Interesting Mohammedan Religious Objects.

- 327 Mohammedan religious sword used in the Moharram procession, exceedingly scarce

- 329 Kurdish or Armenian war club, steel, very rare, probably unique
- 157- 330 Ancient surgical or circumcision scissors, chased and traces of gold inlaying

257- 331 Antique magical cup, bronze engraved with magical formulæ and figures, employed for magical or medical purposes. The inscription was supposed to confer upon him who drank from it blessing and perfect health from heaven. From a ruined Mohammedan shrine, Persia.

257 332 Ditto stone with raised armed figures

333 Bronze wedding chalice, engraved with ancient ornamentation and the name of Princess Bent Mohammed Hosain. There is no other specimen in the British Museum

Remarkable Medical MS. and Painting.

557 334 Persian MS., medical work, being a full description of simple and compound drugs, technical terms and uses of various herbs, plants, roots and all animal substances, silver brocade binding

Note.—An important work, undoubtedly it forms one of the interesting contributions to the science of the theoretical and practical medicine.

335 Persian painting—Bites by rabid animals, possibly a leaf from an important medical work, mounted and framed

Unique Sanskrit and Pali MSS.

161- 336 Sanskrit MS. Not deciphered. From a Buddhist Temple, India

181- 337 Pali MS. on palm leaves. A mythological legend concerning the gods of Mardik and Asik. Formerly belonged to priest at Lahore

221- 338 Ditto. Prayers and incantation with magical formulæ and omens. From Lahore

181- 339 Hindustani MS. Native laws and astrology, etc. From the ancient Royal Library at Lahore

340 Ditto, Arabic, a religious work from the same library

- 191- 341 Unique Arabic MS., numerous formulæ relating to marriage, dowry, sale of male and female slaves, revenue of the Mohammedan temples, duties of women and men, records of legal decisions of the judges, etc. From a dealer in curiosities, Lahore
- 187- 342 Unknown MS. written on an unusual sort of paper, *probably unique*. From Lahore
- 343 Mongolian MS. *An historical work, very rare*
- 227- 344 Indo-Persian MS. Historical extracts concerning early Indian Mongol men of high standing, *very rare*

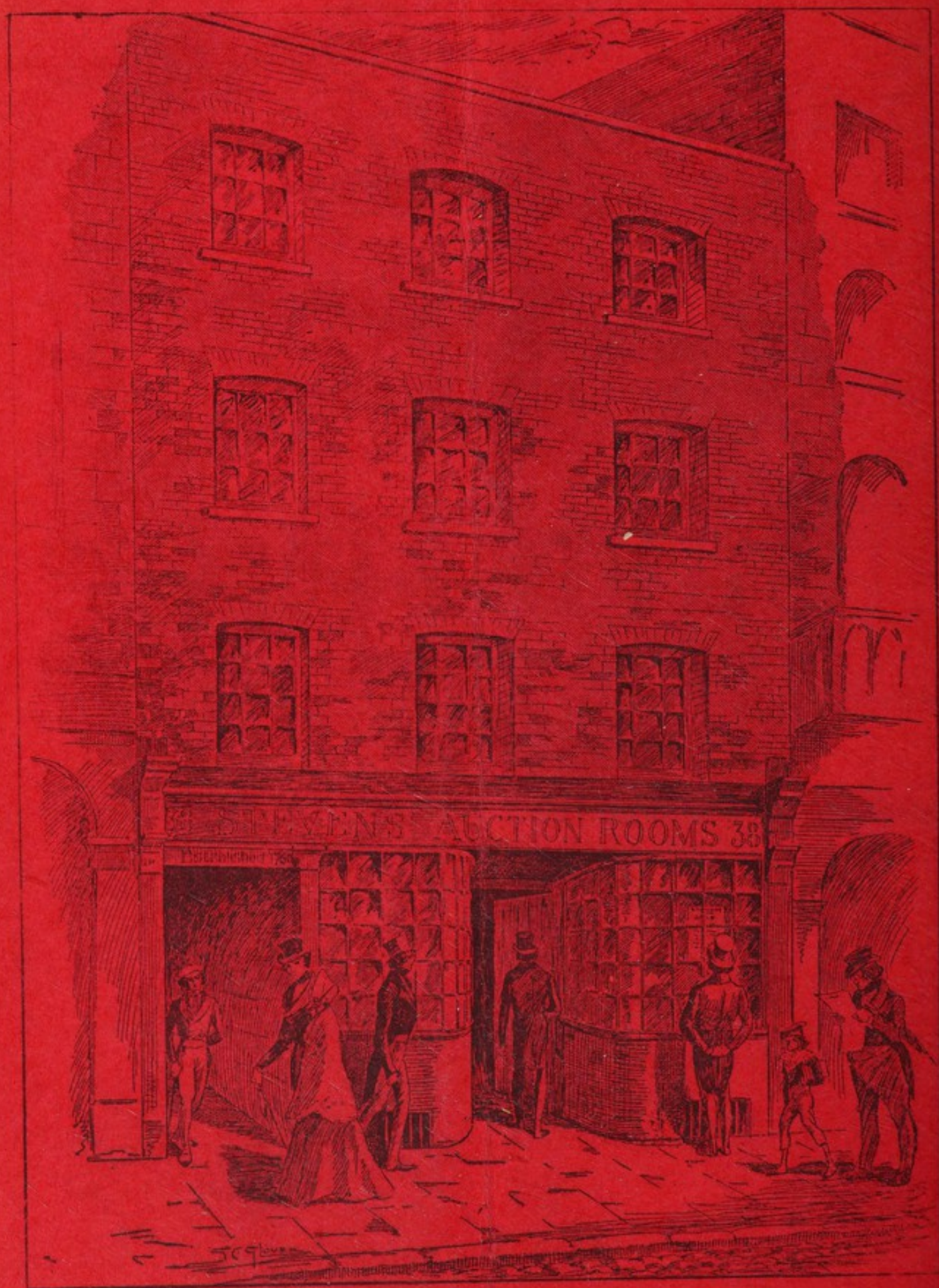
