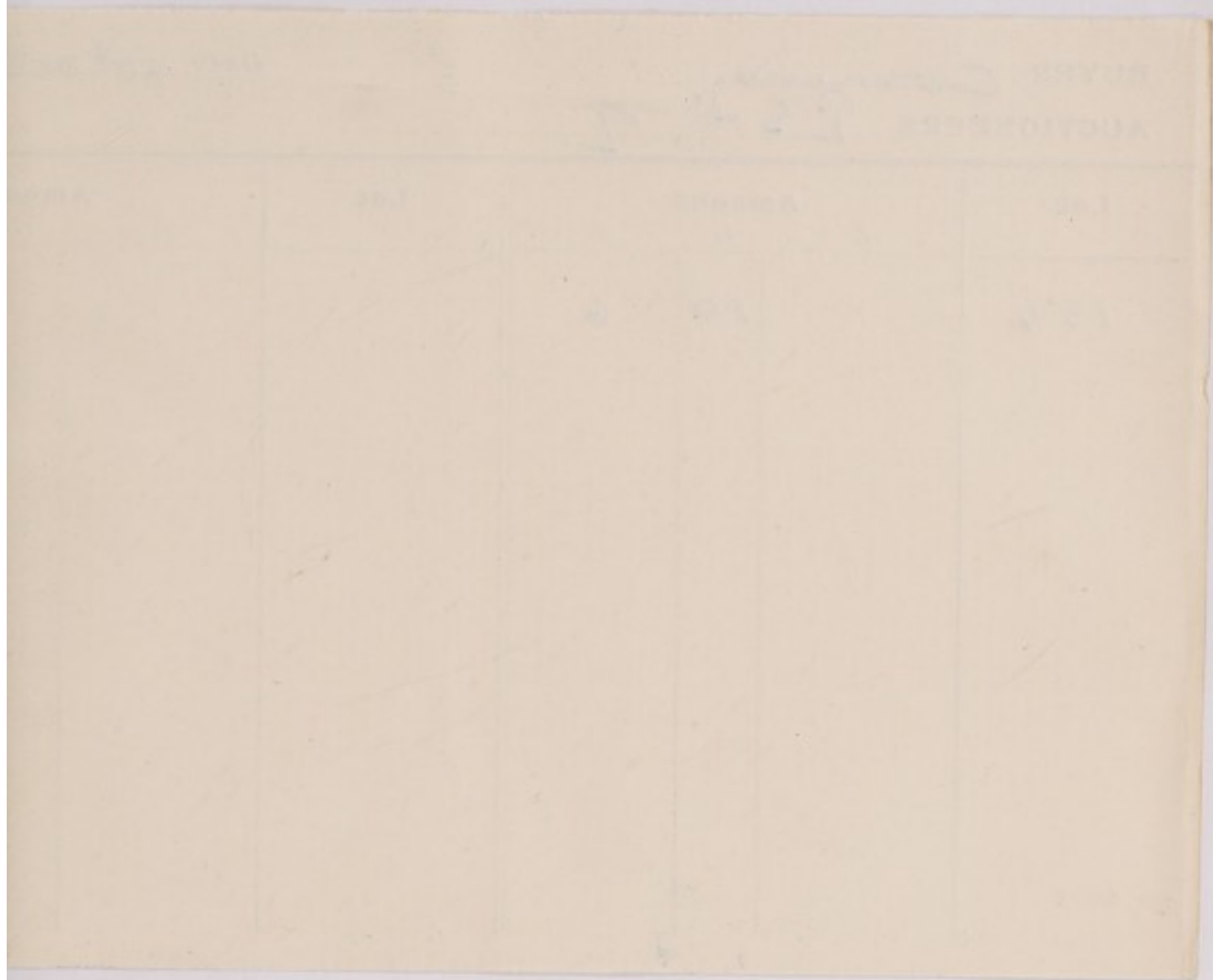

- 226 A pair of large Delft hexagonal shaped vases and covers, blue and white (a.f.), a pair of large hexagonal Canton vases, decorated with panels of terrace scenes and figures (a.f.)
- 227 A pair of powder blue bulb-shaped vases, decorated with panels of oriental landscapes and figures, on black and gilt stands, and a large oriental pilgrim bottle in colours
- 228 A cut glass electrolier, with festoon and star decorations
- 229 A birch bedroom suite, comprising :—A 4ft. Beaconsfield wardrobe ; a dressing chest of 7 drawers and swing mirror over ; a washstand with marble top and tiled back ; a pedestal cupboard, towel ailer and 2 chairs
