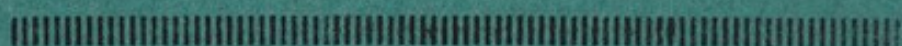

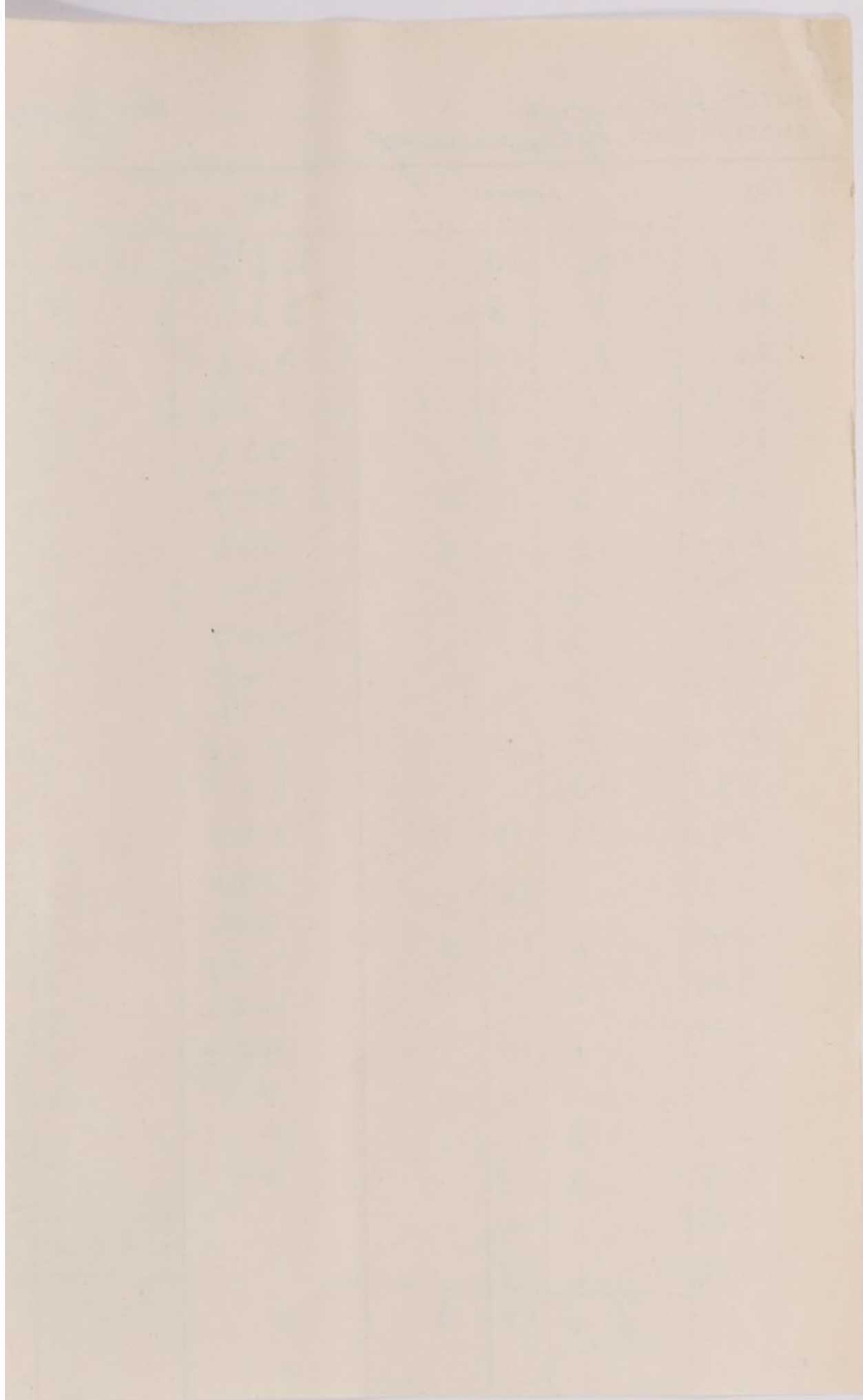

Also relating to her war with the War-Office; Her scheme for Irrigation; On Contagious Diseases and Witchcraft; The Army Sanitary Commission and the prevalence of Fevers; On the incalculable sufferings hanging over Europe and the War of 1870; "I had a good deal rather fight against SLAVE TRADERS than Government Official Authorities of well—a country in prehistoric times." . . .; Upon the death of her father and mother; upon the establishment of an hospital in the General Gordon's Boy Home; upon the death of Doctor David Livingstone and Mrs. Bracebridge; a very fine lengthy manuscript upon the Progress of Sanitation in India (one passage having a marginal note "Omit, if this would be offensive in India, where there is so much fetish worship" . . .; her appeal to John Bright; also an early letter dated "Sunday Embley, 1829 (written when she was nine) to her cousin Henry an amusing letter written in a childish hand, between pencilled lines, describing an incident with gunpowder, giving a riddle, and particulars of a play enacted by herself and other members of the family, signed "Your affectionate cousin, Florence Nightingale," with three early photographs of her father and mother, herself, and their home; upon the statistics of the London hospital; upon the Women's Protective and Providence League and the police power of search at the bad houses; together with a quantity of her own correspondence and manuscripts to various celebrities, an unusually large and important collection, her letter written at the age of nine, being one of the earliest known in any collection, private or public
