 103 Old knife in sheath, 5 brass bracelets and one musical instrument made of hard wood, carved screw shape and played by moving the hollow nut up and down, rapidly or slowly, to keep pace with the performers; taken from the chiefs' Alumbi house at Aqueta, Ibo Country, South Nigeria. Alumbi house is the place where skulls and instruments of the chiefs' ancestors are kept, the purpose of these skulls is to hold a powder which is served to travellers to induce them to make gifts at parting

 104 Alumbi skull from King's Mondah or Alumbi house. A custom prevails in West Africa consisting of serving in dishes given to a guest, powder from the domes which are severed from the skulls of deceased King's ancestors, with a view to soften his heart in the matter of parting presents, the ceremony or custom is accompanied by dancing and music given upon Alumbi instruments which are kept in the Alumbi house (see page 199 "A Journey to Ashango-land," by Du Chaillu). This skull belonged to an old chief of the Commi, Ashira Country

- 30/- 108 Fetish with three horns, the whole covered with human (?) skin, the face painted or coloured with gold by natives; known as the King's Gold Messenger Fetish, and formerly in actual use at the Palaver House of Chief Yaw Antoo of the Gold Coast, where it used to be guarded by the king's gold-handled messenger swords
