

- Fine Sinhalese devil-dancing mask representing the chief demon of disease
- Another of unusual type, with a large cobradicapello issuing from the top
- Another, very rare form, having 3 human figures upright on the head
- [Note.—These masks are from a very old collection, and are of fine workmanship. They were used to cure sick persons by inducing the disease to leave the sufferer.]

Extremely rare and fine antique brass mask of Hanuman, the Hindu god and king of the monkeys, worn in the Dasera Drama

Two Madagascar charm sticks, a curious representation of the god Shongo, W. Africa, and a Ju-ju dancing paddle from Benin

Fetish staff and a pair of fetish axes in wood, from Dahomy. These are interesting, as showing the survival of the idea of the stone axes

Finely carved Samoan club, with unusual designs of animals, fish, men, etc.

Curious old New Zealand chief's waha-ika, with a fetish figure on the side

Fine carved Taiaha of a Rangatira, being his emblem of rank. Specimen with the taure awe of red feathers and dog's hair are very seldom seen

A Tewhatewha used by the Kai-tuhi or timekeeper in a canoe, to give time to the paddles

Rare and very curious club from Samoa, from a collection formed prior to 1824

Four South Sea carved clubs, ditto paddle, and a Fiji dancing wand (scarce)

Four rare Laka Kare charms to keep off evil spirits from the Papual Gulf district, New Guinea. No woman was allowed to see them

Curious dancing wand with a Janus head, used in certain religious ceremonies on Bougainville Is.

Fiji Tambua, or currency, also used as a messenger's guarantee, and a piece of currency from the Congo

Two very interesting and scarce "Messages from one W. African chief to another." Collected by Sir J. A. Moloney
