CONDITIONS OF SALE.

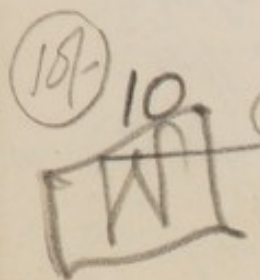
