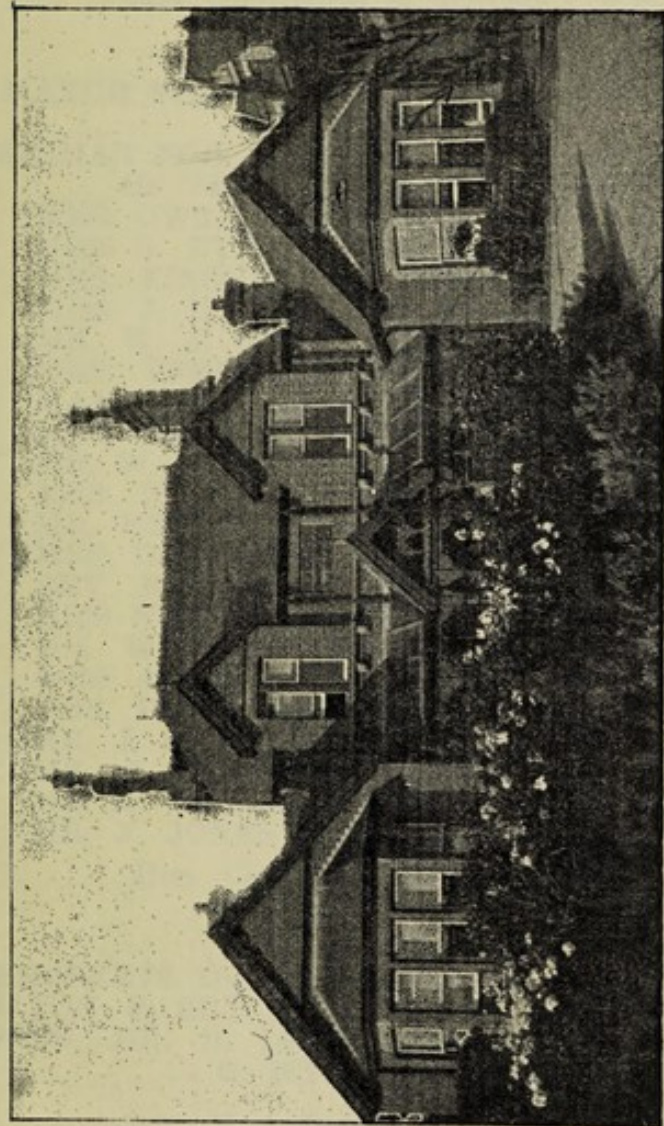

# CAERNARVON COTTAGE HOSPITAL.

## RULES

### I.

The Institution shall be called "The Caernarvon Cottage Hospital."

### II.

The Hospital is intended for the reception of persons suffering from accidents or diseases, which cannot be adequately treated at the homes of the Patients. No children under the age of fifteen shall be admitted to the Hospital, except in cases of emergency, when a private ward (if available) shall be prepared for his or her reception. No midwifery cases or persons labouring under contagious or incurable diseases shall be admitted.

### III.

The Hospital shall be under the management of an Executive Committee of 24 Members, 12 of whom shall be Ladies, and 12 Gentlemen, and who shall be elected annually by Life Members and Subscribers of 10/6 and upwards. The President, Vice-President, Honorary Medical Officers, and Trustees, the Honorary Secretary, and the Honorary Treasurer, being Ex-Officio Members. The said Executive Committee shall have power to nominate such Sub-Committees from among their number as they shall from time to time think proper and desirable, who shall meet as required and report to the Executive Committee. Any vacancies occurring during the year after the Annual Meeting, and prior to the next Annual Meeting, shall be filled up by the Committee.

### IV.

The Annual Meeting shall be held in the month of July, at which the Report of the Committee, and Statement of Receipts and Expenditure for the past year, shall be presented, the Committee and Officers shall be appointed, and, when needful, alterations of the Rules shall be made, but no alterations of the Rules shall be made unless notice thereof be given in the Circular convening the Meeting.

### V.

The Committee shall meet at the Hospital at least once in every two months, but the Honorary Secretary shall call a Special Meeting at any time on the written request of the Chairman, or two Members of the Committee. Three Members shall form a quorum.

