- 153 *Very interesting old banner of coloured silks measuring 9 feet by 5 feet 6 inches, and emblazoned as to one-half with the Royal Arms of England with the heraldic label pertaining to the second son of the sovereign, while the other half bears the arms of the Royal House of Saxe-Meiningen; also a large silk sheet or covering, measuring 12 feet by 8 feet, ornamented with various emblems as borne on the Royal Standard. These were formerly used on the State Barge of the Duke and Duchess of Clarence (afterwards King William IV. and Queen Adelaide) in the days of Royal processions, etc., by water, on the Thames*
