Personally collected from a tribe of Aborigines (Wright's Creek Tribe), near Cairns, N.Q., by a well-known resident, a cotton planter, a University man, who has certified to their genuineness in writing. There are 20,000 Aborigines in Queensland, and of these 15,000 are in North Queensland.