### VI.

The Committee shall have full power to elect and dismiss all Officers and Servants of the Institution.

### VII.

No gentleman shall be elected on the Medical Staff of the Hospital unless he possesses the legal qualifications required by the Ministry of Health.

### VIII.

The Medical Department shall be under the control and superintendence of the Medical Officers of the Hospital, subject to the Committee.

### IX.

Each Donor of £10 10s. 0d. and upwards, shall be a Life Member, and shall have annually for every ten guineas contributed, one nomination paper, and each Annual Subscriber of £1 1s. 0d. and upwards shall have one nomination paper for each guinea subscribed, upon payment of his or her Subscription due the 1st day of July in each year. Every Subscriber of One Guinea,



and for each additional Guinea shall have the power to nominate one Patient for a period of 14 days, upon payment by such Patient or his guarantor of the weekly fees, which may from time to time be fixed by the Executive Committee, in accordance with Rule X.

#### X.

Except as provided for in Rule XIV., Patients shall only be admitted to the Hospital upon production of a nomination paper properly filled in, and upon payment of the sum of 12/6 per week, payable in advance from the date of their admission to the Hospital, until the date of their discharge, and failing another nomination paper at the end of the first 14 days, and every subsequent 14 days each Patient shall pay a weekly fee of £1 5s. 0d., payable in advance, provided that the Executive Committee shall have power at their discretion to increase the said weekly fees, and also in special cases to remit or reduce the same. No Patient shall be readmitted to the Hospital under a period of three months, and applicants for admission may be called upon to produce a certificate from the Relieving Officer that they are not in receipt of parish relief. Private Patients shall pay a weekly fee of Five Guineas, and also the cost of any extra nurse or nurses, who may have to be engaged in consequence of such Private Patients being in the Hospital. No Patient in the Public Wards shall in any case be charged professional fees, save in most exceptional cases, and with the express consent of the Committee.

#### XI.

No person shall take part in the proceedings of the Hospital, nor be entitled to any privileges as a Subscriber, unless his subscription for the current year has been paid.

#### XII.

Every Clergyman or Nonconformist Minister, who shall transmit to the Treasurer a collection made by him to the amount of One Guinea, shall be entitled for the current year to the same privileges as an Annual Subscriber of One Guinea.

#### XIII.

No Patient shall be admitted without a printed recommendation signed by a Subscriber, and countersigned by a Member of the Hospital Medical Staff. The time of every Patient's discharge shall be left to the discretion of the Medical Officer attending the case, who must however report in writing to the Committee should the time exceed two months.

#### XIV.

In cases of accidents or emergency, the Matron or any Member of the Hospital Medical Staff, shall be authorised to suspend the foregoing Rules respecting the admission of Patients, so as to occasion no delay.

#### XV.

Every requisite, except personal clothing, will be provided in the Hospital. Patients shall submit to the Regulations of the Hospital, and not receive food or drink from any other source, without the sanction of a Medical Officer.

#### XVI.

The Hospital, Land and Buildings, and all property devoted to the use of the Hospital, and all Legacies bequeathed to it, shall be vested in Trustees, who shall invest or otherwise deal with such Legacies under the direction of the Committee. The Trustees for the time being shall be indemnified out of the property of the Hospital against all losses and expenses which they may incur or sustain as Trustees.

#### XVII.

The first Trustees were Mr. John Jones, Minafon; Dr. Watkin Roberts, and Mr. John Owen, Ty Coch. All subsequent Trustees shall be elected at the Annual Meeting, or at a General Meeting of Life Members and Annual Subscribers of 10s. 6d. and upwards, convened for that purpose. The present Trustees are the Hon. F. G. Wynn, Glynllifon; Mr. J. E. Greaves, Glangwna, and Mr. Charles A. Jones.



## CAERNARVON COTTAGE HOSPITAL.

### Thirty-ninth Annual Report for the Year ended the 30th June, 1927.

#### TO THE SUBSCRIBERS,—

The Committee has pleasure in presenting its Thirty-ninth Annual Report and Balance Sheet.

