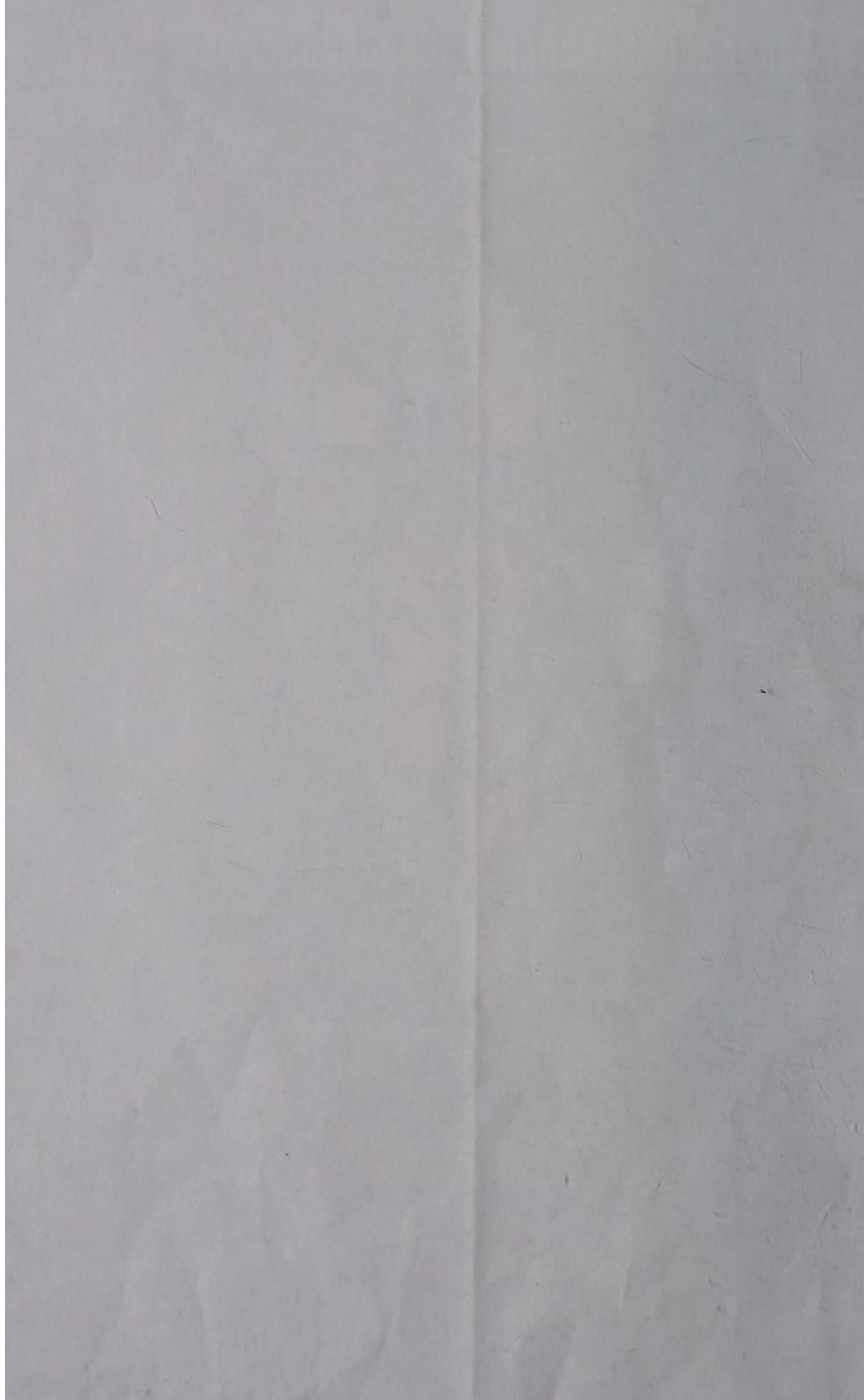

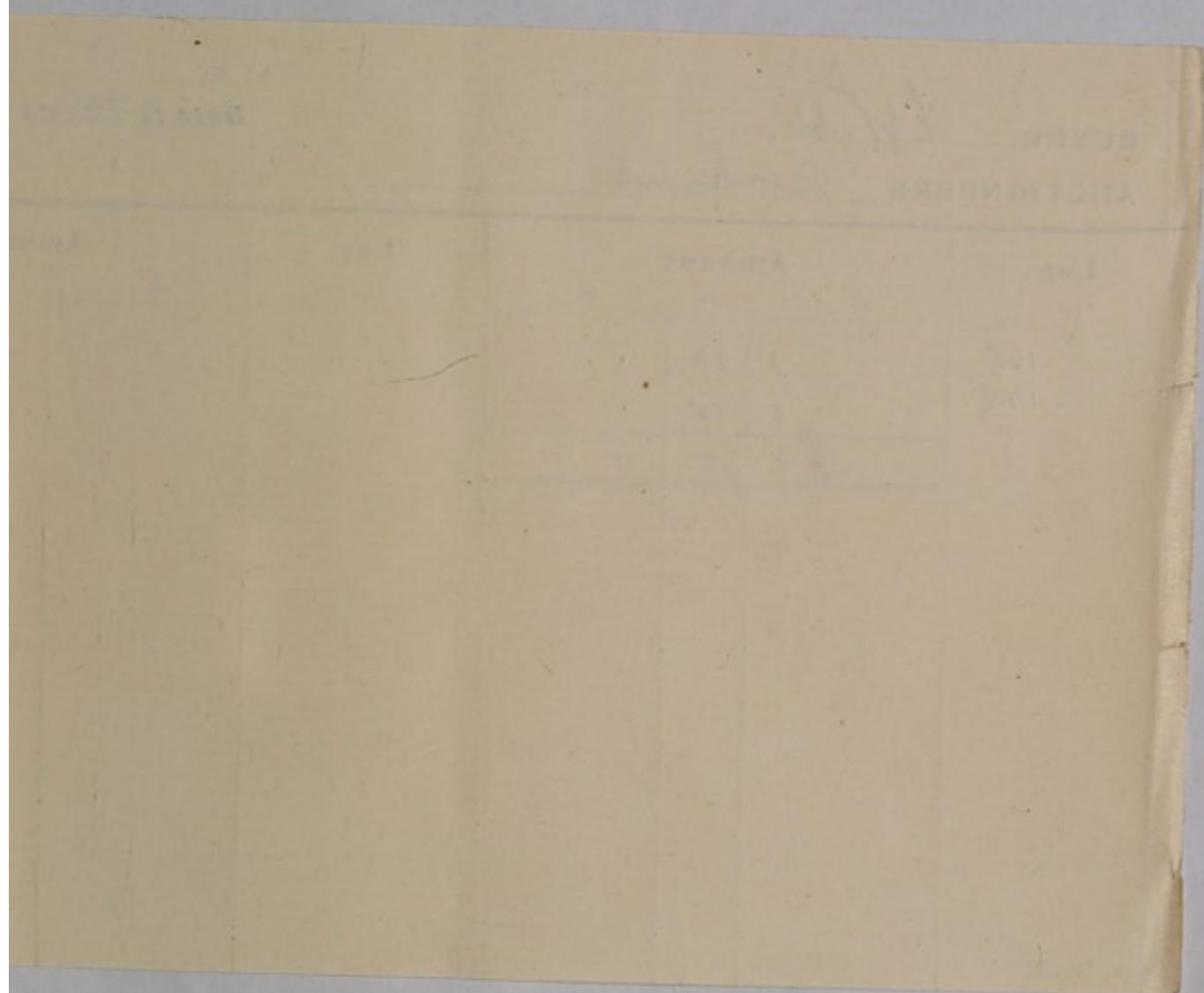
FOURTH.—In the case of lots upon which there is a reserve, the Auctioneer shall have the right to bid on behalf of the seller.
