For a long time past enquiries have been made all over Europe, no one knew what they were, until at last a professor from St. Petersburg, a great traveller, knew, and said that they were exceedingly rare Burmese money, but did not know any one who possessed a piece

*Connected with the Deformation and the Primitive Medical Appliances used by Savage People.*

122 **Dyak medicine or charm basket**, covered with fine beadwork in totemic designs, containing a trophy Dusun skull and charms at bottom, complete with slings for carrying on back, an extremely rare museum specimen, Rejang River

123 Board for deforming heads, used by the Malanos, together with a fine specimen of a deformed skull

124 Set of 6 Cochin body hoops used by women, very rare, and a Solomon ditto waist hoop

125 Cane ring used by the natives of *Duportail Island*, New Britain, to compress men's heads. These rings are worn pressed down tight above the ears, and are placed on the head of a male child when an infant and are not removed until they are fifteen or sixteen, when they are cut off and others larger put on

126 Pair of very rare polished horn ear extenders from Central Africa

127 Pair of Leugua (Paraguay) ear extenders, and an ancient Mexican stone ear-lobe extender or weight

128 Pair of Madagascan tweezers, pair of S. American (Brazil) ditto, pair of S. E. Pacific shell ditto, and a rare Nias Island dagger with tweezers and ear pick attached

129 Pair of Chinese medical tweezers in case, pair of actual shoes worn by a lady of rank, and a razor

130 Three surgical knives from Lake Tanganyika

131 Ditto from the Gaboon and Masailand, and a cupping horn

132 Mashona razor made from an old nail, a Nigerian razor and 3 small Manica knives in sheaths
