- 106 **Tete (prow)**. This tete was formerly the prow of a Maori war canoe named Komarurua. It was built and this tete carved at Mangatapu, near Tauranga, by the Whanaupanui tribe. The canoe was only used in one fight at Oruamatua, in the Bay of Plenty, it was sold after to the Ngatiti tribe, in 1830, for two casks of rum and a double-barrelled gun, its length was 74 feet; on June 23rd, 1893, when owner last saw it, it was entirely rotten, at Mercury Bay. The prow was painted with European paint and kept in a raupo whare (thatched shed). The tete is cut out of one solid block of Totara timber. There are none of these prows left amongst the Maoris, and can only be seen in Museums or private collections
