

- collar (Mu-hi-ni-o) from Mount Kenya, B.E. Africa, with interesting native-made chain pendants, an amulet in shape of a crocodile, and 2 charm cases of immature cocoanuts from British New Guinea
- A most interesting portrait in wax taken from the wrappings of an Egyptian mummy of the 1st century, A.D.; these objects are the earliest examples of portrait painting extant
 - Ancient Egyptian Ka, or soul of a deceased person, in the shape of a hawk; the jackal-headed god, Anubis; and a figure of a jackal, all in wood, rare; and 3 Ushabtis from the tombs of priests of Amen-Ra
- Curious silver idol from Central America, a piece of ancient Peruvian cerecloth, and a rare cap from interior of British Guiana, made from the inner bark of a tree
 - Helmet of a chief from Latuka, East Africa, made of felted human hair with brass overlay; a highly valued object and most difficult to obtain
- Pair of very interesting and scarce "Messages from one West African Chief to Another," collected by Sir A. Moloney many years ago
- Pair of rare old copper Islamic ceremonial banners, surmounted with the mystic hand representing the 5 holy persons; used in the Shi'a procession
 - A very curious little quiver of palm leaf containing blowgun darts poisoned with Curari obtained from the bark of strychnos casteluana, and a bag of raw cotton to form the "feathers," Upper Amazon
 - Large decorative hair comb from Samoa, a genuine antique Scotch snuff-mull, and a Chinese bronze opium pipe
 - Fine and very rare antique Laplander's ceremonial knife, etched and inlaid, used in connection with the reindeer veneration and cult
 - Zulu chief's head ornament of rank worn with the porcupine quills upwards, long obsolete and rare
