

# Old English Arms.

These two old arms were taken from the British by the Dutch at the Cape of Good Hope in the first Settlement war in 1805. They were afterwards taken from the Dutch by Moshesh (Chief) about 1834. Used in subsequent wars by Moshesh's Chief Mojela. Obtained by present owner from Chief Mojela

186a Tower musket, Brunswick pattern, British army, 1830, genuine Tower musket, issued to British army from Tower, bearing Tower stamp, Royal Arms and date


