CONDITIONS OF SALE.

THIRD.—The lots are to be taken away and paid for, whether genuine and authentic or not, with all faults and errors of description, the day after the sale ; Messrs. FOSTER not being responsible for the correct description, genuineness, or authenticity of any lot.

FOURTH.—To prevent inaccuracy in delivery and inconvenience in the settlement of the purchases, no lot can be transferred, nor can any lot be removed during the time of sale. Each buyer must pay for the whole of his purchases before any lot is removed.

FIFTH.—All lots uncleared within the time aforesaid may be re-sold by public or private sale, when or where the vendors think proper, without notice to the defaulter ; and the deficiency (if any), and the expenses attending such re-sale, and any other loss the vendor may sustain, shall be made good by the defaulter, but this condition is without prejudice to the vendor enforcing the purchase, whether a deposit has been paid or not.

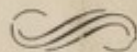

- 355 A pair of mahogany and inlaid chairs with carved and pierced splats and top rails, and 1 other inlaid, with arms, on tapered legs and toes

- 356 An ebonised jardiniere stand on fluted pillar and square base, a mahogany towel airer, and an oxydised fender and 3 fire implements
- 357 An American walnut sideboard, 8 drawers in the frieze and cupboards under, continued back with mirror panels and shelves, and cornice over, on pilaster supports, *5ft. wide*
- 358 An American walnut dining table with extra leaf
- 359 An ebonised square-back chair, with arms carved in acanthus foliage, on turned legs and stretchers, seat and back upholstered in flowered tapestry

- 363 A barometer and thermometer in oak frame
