A small Collection of Syrian and other Antiquities from Constantinople.

- 407 Amber cigarette-holder, Persian handiwork, 200 years old
- 408 Small Chinese Surayi, used for rose-water, nearly 100 years old
- 409 Two earthen lamps, found in an ancient Greek grave near Samsoun, in the ancient province of Pontus
- 410 Kutahia water jug, nearly 50 years old
- 411 Two bronze candle-holders from Persia, over 150 years old
- 412 Somaki bath-bowl, from the collection of the escaped Shah's Palace
- 413 Cigarette box made of animal's horn, very thinly cut
- 414 Two Nazarliks (charms of evil-avoiders) used only Dervish religious chiefs
- 415 An oil drawing in frame of "Nacre," over 600 years old, evidently Byzantine work
- 416 Two Persian looking-glass frames, delicate hand-work, 1 fine mosaic and the other carved with figures of the Shah and Queen, from the Palace Collection
- 417 Twenty Byzantine mail stamps (lead), very well preserved
- 418 Ditto, not so well preserved

- 419 Eight Greek and Persian bronze rings, very old
- 420 Silver Moslem ring with engraved stone. It belonged to Fetime Sultan (a princess, one of the nieces of the Sultan)
- 421 Three gold earrings with pearls fixed on, used by Pashas' wives as well as Sultanas (wives of the Sultan)
- 422 Eight antique Byzantine crosses, found among the ruins of 3 ancient churches. These crosses very well show the various periods of Byzantine art as regards to bronze-work
- 423 Four ancient bookbindings of Sacred Korans, once in the Holy Mosque of Mecca
- 424 Two Byzantine antique scales, used for weighing coins, with Byzantine monograms
- 425 Two metal small bowls called "pimu," with oscillating fish inside, used for drinking liquors, Turkish work
- 426 Byzantine looking-glass frame, gilt with real gold, over 700 years old. Found intact in a chest in the ruins of the Byz palace
- 427 Four "Saxonian" cups for coffee, fine designs of ornament, over 500 years old
- 428 Scarabdi Colier, antique Egyptian pendant, set in order, used by Egyptian ladies of high rank
- 429 Fifteen ivory spoons with handles of fine wood, 3 forks, knife, a pair of tongs with gold ornamentation, inlaid. Asiatic native work of the Fifteenth Century
- 430 Byzantine Ikon, carved on argil stone
- 431 Bone paper-cutter, Persian handiwork of 300 years' old. Of the Palace Collection

- 432 A pair of scissors, decorated with gold ornamentation and corail stones. Of the Palace Collection
- 433 Pendatif of silver and corail stone, Persian work, used by ladies of high rank only. Of the Palace Collection
- 434 Chinese inkstand, over 500 years old, secured after the Chinese Revolution
- 435 Antique Greek hatpin, used by ladies of high-class, found near the ruins of Ephesus
- 436 Two antique Greek bracelets (glass), found in an ancient grave in Greece. Work of the before Christ era
- 437 Silver neckpiece (gilt-silver). Persian work, over 150 years old. From the Palace Collection
- 438 Persian incense bowl, with fine email-stones, secured from a Nestorian ancient church
- 439 A pair of tongs with corail stones. Over 170 years old. From the Palace Collection
- 440 Two Chinese bowls, over 500 years old
- 441 Three antique Greek ring-stones, found in an old grave
- 442 Persian antique sword with fine silver decorative ornamentation on the cover. Of the Palace Collection
- 443 Bronze surayi, or rose-water bottle, with glass base and fine handiwork design. Of the Palace Collection
- 444 Bronze surmalik for black colour, which Persian ladies of high class used for blackening their eyebrows
- 445 Ivory knife handle, Persian work of considerable antiquity. Of the Palace Collection

- 446 Bohemian antique bowl, white and red
- 447 Ditto, blue
- 448 Four beautiful Patin glass tumblers (antique Greek), used by mourning women for filling with their tears to be kept sacred
- 449 Seven embroideries (quite antique), Armenian maidens' handiwork. One of them (the long one), a wedding bath towel
- 450 Persian box with oil painting, representing the meeting of the Shah and his retinue with ladies of the Court. Over 500 years old
