- 54 DRI-GUG, or Temple Chopper, having an iron blade with silver ornamental grip surmounted by a silver dorje
- 55 KHA-TRAM-KA, or Magic Sceptre, an iron shaft surmounted by the following in native silver:— an ambrosial vase (khatvnga), two heads, a skull, and an upright dorje, or vajra
- 56 TRASHIS-GO-MANG, or Portable Shrine, painted red with a coloured design on base; the central shrine contains a brass seated Buddha holding the chalice of life, the remainder are painted reproductions of deities. Yellow Hat Sect.

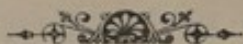
