189a DRAKE RELIC.—The beautiful gold lace embroidered collar, worn by Sir FRANCIS DRAKE

Admiral Sir Francis Drake was twice married, but died without issue; his nephew Francis Drake succeeded to his property, and was created Baronet, August 2nd, 1622. He married September, 1602, Jane (daughter of Sir Amias Bampfylde), by whom he had one daughter who died in infancy; he married secondly Joan (daughter of Sir William Strode), by whom he had Francis, the second Baronet, who married leaving three daughters. Sir Francis Henry Drake, his nephew, succeeded, and married Anne (daughter of Samuel Heathcote, Esq.; his daughter, Sophia, married in November, 1782, Rev. John Pugh, Rector of Rauceby, Lincolnshire, who died without issue surviving him; his property went to Catherine Pugh, his sister, who married David Edwards His daughter, Eleanor, married, 1807, Rev. Romaine Hervey, and died childless. Under a Deed of Settlement part of her property went to her brother, and the remainder to her husband, who married secondly Elizabeth Marshall Blaney, by whom he had two sons, Thomas and George.

He married September, 1602, Jane (daughter of Sir Amias Bampfylde), by whom he had one daughter who died in infancy; he married secondly Joan (daughter of Sir William Strode), by whom he had Francis, the second Baronet, who married leaving three daughters. Sir Francis Henry Drake, his nephew, succeeded, and married Anne (daughter of Samuel Heathcote, Esq.; his daughter, Sophia, married in November, 1782, Rev. John Pugh, Rector of Rauceby, Lincolnshire, who died without issue surviving him; his property went to Catherine Pugh, his sister, who married David Edwards His daughter, Eleanor, married, 1807, Rev. Romaine Hervey, and died childless. Under a Deed of Settlement part of her property went to her brother, and the remainder to her husband, who married secondly Elizabeth Marshall Blaney, by whom he had two sons, Thomas and George.

Admiral Sir Francis Drake was twice married, but died without issue; his nephew Francis Drake succeeded to his property, and was created Baronet, August 2nd, 1622. He married September, 1602, Jane (daughter of Sir Amias Bampfylde), by whom he had one daughter who died in infancy; he married secondly Joan (daughter of Sir William) Strode), by whom he had Francis, the second Baronet, who married leaving three daughters. Sir Francis Henry Drake, his nephew, succeeded, and married Anne (daughter of Samuel Heathcote, Esq.; his daughter, Sophia, married in November, 1782, Rev. John Pugh, Rector of Rauceby, Lincolnshire, who died without issue surviving him; his property went to Catherine Pugh, his sister, who married His daughter, Eleanor, married, 1807, David Edwards Rev. Romaine Hervey, and died childless. Under a Deed of Settlement part of her property went to her brother, and the remainder to her husband, who married secondly Elizabeth Marshall Blaney, by whom he had two sons, Thomas and George.
