- 250 *A small pewter teapot, used by Lord Nelson on board the Victory. On one side inscribed "Battle of Trafalgar, Oct. 21st, 1805," and on the other "Teapot used by Lord Nelson on board the Victory"*

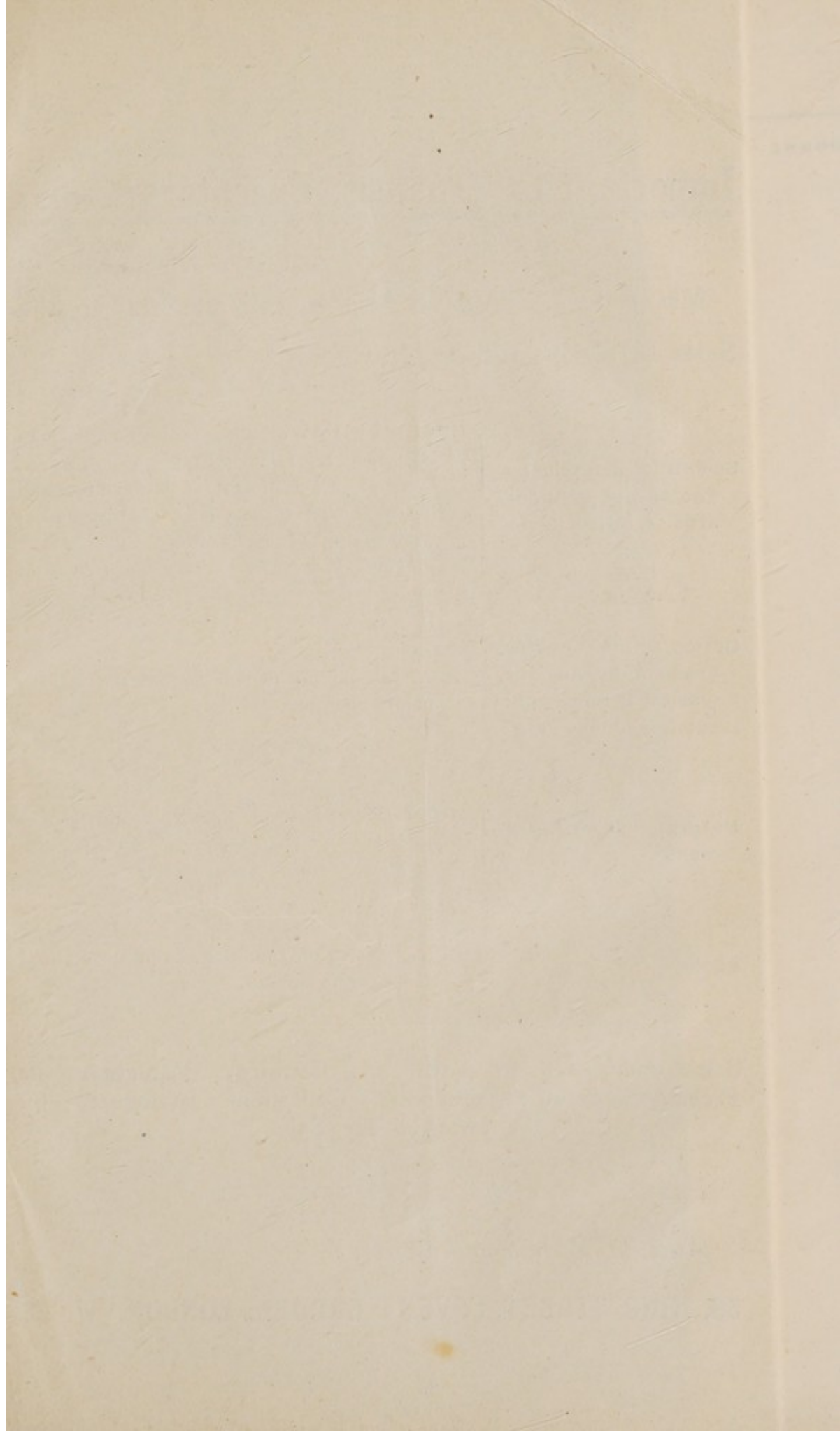
