Florence Nightingale. Her Bible.

A unique and rare Florence Nightingale item. "The Holy Bible" with two long autograph presentation inscriptions to her GODCHILD, W. S. Craven, with an autograph letter from Miss Nightingale to Mrs. Craven.

"Offered thro' his dear mother,
Florence (Lees) Craven."

"For my dear little God child. Waldemar Sigismund Craven, with his Godmother's most earnest prayers that many, many New Years both in this world and the next, may pour upon him all the highest blessings that God can give and I can wish him. And that the child Jesus may be born anew in all our three hearts, his, and his mother's, and mine, than which there can be no better wish, Florence Nightingale, 1881."

Together with an original letter signed and dated 25th Oct. BALACLAVA DAY, to Mrs. Craven.

∴ Mrs. Dacre Craven was FLORENCE LEES, appointed on Florence Nightingale's recommendation, by the Empress Frederick, then Crown Princess of Prussia, to take charge of the Royal Reserve Lazareth at Homburg when the Franco Prussian War broke out, and she was in charge of it until 1871. She was the only Englishwoman actually under fire before Metz. She became a great personal friend of the Empress Frederick, who was the Godmother of the late Col. W. S. D. Craven (d. 1928) one of her sons.

FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE WAS THE OTHER GODMOTHER, AND REFERS TO HER GODSON IN THE LETTER.

"I have been so busy that I have not been able to think, or rather to *do* about my dear Godson's books hitherto. May I take your hint about military books and send him now the "Victoria Cross" which teaches soldiers splendid gallantry towards each other and their country.
