When Professor Petrie first discovered the remains of these people, thinking that they were invaders, he termed them the "New Race"
- 197 Prehistoric hanging vase, Egypt, date 5000 to 6000 B.C., made previous to the Egyptian dynasties by the Neolithic "New Race"
- 198 Seven spear heads from the Soudan
- 199 Antique sword and scabbard, and skin shield
- 200 Piece of railing from Palace of Kartoum
- 201 Revolver, in oak case

- 202 Glass electric wheel, set of scales, antique belt and 2 lamps
- 203 Very early Chinese fountain in form of rockery, Chinese temples and birds, measuring 24 inches by 16, and box containing part of elephant's tooth, petrified bone, and 12 pieces of ore, petrified wood, etc.

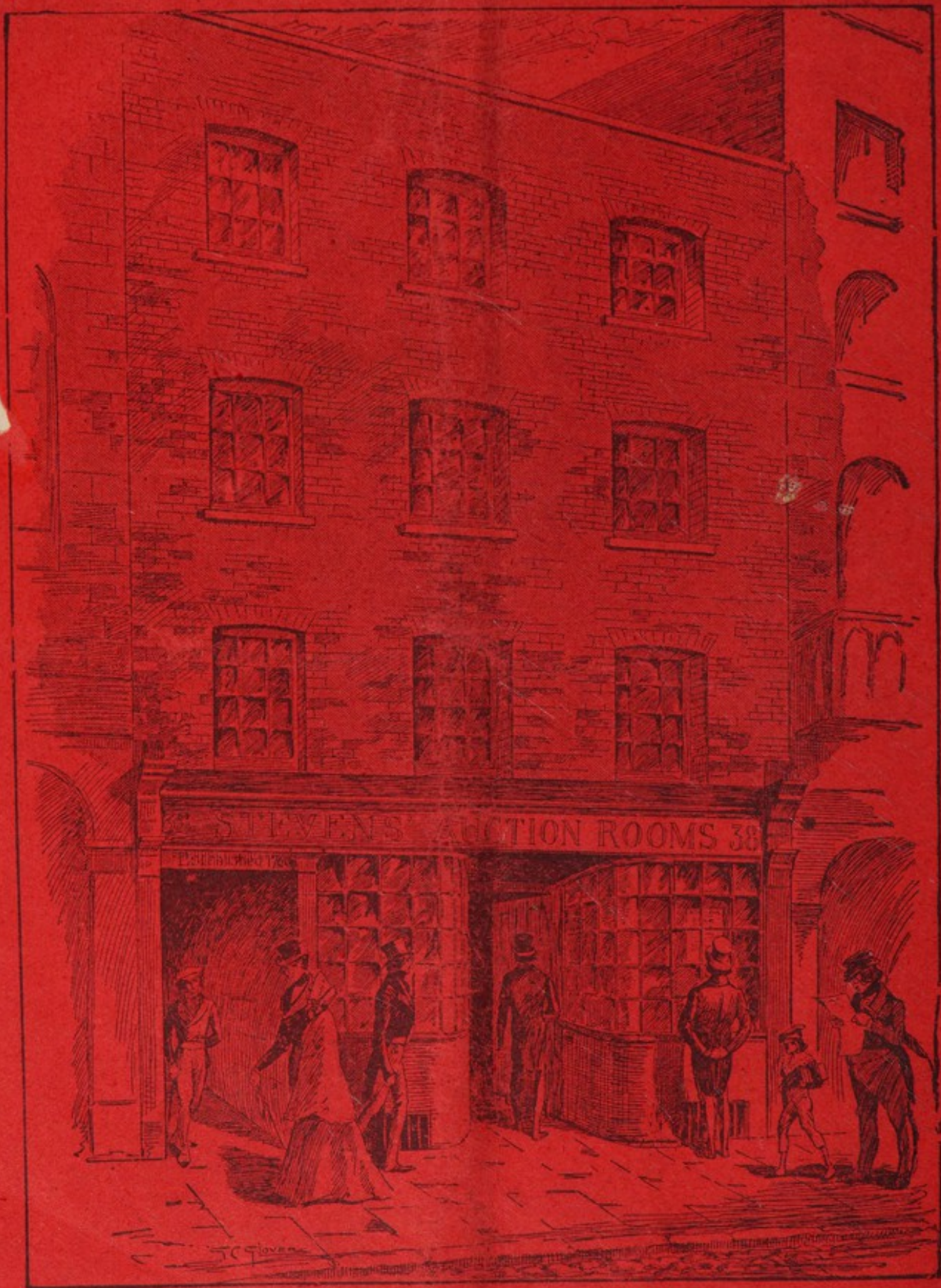
