- ✓ 50 Bundu Secret Society devil mask of black wood, very rare piece from Mendiland, Sierra Leone. The Bundu Devil is a medicine woman who is believed to be capable of casting spells for good or evil over the men
- ✓ 51 Bundu minserch fetish figure of black wood. These figures perform a very important part in the working of the *Yassi* Medicine
- 52 Ditto, slightly different

✓ 53 Mendi witch-doctor's belt with eight knives in sheaths attached. Each knife is supposed to have a different medicinal property and each is used for a different purpose

✓ 54 Three Mandingo charms of leather, containing extracts from the Koran, some are to protect the wearer from bullets and others are to ward off sickness

55 Two pieces of curious shaped iron formerly used as money in the interior of Mendiland, and 2 pieces of West African ring money

56 Large specimen of rare Lower Congo spear money, consisting of an enormous conventional spear-head of hammered iron 5 feet 4 inches long by 13 inches broad, called "*Ngbele*," five of these would buy a large war canoe and one was equal to five women slaves. From Lokele, Lower Lomaimi river, Belgian Congo

57 Rare Tibetan deity group of a bull-headed monster and a woman, both holding dorge, etc., faces gilt and painted

58 Collection of 25 tobacco pipes from all parts of the world, including North American Indian, *Congo* carved head bowl, *Bushango* in form of animal, East Africa, Ganguella, Angola water pipe, very rare, Wavari, Dôr, Swazi of Zulu, Caffre, New Guinea, Marquesas, New Zealand, India, China, Korea, Japan, etc., etc., each named

59 *Remarkable Elizabethan walking stick carved with figures, animals, heads, etc., in high relief, and also a long inscription. Of great interest and rarity*

SIR WALTER RALEIGH RELIC

- 190 **A most interesting relic of Sir Walter Raleigh, being the original wooden pipe carved by the Indians and presented to Sir Walter by them. It is constructed in four pieces of wood rudely carved with dogs' heads and faces of Red Indians.**

Tradition states that this pipe was used by Sir Walter on the scaffold just previous to his execution and handed to one of his relatives as a memento, and it has been in the possession of descendants of the family ever since. With the pipe is included an old rosewood box containing the letters and documents referring to the relic.
