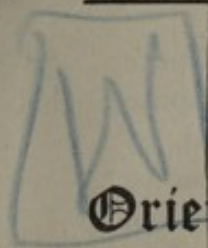

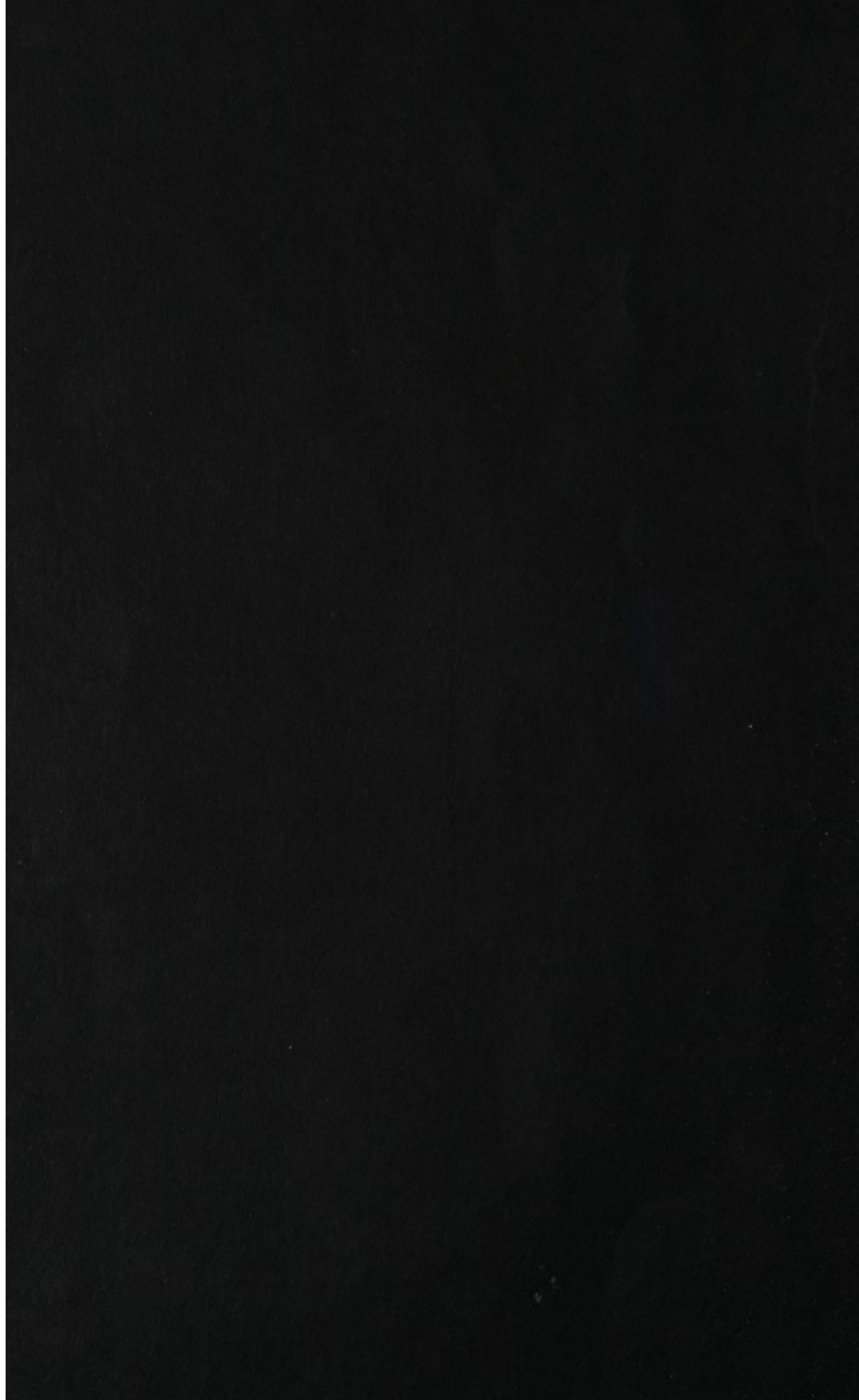

THIRD.—The lots are to be taken away and paid for, whether genuine and authentic or not, with all faults and errors of description, the day after the sale ; Messrs. FOSTER not being responsible for the correct description, genuineness, or authenticity of any lot.

FOURTH.—To prevent inaccuracy in delivery and inconvenience in the settlement of the purchases, no lot can be transferred, nor can any lot be removed during the time of sale. Each buyer must pay for the whole of his purchases before any lot is removed.
