REPORT.

The Managers present a Report for the Year ending March 25th, 1928.

The number of In-Patients has been 117, with an average stay of 16 days each. There have been 106 Out-Patients involving 856 visits for treatment.

Ninety-eight operations have been performed.

The general result is 170 cured, 42 relieved, 5 transferred, 1 died after 2 hours in Hospital and 5 remain undischarged.

In the District 395 cases have been attended and 2,637 visits paid. There have been 20 Maternity Cases.

By the death of Dr. Rogers, the Senior Medical Officer, the Hospital has sustained a severe loss. His constant attention and unfailing kindness won the esteem and affection of all.

The Managers gratefully acknowledge the kindness of all those who have so generously supplied the Hospital with Electric Light and also with a Wireless Set.

Their thanks, too, are due to the many friends who have organised Entertainments for the benefit of the Hospital, and for the many valuable gifts in kind received during the year.

The Managers desire to express their thanks to the Medical Officers, who have so generously given their services, and to the Matron and Staff for their unfailing care and attention bestowed on the Patients.

RULES.

1. The object of the Institution is the treatment, at a low rate of payment, of working men and women suffering from illness or accident. The Hospital area is Ellesmere Rural Parish and five miles round the building.

2. The Hospital Year ends on March 25th, at which date the Accounts will be audited, and a Report drawn up for presentation at the Annual General Meeting, to be held every May. Subscriptions are due on January 1st in each year.

3. Three of the Managers, also the Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary, all of whom are eligible for re-election, to retire every March.

4. No person will be admitted to the Hospital who is of unsound mind, or is suffering from an infectious or incurable complaint, habitual u'cers, or consumption, nor, as a rule, any pauper, or any child under four years of age. Cases that can be sufficiently well treated at home not to be admitted.

5. Doctors shall be allowed to charge for attendance on any patients other than working-men and those dependent on them; but in every such case the Doctor shall intimate his intention to do so, in writing, to the Managers.

6. Scale of Charges for Patients, subject to variations under special circumstances:—

Workmen, and those dependent on them, One Shilling a Day.
Seven Shillings to be deposited upon admission.

Domestic Servants from houses where not more than two are kept, 1/6 a Day.

From houses with more than two, and less than five,
Two Shillings a Day.

From houses with five or more, Three Shillings a Day.

A Private Room can be supplied for Patients, from Three Guineas a week, to include the ordinary services of the Hospital. If an additional Nurse or any extras may be required, and be ordered by the Doctor, they shall be charged for in addition.

7. No Patient to remain in Hospital longer than one month without permission from the Doctor in attendance, and not longer than two months without the consent of the Managers.

8. Three Managers, in rotation, are appointed to visit the Hospital a week at a time. It shall be the duty of one or more of the Visitors to verify the inventory twice a year—in March and September.

9. On a deposit of One Shilling, Bath Chairs, Bed Rests and Crutches are lent, when not in use, to working-men, and can be hired out to others—Bath Chairs, 6d. a day, or 2/6 a week; Shelter, 2/6 a week; Bed Rests and Crutches, 1/- a week. No other appliances or property shall, on any consideration, be removed from the building.

10. The Managers will not be responsible for any funeral expenses.

11. Visiting Hours: Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays, 2 to 4

DISTRICT NURSE RULES.

1. The District to be served lies within a radius of two miles from the Hospital, and is shown on the map. The Nurse is not required to go beyond the limits of the Urban District of Ellesmere, except in Emergency and Maternity cases.

2. Fees to be charged to Patients outside the Urban District to be settled in each case by the Hospital Committee.

3. The Nurse to work not more than eight hours daily—except in cases of emergency.

4. The Nurse not to sit up two nights in succession in the District or Hospital, and to be allowed proper rest during the day following a night's work.

5. Applications for the services of the Nurse to be made at the Hospital. Any complaints against her to be made to the Secretary of the Hospital Committee, and not to the Nurse.

6. When engaged at any house, the Nurse shall carry out the instructions of the Medical Attendant. She is forbidden to talk about her cases, and is not allowed to receive either money or presents from her patients.

7. The Nurse shall be allowed three weeks' holiday during the year. Her engagement may be terminated by a month's notice on either side. She must not practise on her own account within ten miles of Ellesmere after leaving.

8. The Nurse must report in her Day-Book every visit she makes, and Case she attends, and show her book weekly to the Secretary. She will not attend infectious cases.

9. The Matron may send the Nurse out of the District in special cases of emergency, provided that her regular work permits. In these cases it is expected that the Nurse be fetched and sent home.
