





Bound in as fly-leaf to this work is the following valuable Memorandum of an ELIZABETHAN TRAVELLING PHYSICIAN :---

"Whereas yt hathe bene reported by certaine maletious persones that ther ys certayne phesesyons and Chururgins and none of them good Thes therefor ar to lett all men understand for my dyscharge that occacon doth serue that I must depart from this towne and yf ther be anye man or woman wthin this towne of Richmond or Richmond shyre or Newcastell where I remayned last for the space of xviij wekes and now here for the space of ij monthes & odde dayes that if I haue in the places abouesaid taken anye money of anye person and not performed my convenaunt or discharged my cure accordinglie that they come now to my ost house at Willm. Atkinsons And ther I am redie for everye grote so receyved to restore yt duble Least they haue occacon to report the lyke by me after my departure Written this xxiiij of October By me Walter Doctor & chyrurgion & practyser in phesicke & Srvant etc."

Written in manuscript on 1 page, 8vo.

This appears to be the physician's original copy of a notice probably cried by the common crier on the doctor's arrival in a new town. It was possibly kept on the fly-leaf of a book more as a draft for future reference than as a memorandum of the actual occasion. We learn by it that the doctor stayed 18 weeks in the important northern town of Newcastle and in Richmondshire (Yorks.). The value of this document of the embryonic period of modern medicine is enhanced by the fact that it is prefixed to a medical tract. It is an exceedingly early manuscript example of medical advertising.



There can be no doubt that this codex is copied from very good and authentic originals, since each treatise ends with the full subscription of the author with the date of composition. This tends to show that the MSS. from which Langkamer copied his text went back to a very genuine source.

For instance, the first subscription, that to the Ars Generalis on fol. 62 reads in full:

"Incepta fuit hec sciencia in mari in portu Tunicij (Tunis) in medio Septembris Anno Incarnacionis Millesimo ducentesimo nonagesimo tercio (1293) et fuit finita in eodem anno in Octobri Apiphanie in Civitate Neapolis ad honorem domini dei nostri et beate virginis Marie.

Scripta sunt hec per Stephanum Lannkchammer de Patavia, clericum eiusdem doicesis, Anno MCCCCLIIII. in die sanctissimi principis apostolorum beati Petri ad Vincula, in opido Prawnaw, duce Ludwico regnante per Bauoariam."