A Review of the work of the Hospital for the year which ended on the 30th June, 1927, shows that its usefulness is well maintained. During the year 230 cases were admitted into the Hospital:—111 Males and 119 Females. Of these cases 32 were medical (18 Males and 14 Females) and 198 Surgical (94 Males and 104 Females). Of these:—

156 were discharged as having been cured.

52 were discharged improved or relieved.

14 died, leaving 8 in the Hospital at end of the year.

The average stay of the Patients in the Hospital was 17 days.

The districts from which the Patients have been received are as follows:—

50 from Caernarvon.

19 from Nantlle, Penygroes, and Llandwrog.

32 from Rhostryfan, Groeslon, and Bontnewydd.

41 from Llanberis, Llanrug, and Deiniolen.

21 from Rhyd-ddu, Waenfawr, and Caeathraw.

19 from Clynog and South Caernarvonshire.

21 from Pwllheli, Criccieth, and Portmadoc districts.

9 from Bangor, Portdinorwic, and Bethesda.

10 from Anglesey, and

8 from other districts.

The Committee is pleased to report that during the year the Hospital has maintained its satisfactory financial position. The total income amounted to £1,342 11s. 0d. as against £1,353 15s. 3d. last year, whilst the expenditure amounted to £1416 0s. 7d. as against £1,323 14s. 6d., leaving a balance in hand of £68 14s. 9d. to be carried forward to the current financial year. The increased expenditure is accounted for chiefly by the larger number of cases admitted. Donations amounted to £106 19s. 5d., and the Receipts under the heading "Collections" amounted to £176 14s. 0d. Annual Subscriptions amounted to £311 18s. 0d.

The Annual "House to House" Collection was again a record, and amounted to £109 14s. 0d. as compared with £94 18s. 0d. last year. The Collection has now become an important item on the credit side of the Accounts. To all the Ladies who assisted in the Collection, the Committee beg to tender their sincerest thanks for the very hard work which it involved.



The Committee has again to mourn the loss of several friends and supporters, including three colleagues:—Sir Thomas E. Roberts a Vice-President, and one of its most valued supporters. Dr. Robert Parry, the senior and one of the original Medical Officers of the Hospital, and Mrs. Jackson, Highfield, all of whom had proved themselves faithful and valued members, and whose places it will be difficult adequately to fill.

The Committee is pleased to announce that under the Will of the late Lady Turner, of Parkia, a legacy of £250 was bequeathed by her to the Hospital. By her Will, Lady Turner also directed that certain of her property was to be sold, and the proceeds appropriated amongst charitable institutions to be selected by her Executors. The latter, Messrs. W. H. Bell and G. A. J. Bell knowing the interest which Lady Turner took in the Caernarvon Cottage Hospital, have very kindly given £2,000 out of this fund to the Institution. Your Committee have commemorated this munificent gift by devoting its income to the provision of a free bed in the Hospital, and by erecting a Tablet on its walls in memory of Lady Turner.

Your Committee is also pleased to report that the late Sir Thomas E. Roberts, of Plasbybryn, bequeathed a legacy of £500 to the Institution. Both these sums, under the settled policy of your Committee, have been placed to the Hospital Capital Account, and not to Income Account, so that the donors may be associated in perpetuity with their gifts to the Hospital. As will be seen from the Accounts at the end of the Report, the amount received up to date by the Hospital from legacies, and invested in the names of the Trustees amount to the sum of £4,276 6s. 1d.

Your Committee tenders its cordial thanks to the many friends who assisted them in the work by their various gifts in kind to the Hospital during the past year. They are most acceptable, and your Committee hope that this interest in Hospital work will continue to increase during the coming year.

The thanks of your Committee are offered to the various hospital funds for their donations, also to the Trustees of Moriah Chapel, and the Caernarvon Male Voice Choir for the proceeds of Concerts held by them.

The Buildings, Equipment, and also all Medical and Surgical Appliances have been efficiently maintained during the year.

In conclusion the Committee desires once more to thank the Clergy, Ministers and Congregations of the several places of Worship, who have contributed to the funds of the Hospital by their offertories during the year, and to place on record its sincere appreciation of the work of the Honorary Medical and Dental Staff, and to the Matron (Miss Miriam Mason) and her Staff for their unremitting attention to their onerous and responsible duties.
