



TIBETAN COLLECTION.

The following articles are part of the collection made in Tibet, and recently brought home by an Officer serving in the Tibet Field Force during its advance to Lhasa in 1904.

Several of the pieces of cloisonné enamel are of great age, some probably dating from the time of the Ming Dynasty, which began to reign in China in the fourteenth century. One piece, No. 193 in this catalogue, is believed to be the only specimen of its kind that has been brought to England.
