CONDITIONS OF SALE.

THIRD.—The lots are to be taken away and paid for, whether genuine and authentic or not, with all faults and errors of description, the day after the sale; Messrs. FOSTER not being responsible for the correct description, genuineness, or authenticity of any lot.
