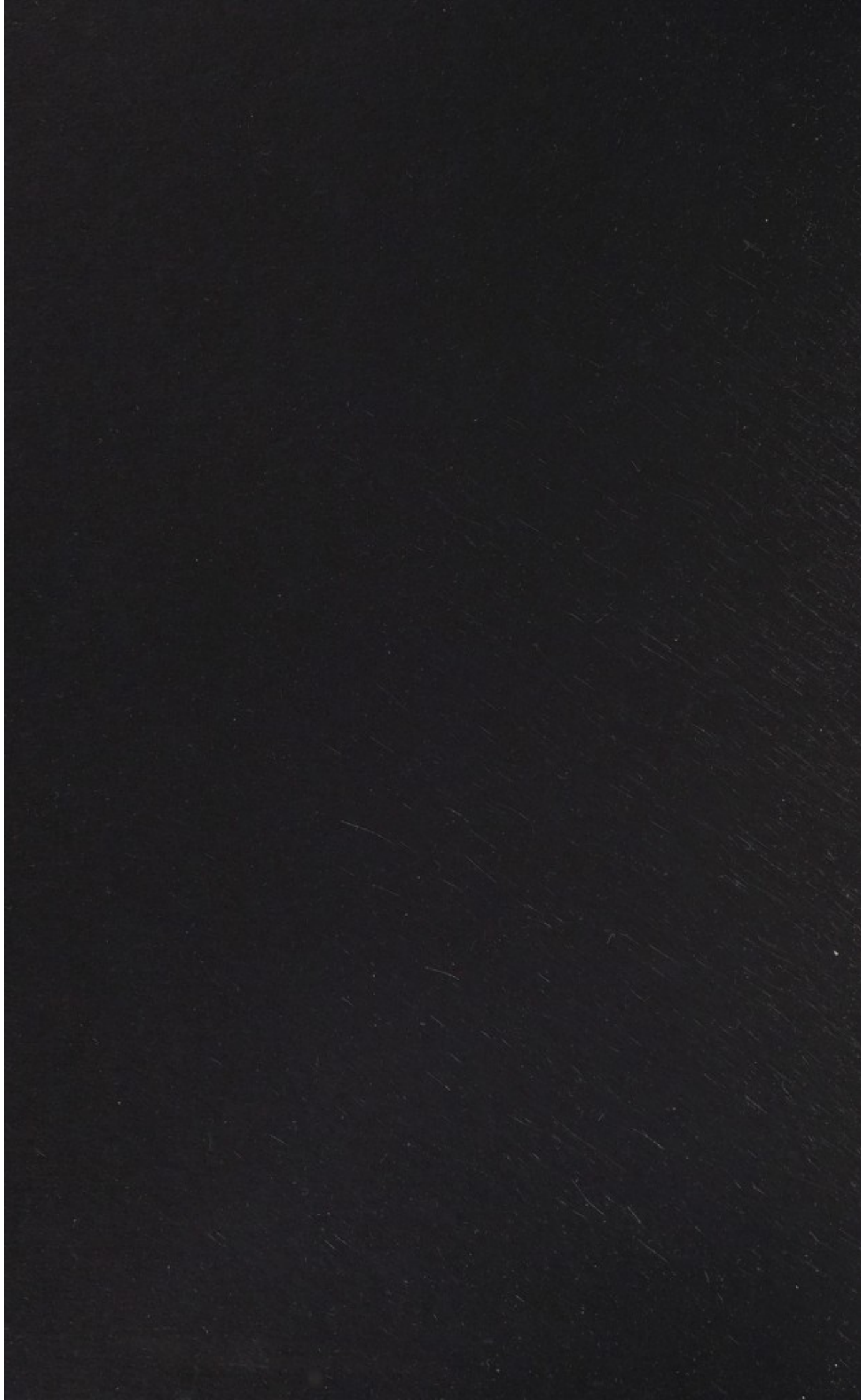

- 362 An Old English upright mirror in gilt frame with cornice over, *2ft. 3in. wide*, another with frieze of classical figures, *22in. wide*, and another, *23in.*
- 363 A pair of Chinese black lacquer octagonal shaped chests inlaid in landscapes and figures and flowers in mother-o'-pearl, on ebonised stands with drawer, scroll-shaped legs and tray stretchers, ormolu mounts, *18½in. wide*
- 364 A barometer and thermometer in boldly carved and gilt case with acanthus foliage and flowers and boy figure at base, *3ft. 3in. high*
- 365 An Old English square-shaped footstool, top covered in needlework, and a fender stool, top covered in needlework

- 366 An Old English walnut top table, with drawer and carved edge, inset with geological specimen plaque, on carved mahogany fluted pillar and shaped base and paw feet,  $22\frac{1}{2}$ in. wide
- 367 An Old English mahogany and inlaid swing toilet mirror on plateau, with 1 long and 2 short drawers, 17in. wide
- 368 An Old English mahogany swing toilet mirror, on oblong plateau with drawer,  $14\frac{1}{2}$ in. wide
- 369 Another with drawer in plateau, 20in. wide
- 370 An Old English mahogany and inlaid swing toilet mirror, bow front plateau with 3 drawers,  $19\frac{1}{2}$ in. wide
- 371 An Old English mahogany and inlaid swing toilet mirror in plateau with drawer,  $13\frac{1}{2}$ in. high, and a mahogany swing toilet mirror, on standards, 14in. high
- 372 An ebonised and walnut 4-tier etagere
- 373 Four circular mirrors in gilt frames and 2 oak panels, carved in scrolls and gilt
- 374 An oblong mirror with bevelled plate and mirror border, in gilt frame, 3ft. 2in. by 2ft. 1in.
- 375 A set of 6 Chinese blackwood panels, inlaid in flowers, seals, Chinese characters, etc., in mother-o'-pearl, 6ft. 6in. by 12in.
- 376 A pair of carved and gilt square shaped jardiniere stands, on cabriole legs and tray stretcher, 13in. square, 3ft. 7in. high
- 377 An Old English mahogany telescopic reading table with rising top and pull-out slides at ends, on turned pillar and claw, 24in. wide
- 378 A 3ft. 4in. Old English walnut oblong table with oak top and 1 long drawer, oak lined, shaped apron front, on front cabriole legs
- 379 A pair of gilt jardiniere stands, on scroll tripods and claw, 3ft. 6in. high
- 380 A Persian carpet, conventional design, on a marone ground (cut one end), about 10ft. 6in. by 12ft. 6in.
- 381 A mahogany and satinwood inlaid bureau with fall front, enclosing pigeon holes and drawers and 3 drawers under, on bracket feet, 2ft. 6in. wide
- 382 A mahogany circular table, on carved pillar and claw, the top inlaid in various woods in geometric design and circles of animals, 30in. diam.
- 383 A mahogany oval top table with drawer and fall down flaps, on tapered legs
