The compound mechanical rotating stage is a very fine piece of workmanship fitted

with brass sliding bars for clamping object in fixed position, horizontal rack and pinion motion in two directions at right angles and rack and pinion rotating motion on a heavy gunmetal ring accurately graduated to degrees and with index to register angle of rotation; the sub-stage is fitted with rack and pinion perpendicular motion, rack and pinion rotating motion and horizontal rack and pinion centering adjustments in two directions. The large plain and concave mirrors are swung on a double swivel, permitting inclination in any direction and at any angle. The microscope stands 21 inches high when racked down. This magnificent instrument is in perfect order and in condition as new.
