Ancient Clay Figures of Birds, Animals, etc.

Found in the neighbourhood of Bucaramanga (Interior of Columbia), in an ancient Indian cemetery of the tribe called the Laches, which tribe has disappeared since these regions have been colonised. The Laches were Indians of a warlike nature, and they fought many battles with the "Conquistadores," especially against the German Alfinger, who was the first to explore these territories. They occupied a part of what is now known as the Department of Santander, and their chief place seemed to have been Bucaramanga, although their expeditions extended over a comparatively large radius. Several of the articles have been found in tombs which by their structure are believed to be of Caciques or Chieftains.

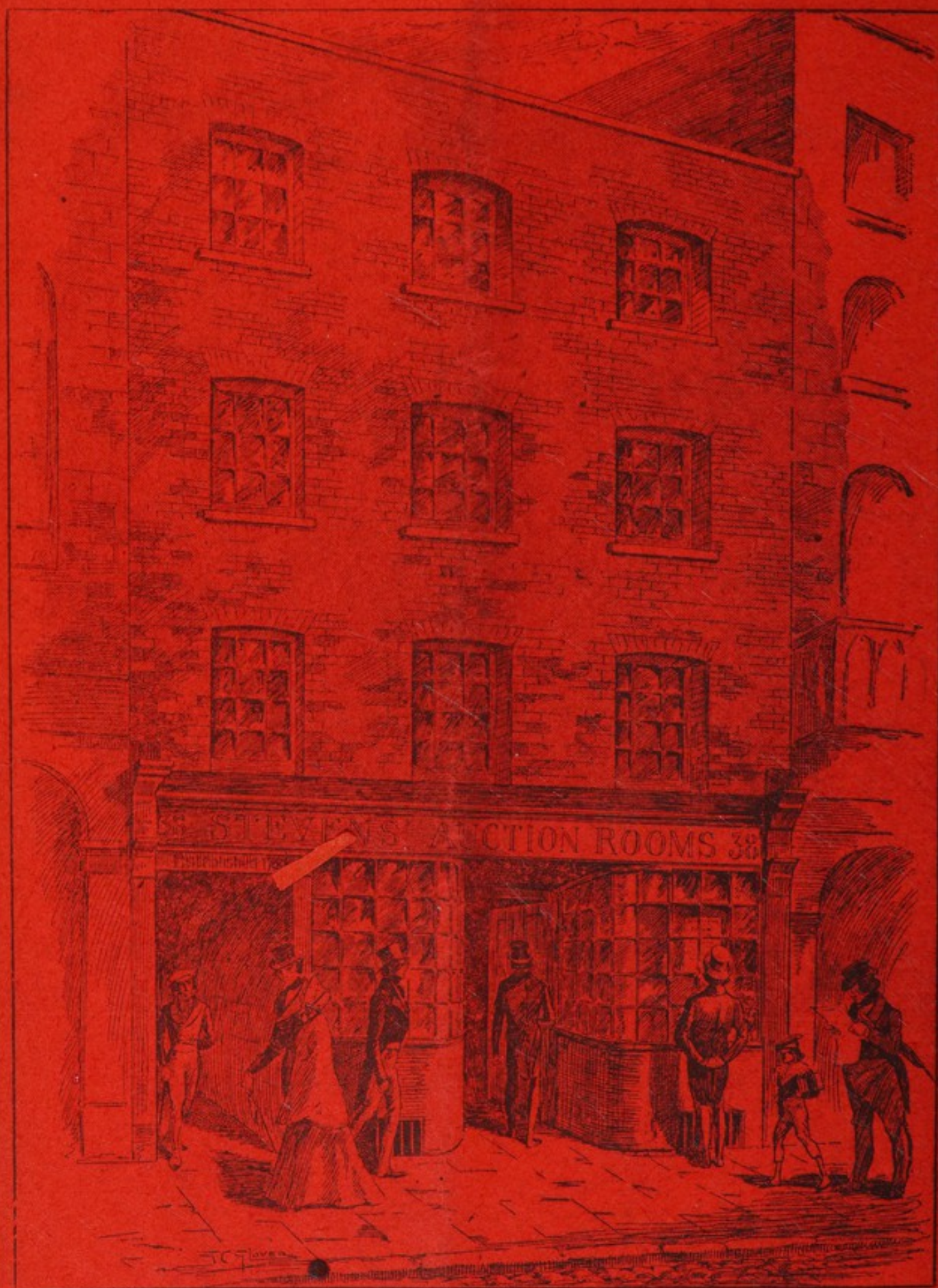
