These are becoming very rare as the gaucho or cowboy is giving up the distinctive dress 301

298 Hausa bridle (N. Nigeria), 2 ditto swords and native-made sword belts

299 Two North Nigerian bows, 2 quivers of poisoned arrows, 2 assegais and stick

300 Curious bridle, reins and stirrups

301 Set of throwing lassos or bolas

302 Ten Masai spears (African) on shield

303 Three African shields and bow

304 Three pairs of African horns

305 *King Theebaw's riding saddle, taken at Mandalay,* with headstall, bit, stirrup, reins, etc., the saddle cloth and trappings richly embroidered in gold and silver on crimson velvet

306 Two interesting swords of Eastern manufacture, in leather sheaths

307 Central African chief's basket helmet, leather quiver full of arrows and sundry other weapons

308 *Ceremonial staff* and carved wood tray

309 Three specimens of Central African hammered brass work

310 Carved African stool, legs cut out of the solid wood

311 Large number of miscellaneous autograph letters including Sims Reeves, Count Seckendorff, actors, actresses, peers, church dignitaries, etc.

312 An account of the discovery of the body of King John in the Cathedral Church of Worcester, July 17th, 1797, with a portion of the hose and sandal as taken from the body when found as described in the MSS.

313 Four Uganda spears

314 Long Indian knife with curious brass-mounted handle

315 Two flintlock pistols and 3 percussion ditto

315a Box of Greek pottery

316 Large box of Etruscan and other pottery

317 Egyptian, wooden and bronze antiquities

318 Miscellaneous collection of antiquities, mostly found in London

319 Fine North American Indian tobacco pouch, sewn with animal sinew and large stone pipe with bone stem

320 Property Mark of St. Olaves School, Southwark, founded by Queen Elizabeth, with schoolmaster and pupils in Sixteenth Century costume, dated 1571. Found when demolishing old buildings during the construction of the Tower Bridge

321 Set of antique slave irons consisting of neck and wrist rings, with curious padlock and pair of leg rings

322 Large collection of prehistoric implements from Thames gravels

323 Five perforated and inlaid tsubas

324 Old Sedan clock in going order

325 Rare album of hand-painted Indian mythological subjects

326 Pair of very fine old bronze vases

Interesting Mohammedan Religious Objects.

327 Mohammedan religious sword used in the Moharram procession, exceedingly scarce

328 Ditto dagger with religious inscription and ornaments engraved on the blade and steel scabbard

329 Kurdish or Armenian war club, steel, very rare, probably unique

330 Ancient surgical or circumcision scissors, chased and traces of gold inlaying

257-331 | Antique magical cup, bronze engraved with magical formulæ and figures, employed for magical or medical purposes. The inscription was supposed to confer upon him who drank from it blessing and perfect health from heaven. From a ruined Mohammedan shrine, Persia.

257-332 | Ditto stone with raised armed figures

333 | Bronze wedding chalice, engraved with ancient ornamentation and the name of Princess Bent Mohammed Hosain. There is no other specimen in the British Museum

Remarkable Medical MS. and Painting.

557-334 | Persian MS., medical work, being a full description of simple and compound drugs, technical terms and uses of various herbs, plants, roots and all animal substances, silver brocade binding

Note.—An important work, undoubtedly it forms one of the interesting contributions to the science of the theoretical and practical medicine.

335 | Persian painting—Bites by rabid animals, possibly a leaf from an important medical work, mounted and framed

Unique Sanskrit and Pali MSS.

16-336 | Sanskrit MS. Not deciphered. From a Buddhist Temple, India

181-337 | Pali MS. on palm leaves. A mythological legend concerning the gods of Mardik and Asik. Formerly belonged to priest at Lahore

221-338 | Ditto. Prayers and incantation with magical formulæ and omens. From Lahore

181-339 | Hindustani MS. Native laws and astrology, etc. From the ancient Royal Library at Lahore

340 | Ditto, Arabic, a religious work from the same library

Unique Arabic MS., numerous formulæ relating to marriage, dowry, sale of male and female slaves, revenue of the Mohammedan temples, duties of women and men, records of legal decisions of the judges, etc. From a dealer in curiosities, Lahore

Unknown MS. written on an unusual sort of paper, *probably unique*. From Lahore


