- THIRD.—The lots are to be taken away and paid for, whether genuine and authentic or not, with all faults and errors of description the day after the sale; Messrs. Foster not being responsible for the correct description, genuineness or authenticity of any lot.
- FOURTH.—To prevent inaccuracy in delivery and inconvenience in the settlement of the purchases, no lot can be transferred, nor can any lot be removed during the time of sale; each buyer must pay for the whole of his purchases before any lot is removed.
