Horatio Nelson Rivers, by whom it is offered for sale

The identical flag (Union Jack) from out of H.M.S. 92 "Victory," which was used to cover the shell containing 190 games the remains of the immortal Nelson, when conveyed by water to lay in state in Pain'ed Hall of Greenwich Hospital the 24th December, 1805. After the funeral the flag was presented to Lieut. Wm. Rivers, who was .I.D.C. to Lord Nelson at the Battle of Trafalgar, and afterwards Adjutant of Greenwich Hospital. After the death of Lieut Rivers the flag passed to his son, Horatio E. Rivers, and from thence to his grandson, Lieut.






