The Hagiris, in vengeance, descended and massacred the whole of the tribe of Akiris. The two ornaments came into the possession of W. C. BRUCE, Esq., late Commandant of Papuan Police, who was in charge of the punitive force sent to regain order in the district.

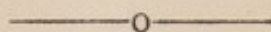

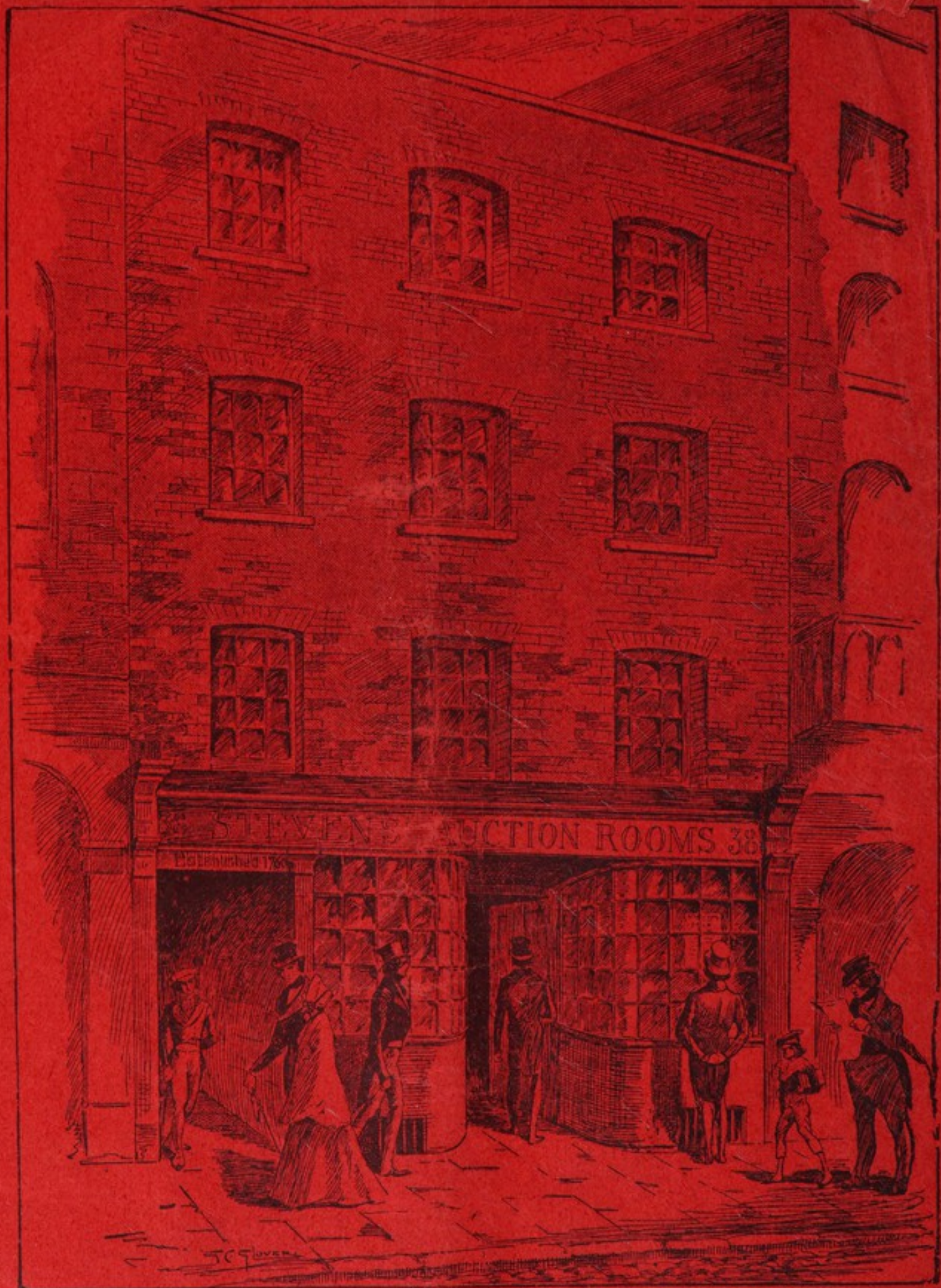
